

Materials/Cutting Chart for NLSEE2145-5x7

Front, Outside, Applique Fabric (border)	1 cut at 7.5 x 5.75 inches
Front, Inside, Applique Fabric (center)	1 cut at 6.25 x 4.25 inches
Snowmen, Applique Fabric	1 cut at 3 x 2 inches
Puffy Foam	1 cut at 7.5 x 5.75 inches
Vinyl-Felt backed-Tablecloth	1 cut at 7.5 x 5.75 inches1 cut at 2 x 3 inches
Heat-N-Bond Lite	1 cut at 7.5 x 5.75 inches
	1 cut at 6.25 x 4.25
	1 cut at 3 x 2 inches
Water-Soluble Stabilizer	Enough for a single layer for a 5 x 5 inch embroidery hoop

The Color Sequence Chart below will be referenced throughout these instructions



- 1. Prepare materials as indicated in the Materials/Cutting Chart above and fuse the Heat-N-Bond pieces to the fabric of the same size.
- 2. Hoop a single layer of water-soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch embroidery hoop and attach to machine.
- 3. Transfer NLSEE2145-5x7 to your embroidery machine.



4. Change needle and bobbin thread to white for this next step. 5. Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the "Placement Stitches" for the project. 6. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface (right-side up), place the Puffy Foam piece over the placement stitches and secure with tape at the top and bottom. Keep tape out of stitching area. 7. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the foam to the stabilizer. 8. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface, face up, and carefully cut away the excess foam from around the stitching.

9. Remove paper backing from the front, outside fabric.	
10. Place front, outside fabric, right side up, over the foam and tape in place at top and bottom. (Keep tape out of stitching area.)	
11. Return hoop to machine and sew # 3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach front, fabric piece to project.	
12. Sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create stitches for the interior of the applique.	

13. Remove hoop from machine and carefully cut out the center portion of the project. 14. Remove paper backing from the center fabric. 15. Place the center fabric piece over the cut-out section and tape in place at top and bottom. 16. Return hoop to machine and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the center, fabric piece to the project.

- 17. Change the needle thread to the color you want for the quilting stitches.
- 18. Sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the quilting stitches for the center section of the project.



19. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface and cut away the excess fabric from around the center of the project.





20. Return hoop to machine and sew #7 and #8 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create a border around the center part of the project and a motif stitch on top of border



21. Change needle thread to white. Sew #9 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the "Placement Stitches" for the snowmen bodies. (Because the thread I used is white, it does not show up very well in the photo, but you should be able to see the stitches when you sew them.)



22. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface, remove paper backing from the Snowman-fabric and place the fabric over the placement stitches for the snowmen bodies. (I had two scraps of white I used, but you were instructed to cut one piece, which makes it easier.)
23. Tape fabric piece in place with tape at the four corners.



24. Return hoop to machine and sew #10 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the snowmen fabric to the project.



25. Remove hoop from machine, lay face-up on a flat surface and trim away excess snowmen fabric.



26. Return hoop to machine and sew #11 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create satin borders on some sections of the snowmen.



- 27. Change needle thread to the color you want for the hat, scarf and mittens of the first snowman.
- 28. Sew #12 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the hat, scarf and mittens for the first snowman.



- 29. Change needle thread to the color you want for the hat, scarf and mittens for the second snowman.
- 30. Sew #13 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the hat, scarf and mittens for the second snowman.



31. Change needle thread to black and sew #14 in the Color Sequence Chart.
These stitches will create the eyes, mouths, and buttons on both snowmen.





- 32. Trim jump threads.
- 33. Change needle thread to light pink and sew #15 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the "rosy" cheeks on both snowmen.



- 34. Change needle thread to orange and sew #16 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the carrot noses for both snowmen.
- 35. Change needle thread to white and sew #17 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the fuzzy ball on top of the red hat.




 36. Change needle thread to the color you wish for the text "Snow Buddies" and sew #18 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the text. 37. Change needle thread to color for the "snowflakes" and sew #19 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the snowflakes. 	Snow Buddies
38. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface, trim all jump thread from the front of the hoop and thread tails from the back of the hoop.	
39. Place the vinyl piece over the BACK of the hoop. Make sure to cover the project.40. Tape in place-all four corners and return hoop to machine.	
41. Sew #20 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the back, vinyl piece to the project.	

42. Remove hoop from machine, place hoop face-up on a flat surface and carefully trim away excess fabric from around the front of the hoop.



43. Turn hoop to back-side and trim away excess vinyl from around the project.



44. Return hoop to machine, change thread to the color you want for the outside border and sew #21 and #22in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will complete the border around the project.




- 45. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
- 46. Trim away all but ¼ inch from around the project.
- 47. Use a wet paper towel or Q-Tip to remove the remaining ¼ inch stabilizer.
- 48. Let dry and your project is ready to use or give to that special someone.






