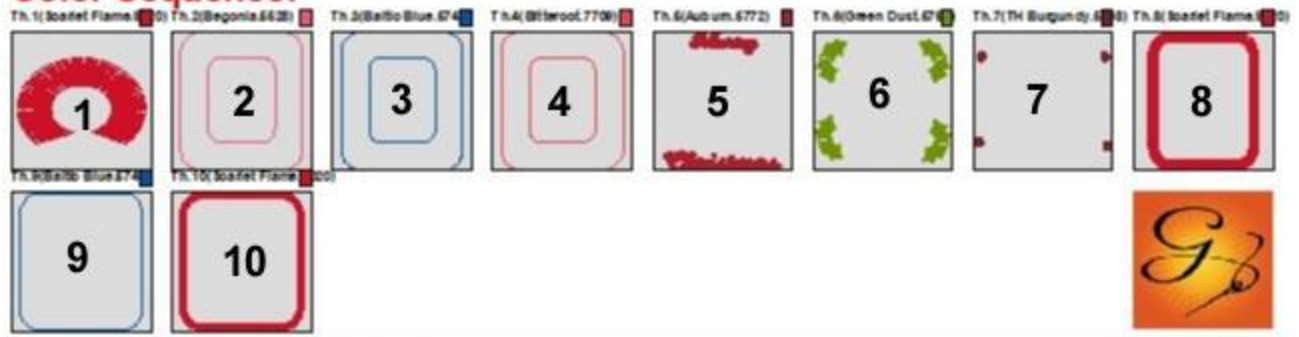

Materials/Cutting Chart-NSLSEE2407-5x7

Materials	Number & Size of Cuts
Front Fabric	1 cut at 5 x 5.25 inches
Back Fabric (Will be folded in half)	1 cut at 5 x 9 inches
Puffy Foam	1 cut at 5 x 5.25 inches
Heat-N-Bond Lite	1 cut at 5 x 5.25 inches 1 cut at 4.5 x 5 inches
Water-Soluble Stabilizer	Enough for a 5x7 inch embroidery hoop

Color Sequence:



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The Color Sequence Chart above will be referenced throughout these instructions.

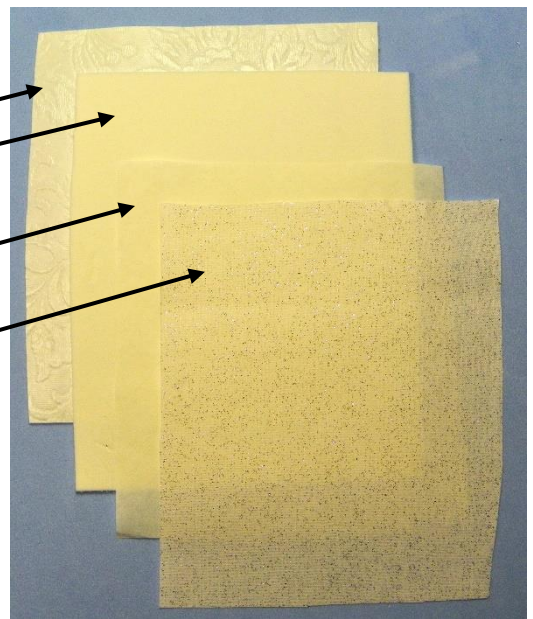
1. Prepare all materials as indicated in the Color Sequence Chart on page 1.

Back Fabric Material (folded)

Puffy Foam

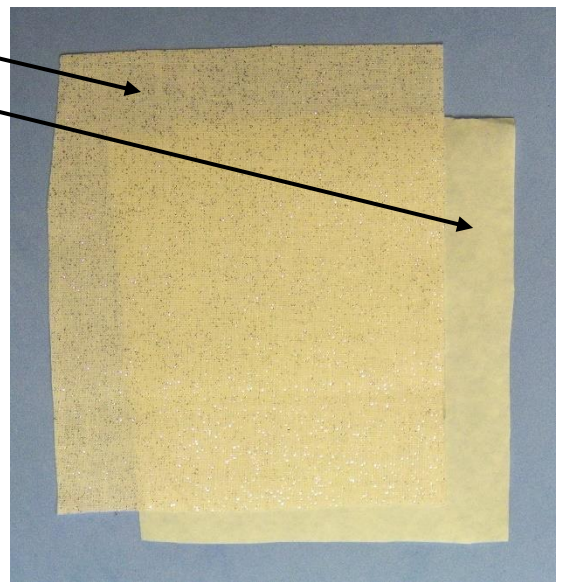
Heat-N-Bond Lite

Front Fabric



Back Fabric (folded)

Heat-N-Bond Lite (4.5 x 5 inches)



2. Fuse the Heat-N-Bond piece (5 x 5.25 Inches) to the back of the front fabric piece.
3. Fold the back fabric piece (5 x 9 inches) in half and fuse the Heat-N-Bond piece (4.5 x 5 inches) to the inside of the folded fabric-wrong sides should be on the inside.
4. Remove the paper backing from the folded piece and fuse to create a "sandwich". Set this piece aside for now.



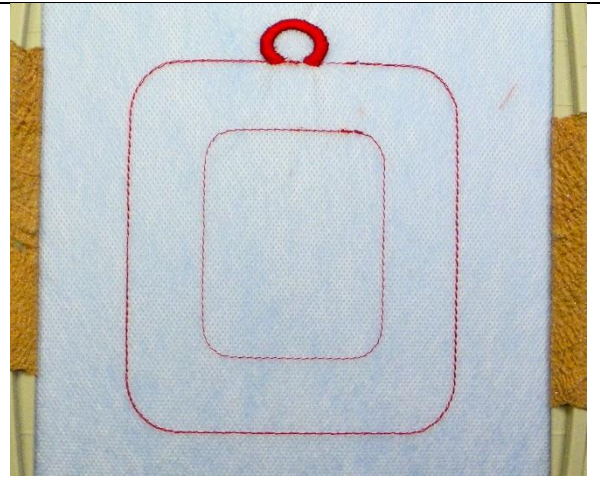
5. Transfer the design file (NLSEE2407-5x7) to your embroidery machine.
6. Hoop water soluble stabilizer in a 5 x 7 inch embroidery hoop and attach to embroidery machine.



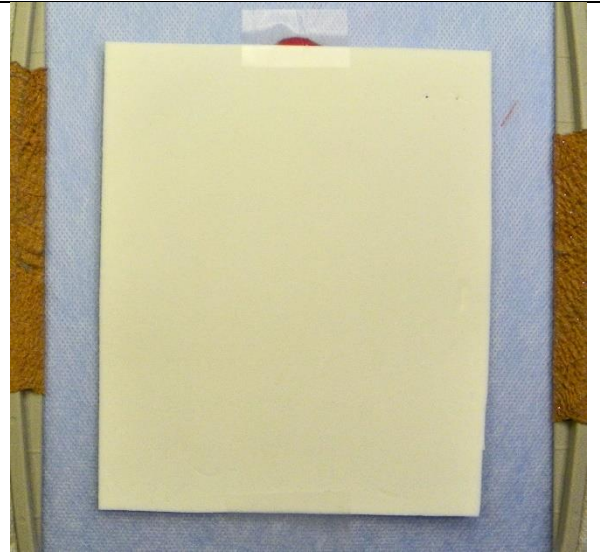
7. Change both needle and bobbin thread to red and sew #1 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the ornament hanger.



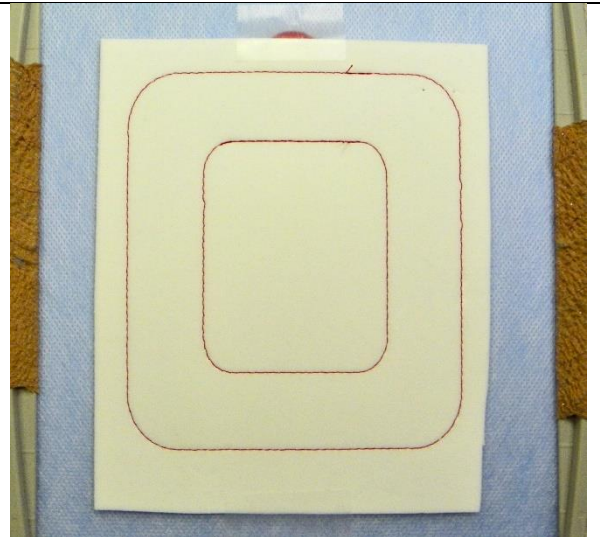
8. Change bobbin thread to white (leave needle thread red) and sew #2 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the placement stitches for the ornament.



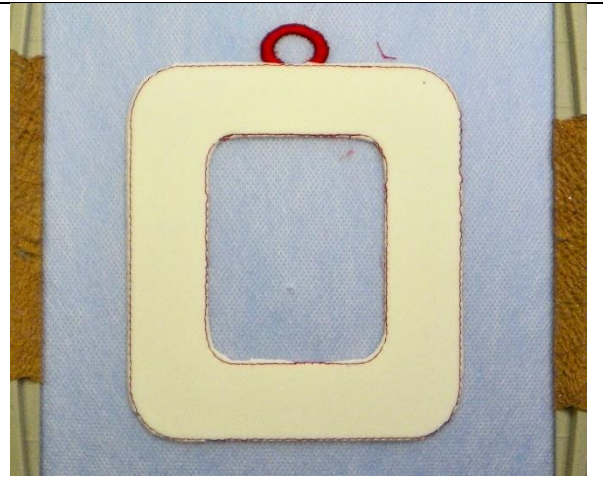
9. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface and place the foam piece over the placement stitches. Tape in place at top and bottom of foam.



10. Return hoop to machine and sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the foam piece to the stabilizer.



11. Remove hoop from machine, and place on a flat surface.
12. Using sharp scissors, carefully cut away excess foam from outside and inside the stitches of the ornament.



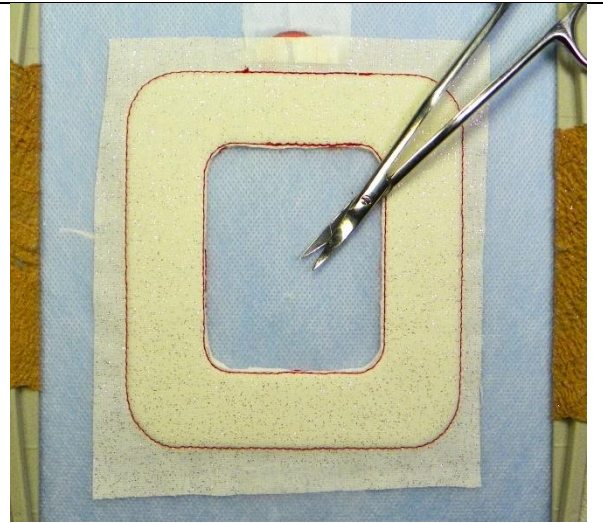
13. Remove paper backing from the front fabric piece.
14. Place fabric, right-side-up, over the foam and tape at top and bottom of the fabric.



15. Return hoop to machine and sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the front, fabric piece to the ornament.



16. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface and, using sharp scissors, remove the fabric piece from the inside of the ornament as shown in photo.



17. Return hoop to machine and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the text of the ornament.



18. Change needle thread to green and sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the holly leaves.



19. Change needle thread to red and sew #7 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the holly berries.



20. Change bobbin thread to red—needle thread should still be red—and sew #8 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin border around the inside of the frame.



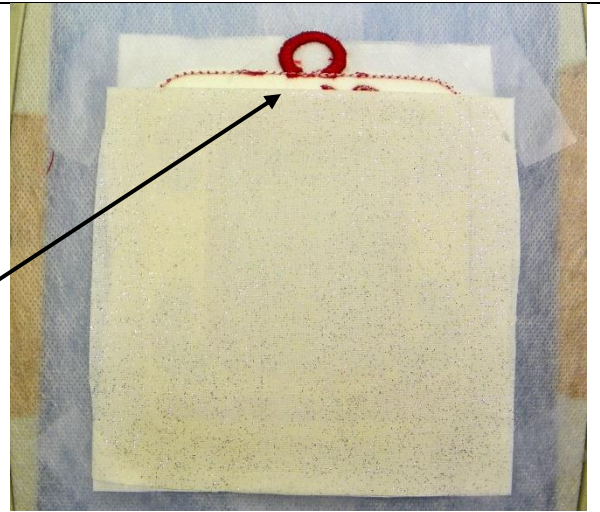
21. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface with back side of the hoop up and trim all thread tails.



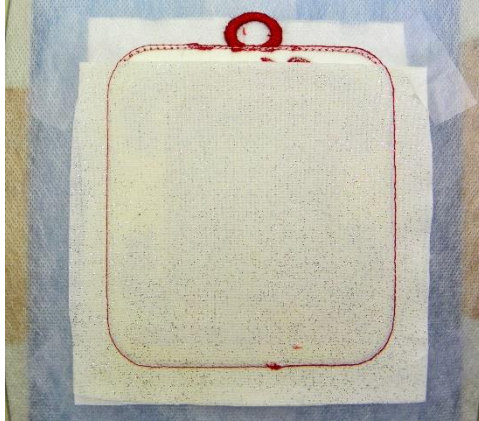
22. Place the “sandwich”, back, fabric piece over the back of the hoop. Make sure the **folded edge** is at least ¼ inch down from the hanger. This is to create the slot the money (or picture) will fit into.

23. Tape in all four corners.

Fold of fabric



24. Return hoop to machine and sew #9 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the back fabric piece to the ornament.



25. Remove hoop from machine, place on flat surface with back of hoop facing up.

26. Using sharp scissors, trim away the excess, back fabric from around the back of the hoop.



27. Turn hoop to right side and trim away excess front fabric from around the front of the ornament.



28. Return hoop to machine and sew #10 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin border around the outside of the ornament. Notice how the back piece was not caught in the satin border.



29. Remove hoop from machine and project from hoop.
30. Trim away all but ¼ inch of stabilizer from around the outside and the inside of the ornament. This ¼ inch will prevent you from cutting the stain borders,
31. Remove the remaining ¼ inch of stabilizer using a folded, wet, paper towel. Rub gently until the stabilizer dissolves.



32. Let the edges dry, insert folded money (or a photo) and the ornament completed.
