## POTW – 3D Fairies!!

What a delightful set Marlene has created for you this week! These cute-as-a-button fairies can be stitched – as a normal design OR you can take it one step further and a little embroidered dress for a 3D effect!

All designs fit the  $4\times4$  hoop.

Wings and Fairies with and without 3-D Dresses

Hoop organdy or nylon over your fabric and stabilizer



Sew the first outline. Take the hoop out of the machine (do not unhoop) and carefully trim close to the edge.




Place back in the machine and sew the remainder or the design.

Fairies with 3-D dresses: (Dress pattern "Dress")

Hoop a clear stabilizer along with organdy or nylon.



Sew dress up to the single stitch outline. Take out of the machine and trim closely.



Place back into the machine and sew the remainder of the dress. When done, unhoop and cut around design.

## (Fairy pattern "Girl")

Next: Follow the instructions as above for the Wings and Fairies. Stop when you finish sewing the solid dress. This should leave you two colors.

Take hoop out of the machine and position the dress, matching the bottom and sides to the solid dress on the fairy.



Tape one side at a time, leaving the center of the dress in a slight mound.



KEEP FINGERS AWAY FROM THE DESIGN WHEN DOING THE TACKDOWN.

Sew the next color (single stitch tackdown) Take out of the machine and carefully remove tape and trim closely around the dress.



Place back in the machine and complete the design.
