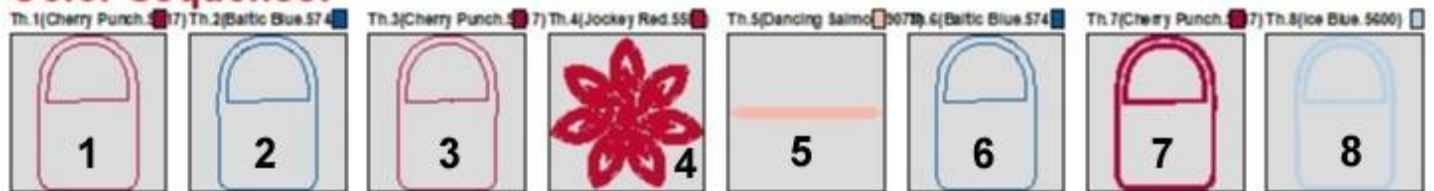


Materials/Cutting Chart

Materials	Cut Size & Number of Cuts
Fabric (Front, Back & Lining)	Cut 4 pieces at 5 x 7.5 inches
Puffy Foam	Cut 1 piece at 5 x 7.5 inches
Heat-N-Bond-Lite	Cut 2 pieces at 5 x 7.5 inches
Water-Soluble Stabilizer	Enough for a 5x7 inch embroidery hoop
Threads of choice	To match/compliment fabric

The Color Sequence Chart below will be referenced throughout these instructions.

Color Sequence:



1. Prepare all cuts as indicated in the **Materials/Cutting Chart** above.

Lining

Puffy Foam

Heat-N-Bond Lite

Front and Back Fabric Pieces



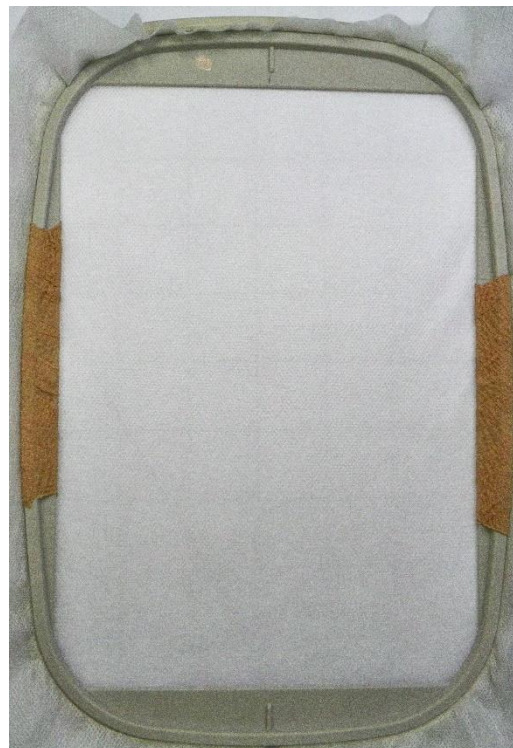
2. Fuse 2 of the fabric pieces for back, wrong sides together with one piece of the Heat-N-Bond Lite.



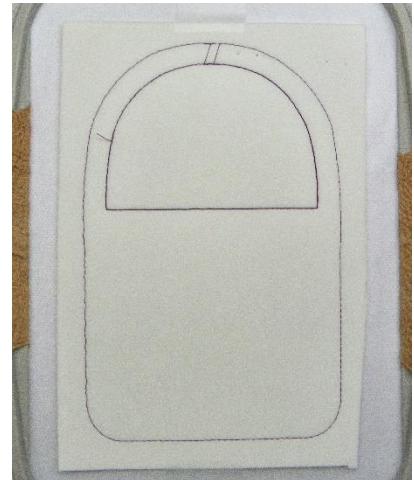
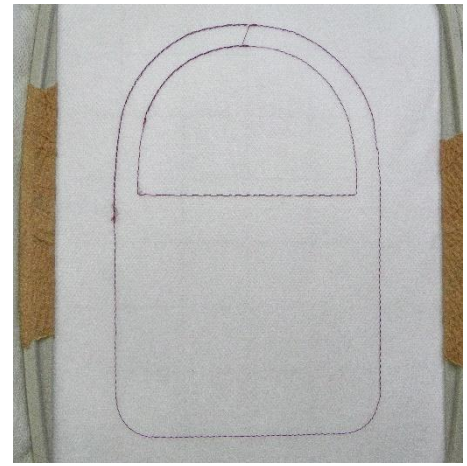
3. Fuse the second piece of the Heat-N-Bond Lite to the wrong side of the remaining front, fabric piece.



4. Hoop water-soluble stabilizer in a 5x7 inch embroidery hoop and attach to embroidery machine.
5. Transfer design (NLS2347-5x7) to embroidery machine.



6. Sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches for the basket.
7. Remove hoop from machine and place the **foam piece** over the placement stitches. Secure with tape at top and bottom.
8. Return hoop to machine and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach foam to stabilizer.
9. Remove hoop from machine, place hoop on flat surface and carefully cut away foam from around the basket and inside of the handle.



10. Remove paper backing from the single, fabric piece and place over the foam. Secure with tape at top and bottom.



11. Return hoop to machine and sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the front, fabric piece to the project.



12. Sew #4 in the Color Sequence chart. These stitches will create the design on the front of the project.



13. Remove hoop from machine, place up-side-down on a flat surface and place the single fabric piece, wrong side down, on the back of the hoop.



14. Secure with tape in all four corners.
15. Return hoop to machine and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the opening through the two, front fabric pieces and the foam.



16. Place the “sandwiched” pieces of outside fabric and lining fabric over the back of the hoop and secure with tape at all four corners.



17. Return hoop to machine and sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach all of the pieces to the basket front.



18. Remove hoop from machine and place on a flat surface.

19. Cut away all fabric from around the project and the fabric inside of the handle.



20. Return hoop to machine and sew #7 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create a satin border around the basket.



21. Sew #8 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create a **motif border** on top of the satin border.



22. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop,
23. Cut away all but $\frac{1}{4}$ of the stabilizer from around the basket and handle.



24. Using sharp scissors or seam ripper, cut through the opening area on front of the basket, do not cut back fabric/lining. Make sure not to cut through the back pieces.



25. Use a wet paper towel to remove remaining stabilizer from around the project.



26. Allow edges to dry and your basket is ready to receive a gift card, candies, notes, or whatever you choose to stuff in the pocket.
