



#### NLSEE2222-4x4

The Color Sequence Chart below will be referenced throughout these instructions.






 Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the "placement stitches" for the gnome.



- 5. Remove hoop from machine, place right side up, on a flat surface.
- 6. Place one of the felt pieces over the "placement stitches" and secure with tape at top and bottom.

7. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the front, felt piece to the stabilizer.



8. Sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the gnome's nose.



9. Sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the gnome's hat.



- 10. Sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart.

  These stitches will create the white part of the Gnomes hat.
- 11. Sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart.
  These stitches will create the gnome's shirt and dots on his hat.




12. Remove hoop from machine, place back-side-up on a flat surface and trim all thread tails.



Thread tails trimmed

- 13. While hoop is still on flat surface (back-side-up) place the second piece of felt over the back of the design. Make sure all areas are covered.
- 14. Return hoop to machine and sew #7 (red thread in needle and bobbin) and #8(White thread in needle and in bobbin) in the in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the back, felt piece to the project.



- 15. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
- 16. Cut away all stabilizer from around the gnome.



17. Using sharp scissors, carefully cut around the gnome, about 1/8 inch outside of the gnome-stitching.




18. Insert candy canes, bottom first through the provided arm-hole openings. Your Candy Cane Gnome is complete.




The **first two steps** and **last two steps** in the Color Sequence Charts are the same so they are sewn in similar fashion to the one outlined in the instructions.
