New Years Banner

SUPPLIES:

Fabric (Cut a little bigger than your hoop)

You need 2 pieces of fabric for each banner.

threads to match of your choice

Med. tear-a-way or Cut-a-way

Ribbon for ties

All Banners with letters are done in the same order

Banner Letter Directions

Hoop tear-a-way in hoop and place on machine.

CC1 - placement

Lay Fabric right side up over top so that it covers the placement stitching leaving excess cover over hoop.

- CC2 this will stitch down the fabric in place
- CC3 Your Choice Color Letter
- CC4 white line on letter
- CC5 Your Choice Color stars

Then lay second piece of fabric right side facing down over hoop and stitch CC6.

This will join the front to back of the banner leaving a area open so it can be turned right side out.

Remove from hoop and trim close to stitching line(except where you turn it) and then turn it right side out through the opening. Press raw edges inside and then stitch close, add ribbon at each top corners so you can tie the banners together.

Then lay second piece of fabric right side facing down over hoop and stitch CC8.

This will join the front to back of the banner leaving a area open so it can be turned right side out.

Remove from hoop and trim close to stitching line(except where you turn it) and then turn it right side out through the opening. Press raw edges inside and then stitch close, add ribbon at each top corners so you can tie the banners together.
