MINI FSL CHARMS/EARRINGS/PENDANTS



For all the designs basic method would be same-

- 1. Hoop 2 layers of wash away stabilizer, the fibrous type is best. I recommend Vilene. (Make sure its hooped drum tight)
- 2. Try and use the smallest hoop which can accommodate the pieces you wish to embroider.
- 3. As with all free standing lace, you need to use the same thread in the bobbin as the top thread.

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(So you will keep changing the bobbins when you use multiple colors in a design, however for very little details you may skip it)

- 4. Polyester thread works best for FSL.
- 5. Slow down the speed if your thread breaks.
- 6. Make sure the thread tension is perfectly set and you have a nice fresh needle.
- 7. Once you complete the pieces, remove and unhoop. Trim away all the excess stabilizer and then rinse the pieces under running water till all the stickiness is cleared.
- 8. Lay them on a paper towel and dry them flat.
- 9. Decorate using beads, pearls. Rhinestones or whatever you desire.
- 10. Use them as earrings, pendants, key chains, zipper pulls, tags, and ornaments for decoration!
