



Trapunto



- 1) Cutaway Stabilizer
- 2) Batting (Thin)
- 3) Polyester Batting (Thick)
- 4) Water-soluble Stabilizer
- 5) Fabric
- 6) Embroidery Thread
- 7) Scissor
- 8) Bobbin

Hoop Cutaway Stabilizer

- Stitch out the Marker line on the Stabilizer
- Lay down your batting (thin) and stitch around
Cut away the edges around the batting



- Lay down the polyester batting (thick) and on top water-soluble stabilizer to prevent the needle from getting stuck in the batting



- **Different thread colors are used for the machine to stop. You only use one color as you go**
- Stitch out the outline of the design
- Cut away the polyester batting around each design, just like applique
- Place desired fabric on top of the batting
- Set your machine speed to slow.
- Stitch around the fabric to secure the design
- Continue with the pattern around the designs. **WATCH** out for jump stitches, if any Stop the machine in time to cut the jump stitch. This only happens on some machines
- Continue to stitch out the designs
- Stitch around for seam (zig-zag)
- Stitch around the trapunto.
