Instructions



These designs are digitized for 5x7 inch embroidery hoops.
The Chart below shows the filenames, stitch counts and sizes.

NLSEE2168-5x7-Boy	Felt	2 cuts at 3.25 x 4.25 inches
NLSEE2170-5x7-Girl	Felt	2 cuts at 4.75 x 5.5 inches
	Tear-Away Stabilizer	Enough for 5x7 inch embroidery hoop








NLSEE2170-5x7 (Gingerbread-Girl)

Color Sequence:

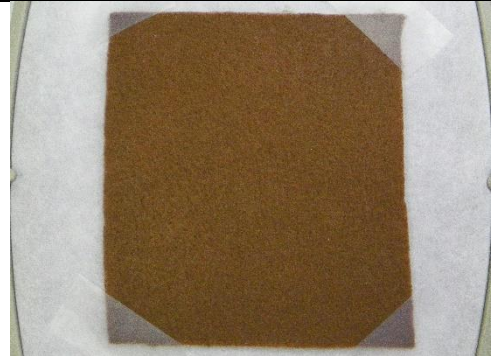


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<p>1. Prepare materials as indicated in the Materials/Cutting Chart above.</p>	
<p>2. Hoop tear-away stabilizer in a 5x7 inch embroidery hoop and attach to embroidery machine. 3. Transfer design (NLSEE2171-5x7) to machine.</p>	

<p>4. Thread bobbin and needle thread to color matching the color of the felt.</p> <p>5. Stitch #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches.</p>	
<p>6. Remove hoop from machine, place on flat surface and place one of the felt pieces over the placement stitches.</p> <p>7. Secure in place at top and bottom of felt with tape.</p>	
<p>8. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the felt to the stabilizer.</p>	
<p>9. Sew #3 through #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. Make sure to change needle thread to correct color, but leave the bobbin thread the same color as the felt. These stitches will complete the front design of the Gingerbread Girl.</p>	
<p>10. Remove hoop from machine, place hoop wrong-side up on a flat surface and trim all thread tails.</p>	

11. Place the second felt piece over the back of the design and use tape to secure all four corners.



12. Change needle thread to the same color as the felt (bobbin thread should still be the same color as felt).
13. Return hoop to machine and sew #7 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will connect the back felt to the front felt. The arm and leg sections will be left open.



14. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
15. Tear away stabilizer.



16. Use sharp scissors and carefully cut around the design, leaving about ¼ inch between the outer stitches and where you cut.



17. Insert Candy Canes and your Gingerbread Girl is complete.

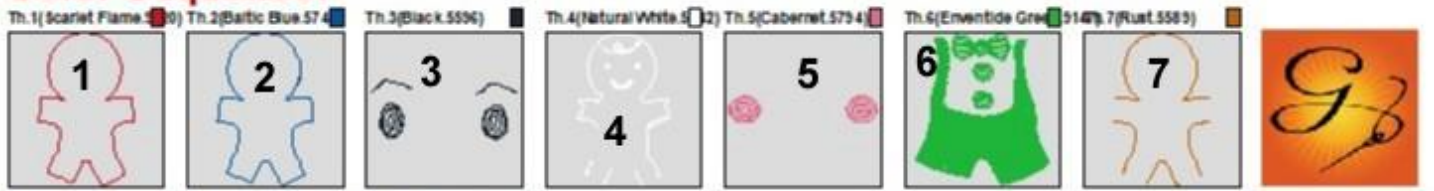


Instructions for Gingerbread Boy (5x7)

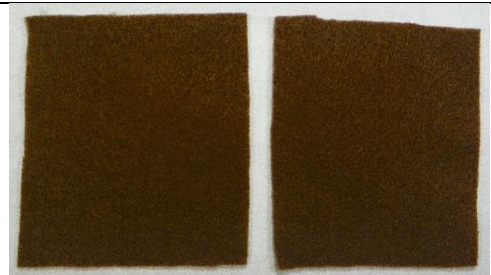

Color Sequence:



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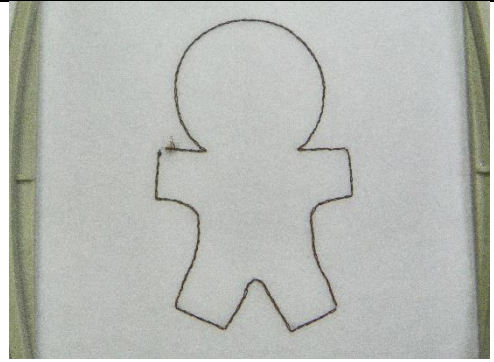
1. Prepare materials as indicated in the Materials/Cutting Chart above.



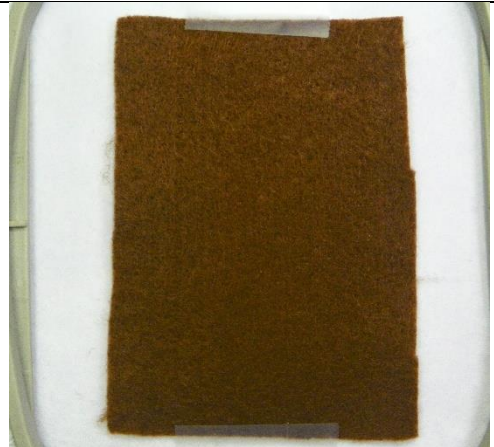
2. Hoop tear-away stabilizer in a 5x7 inch embroidery hoop and attach to embroidery machine.
3. Transfer design (NLSEE2168-5x7) to machine.



4. Thread bobbin and needle thread to color matching the color of the felt.
5. Stitch #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches.



6. Remove hoop from machine, place on flat surface and place one of the felt pieces over the placement stitches.
7. Secure in place at top and bottom of felt with tape.



8. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the felt to the stabilizer.



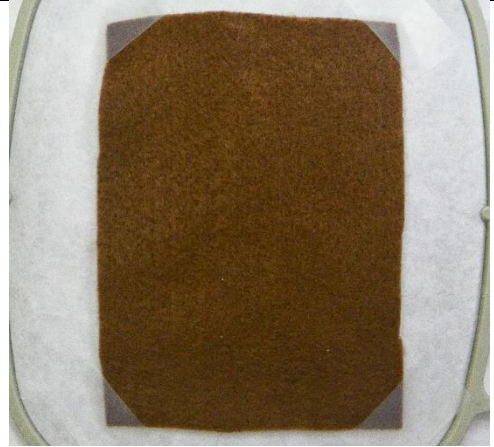
9. Sew #3 through #6 in the Color Sequence chart. Make sure you change needle thread to correct color, but leave the bobbin thread the same color as the felt. These stitches will complete the front design of the Gingerbread Boy.



10. Remove hoop from machine, place hoop wrong-side-up on a flat surface and trim all thread tails.



11. Place the second felt piece over the back of the design and use tape to secure all four corners.



12. Change needle thread to same color as the felt (bobbin thread should still be the same color as the felt).
13. Return hoop to machine and sew #7 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will connect the back felt to the front felt. The arm and leg sections will be left open.



14. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
15. Tear away stabilizer.



16. Use sharp scissors and carefully around the design, leaving about ¼ inch between the outer stitches and where you cut.



17. Insert Candy Canes and your Gingerbread Boy is complete.
