## **POTW - Spring Bowls**

#### **Materials:**

tear away stabilizer, med or heavy thread to match colors cloth to match project. 14 pieces approx 4 1/2 " square Mylar applique scraps

#### General instructions for each piece

#### placement stitch:

stitches out an outline. This can be cut out for and stitched again or after stitching, place material over the top of the stitching line. I prefer a child's washable glue stick to secure in place.(the child's washable glues stick does not gum up the needle like some adhesives)

#### tack down stitch:

this tacks down the applique material, or Mylar.

after stitching remove from hoop and carefully trim around material getting as close as you can without cutting thread.

#### Zig zag tack down stitch:

this makes a good zig zag stitch around raw edges to secure them.

#### **Bottom of Piece:**

remove Hoop from Machine (DO NOT REMOVE MATERIAL FROM HOOP) with glue stick, glue material to the bottom of the design area. This will be the inside of the bowl material, or outside, you choose.

return hoop to machine and stitch the tack down stitch.

remove hoop from machine, turn over and carefully trim around material return hoop to machine and continue with design.

- 4. placement stitch for mylar Egg
- 5. tack down stitch for mylar
- 6. fill stitch for mylar
- 7. outline stitch for mylar

Colors 8-10 can be done in the same color as satin outline

(see general instructions for bottom of piece.)

- 8. tack down for back of design
- 9. zig zag tack down for back of design
- 10. Satin Stitch for around entire outside of design.

- 6. zig zag tack down for back of design

colors 1-3 can be done in same color as satin outline

- 8. dark green stems
- 9. light green leaves
- 10. green leaves

Colors 11 - 13 can be done in the same color as satin outline

(see general instructions for bottom of piece.)

- 11. tack down for back of design
- 12. zig zag tack down for back of design
- 13. Satin Stitch for around entire outside of design.

Side of bowl is now complete.

colors 1-3 can be done in same color as satin outline

- 13. zig zag tack down for back of design
- 14. Satin Stitch for around entire outside of design.

- 5. tack down stitch for Mylar
- 6. fill stitch for Mylar
- 7. outline stitch for Mylar

colors 8 - 10 can be done in same color or contrast color for mylar

- 8. placement stitch for Mylar (chick head)
- 9. tack down stitch for Mylar
- 10. fill stitch for Mylar
- 11. outline stitch for Mylar
- 12. white eyes
- 13. orange beak
- 14. black pupils

Colors 15-17 can be done in the same color as satin outline

(see general instructions for bottom of piece.)

- 15. tack down for back of design
- 16. zig zag tack down for back of design
- 17. Satin Stitch for around entire outside of design.
