



Coffee Cup Pieced Quilt Block

Materials needed

Stabilizer (I prefer a wash a way so that there isn't any stiffness when quilting)

Fabric pieces for design. Background & Cup

Thread that matches your fabric

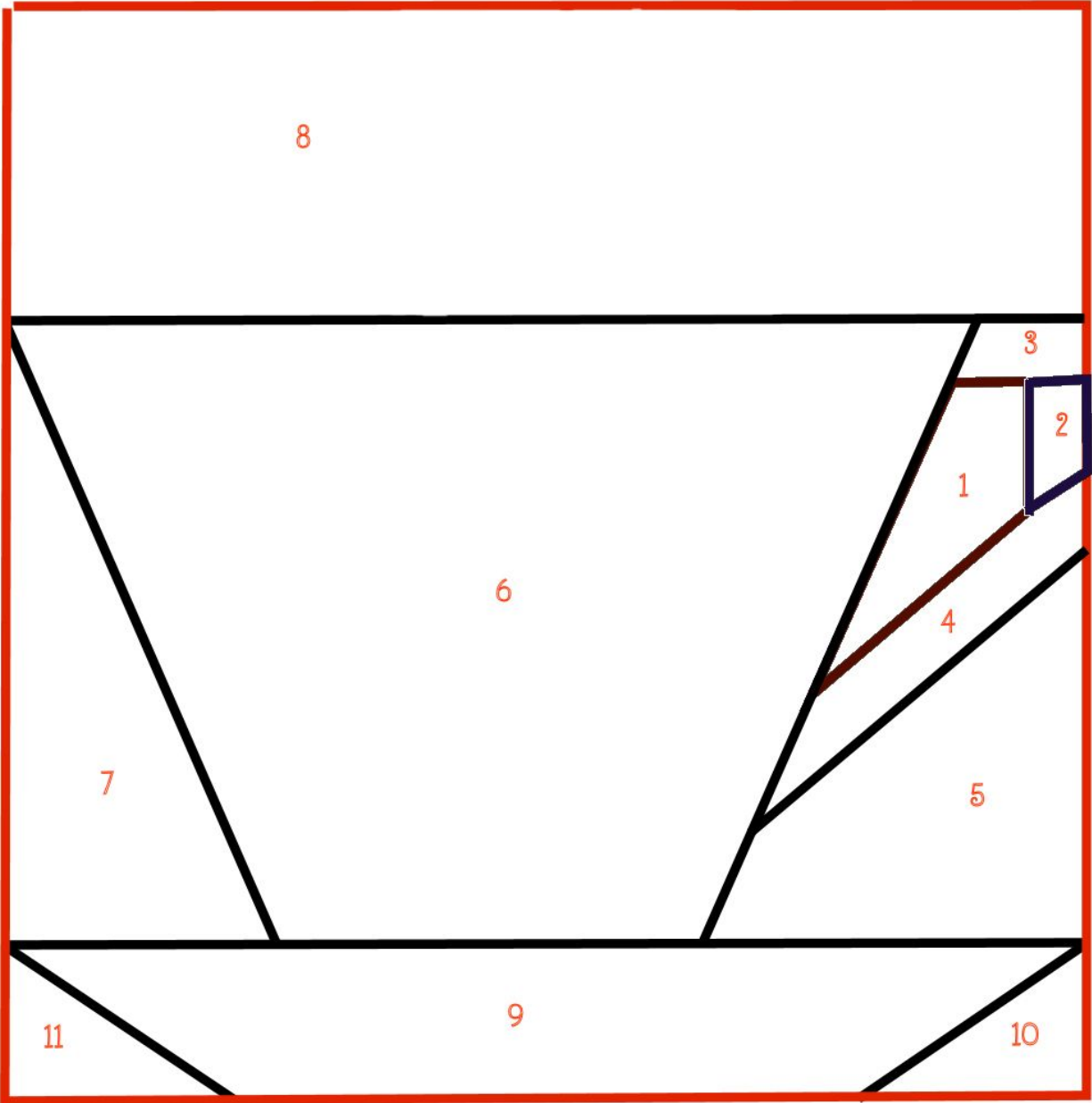
Thread that contrasts for the coffee steam

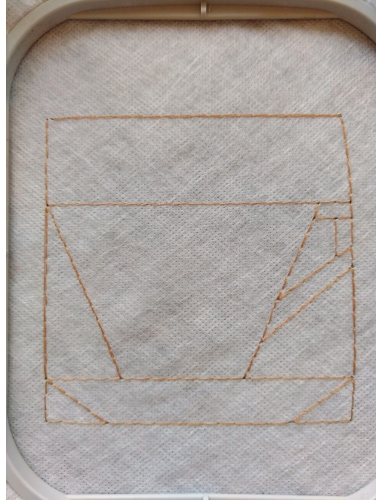
Washable childs glue stick

Print out the reference picture.

ALL can be stitched in the same color. Color changes are for stops only unless specified at the end.

Print out this picture for reference on piecing.





1. Stitch Outline of block pieces onto stabilizer.

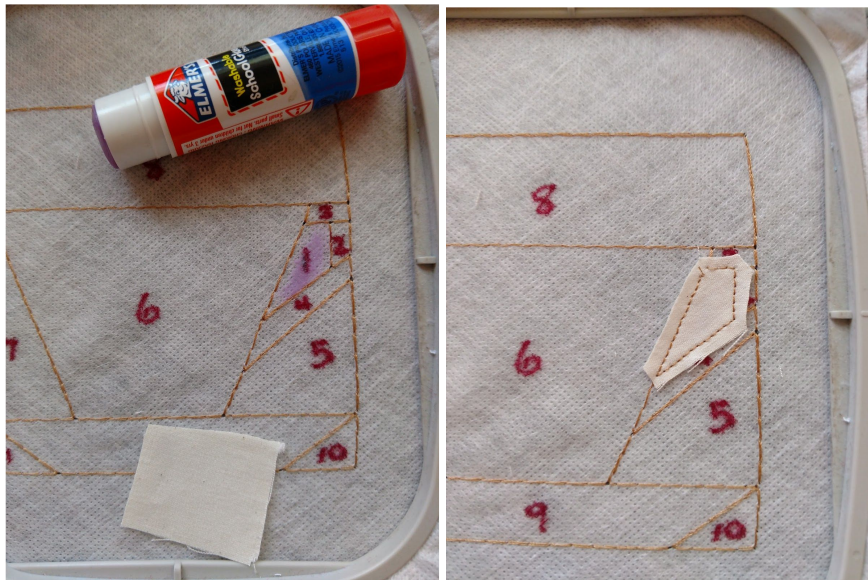
Remove hoop from machine.

I wrote the numbers on the stabilizer for Instructions.

2. Secure or glue a piece of background material over section 1.

Return hoop to machine.

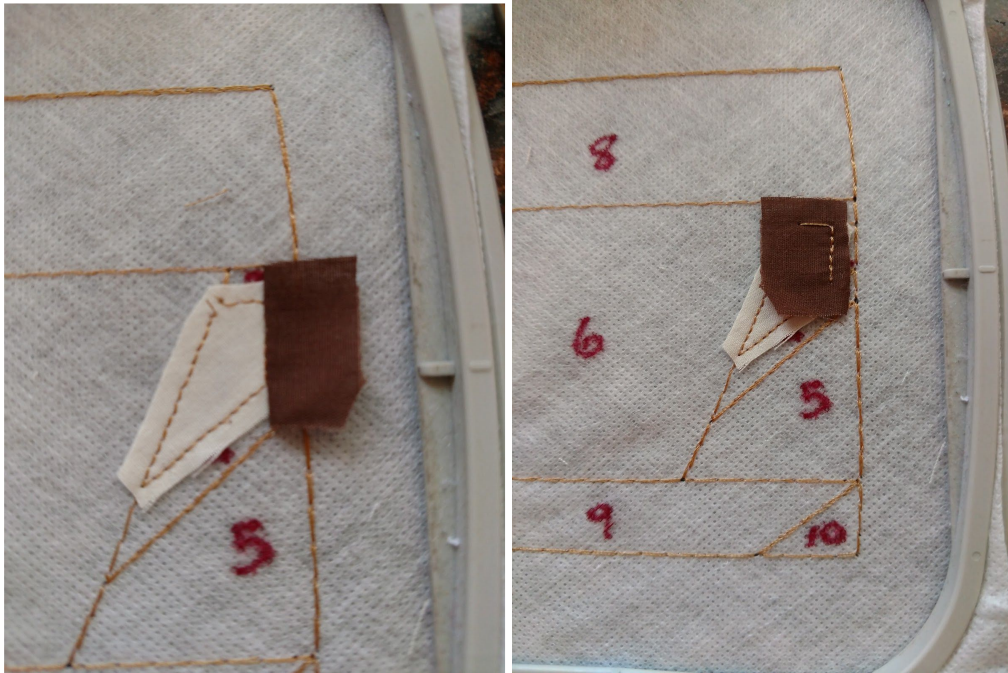
Stitch in place.



3. Remove hoop from machine and trim around area, but not to close. Trim about 1/4" as you would for quilting.

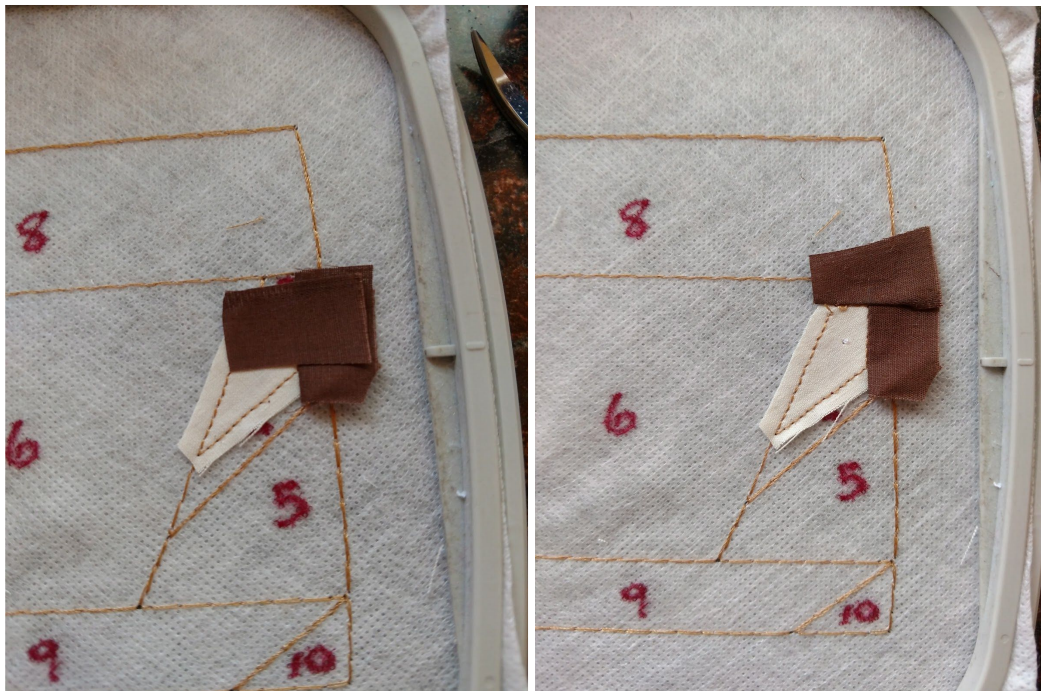
Secure a piece of cup material rightside down over section 1 and overlapping section 2 about a 1/4"

Refer to picture



Stitch the next color

Remove hoop from machine and apply glue stick to section 2, fold the material over and finger press the seam. Make sure it is nice and flat without wrinkles, but not stretched.



Use this procedure sections 3-11.

4. Section 3, Cup material. Place material rightside down over sections 1 & 2, overlapping 1/4"
Stitch.

Trim section 2 on top.

Remove hoop from machine and rub glue stick over section 3 area. Turn material right side up and finger press seam and over glue area.

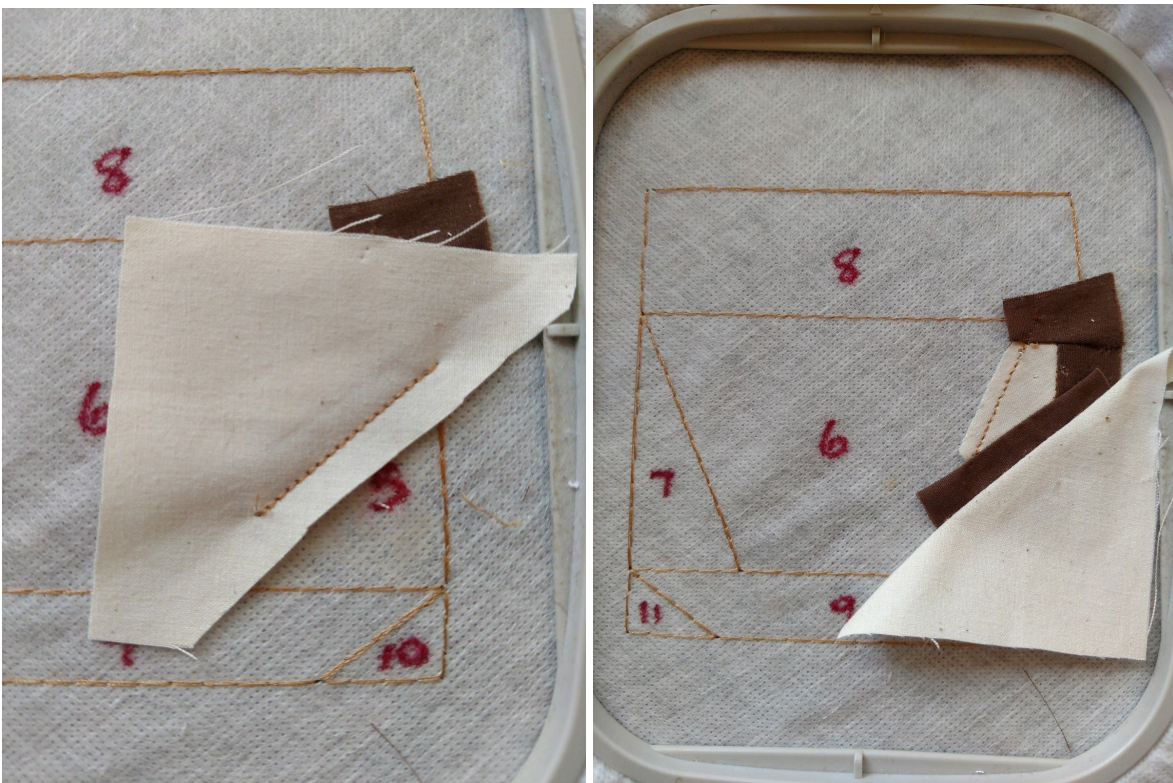
5. Section 4, Cup material

Place a piece of material over sections 1 & 2 right side down.

Stitch

Trim section 2 bottom.

Remove hoop from machine and rub glue stick over section 4 area. Turn material right side up and finger press seam and over glue area.



6. Section 5, Background material

Place a piece of material over section 5 right side down.

Stitch

Trim section 4 bottom.

Remove hoop from machine and rub glue stick over section 5 area. Turn material right side up and finger press seam and over glue area.



7. Section 6, Cup material

Place a piece of material over sections 3,1,4 & 5 right side down.

Stitch

Trim section 1/4 inch along seam line, to include previous sections.

Remove hoop from machine and rub glue stick over section 6 area. Turn material right side up and finger press seam and over glue area.

8. Section 7, Background material

Place a piece of material over sections 6, right side down.

Stitch

Trim section 1/4 inch along seam line, to include previous sections.

Remove hoop from machine and rub glue stick over section 7 area. Turn material right side up and finger press seam and over glue area.



9. Section 8, Background material

Place a piece of material over sections 3 & 6, right side down.

Stitch

Trim section 1/4 inch along seam line, to include previous sections.
Remove hoop from machine and rub glue stick over section 8 area. Turn material right side up and finger press seam and over glue area.

10. Section 9, Cup material

Place a piece of material over sections 7,6 & 5 right side down.

Stitch

Trim section 1/4 inch along seam line, to include previous sections.
Remove hoop from machine and rub glue stick over section 9 area. Turn material right side up and finger press seam and over glue area.

11. Section 10, Background material

Place a piece of material over the right corner of section 9, right side down.

Stitch

Trim section 1/4 inch along seam line, to include previous sections.
Remove hoop from machine and rub glue stick over section 10 area. Turn material right side up and finger press seam and over glue area.

12. Section 11, Background material

Place a piece of material over the left corner of section 9, right side down.

Stitch

Trim section 1/4 inch along seam line, to include previous sections. Remove hoop from machine and rub glue stick over section 11 area. Turn material right side up and finger press seam and over glue area.

14. Make sure that all areas are nicely glued down.

Stitch the basting stitch around design area.13. Color of choice for steam detail

Remove from hoop

You can now make this block into a nice quilt, table runner, placemat or whatever you want to design.

Applique

first 12 colors can be done in the same color thread

1. Placement stitch for cup

Stitch, remove hoop from machine, secure a piece of material over the area, return hoop to machine.

2. Tack down stitch

Stitch, remove hoop from machine, trim around the applique area, trim close, return the hoop to the machine.

3. Zig Zag Tack down stitch.

4. Placement stitch for cup handle

Stitch, remove hoop from machine, secure a piece of material over the area, return hoop to machine.

5. Tack down stitch

Stitch, remove hoop from machine, trim around the applique area, trim close, return the hoop to the machine.

6. Zig Zag Tack down stitch.

7. Placement stitch for saucer

Stitch, remove hoop from machine, secure a piece of material over the area, return hoop to machine.

8. Tack down stitch

Stitch, remove hoop from machine, trim around the applique area, trim close, return the hoop to the machine.

9. Zig Zag Tack down stitch.

10. Placement stitch for Steam

Stitch, remove hoop from machine, secure a piece of material over the area, return hoop to machine.

11. Tack down stitch

Stitch, remove hoop from machine, trim around the applique area, trim close, return the hoop to the machine.

12. Zig Zag Tack down stitch.

13. Satin Outline for Steam, Color of choice.

14. Satin Outline for Cup, handle and saucer. Color of choice.
