Guidelines for embroidery of a Christmas Boot


1. Fix the detachable stabilizer in the hoop; prepare flaps of multi-colored fabrics and threads for machine embroidery.




- 2. Embroider the first color on the stabilizer. This is the outline of a boot.
- 3. Attach the main fabric to the contour face up and embroider the next color that will attach the main fabric to the stabilizer. Embroider the contour of the attachment of the first color cut immediately.



4. Attach the fabric to the contour.



5. Embroider the next color attaching the color cut to the main fabric.




6. Trim excess fabric close to the line. On the sides, you may not cut the allowances close, as they will be in the side seams.



7. We work with the next cut of the colored fabric similarly, repeating points 3-6.










- 8. Repeat these steps with the remaining colored cuts of the fabric, according to the project.
- 9. When all the scraps are sewn, decorative stitching is performed.



10. We put the fabric on top of the face inside - this is the back of the toy.



11. Embroider the connecting line. Remove the embroidery from the Hoop



12. To make the finished boot look neat, it is better to make a lining for it. To do this, fix the detachable stabilizer into the Hoop, take two pieces of fabric, fold the front sides inside and embroider the design of the lining fastening these parts together.



13. Take the embroidery from the Hoop, remove the stabilizer and trim the excess fabric along the contour.



14. Turn out the boot on the front side; do not turn out the lining; conduct a wet heat treatment.



15. Insert the lining into the boot, straighten carefully.



16. Combine the upper sections by fixing them with plastic clips or laying a basting seam.



17. Sew manually the boot with the lining, conduct a wet heat treatment and decorate it.

Guidelines for embroidery of a Christmas toy Heart in the patchwork style

Christmas toy Tree in the patchwork style is embroidered on the same way.

Prepare a tear-off stabilizer, cuts of multi-colored fabrics, and threads for machine embroidery.

Fix the detachable stabilizer in the Hoop.

1. Embroider the first color on the stabilizer; this is the contour of the heart and the place where the main fabric is attached to.



2. Attach the main fabric to the contour and sew the next color.



3. Embroider the next color; this is the contour of the attachment of a colored piece of fabric.



4. Apply the fabric along the contour.



5. Make a connecting line.



6. Trim excess fabric close to the line. On the sides, you may not cut the allowances close, as they will be in the side seams.





7. We work with the next cut of the colored fabric similarly, repeating points 3-6.








- 8. Repeat these steps with the remaining colored cuts of the fabric, according to the project.
- 9. When all the cuts are sewn and the decorative finishing line is made, you can sew a decorative cord for the loop. Attach the cord loop inside with masking tape, which is then easy to remove.



10. We put the fabric on top of the face inside - this is the back of the toy



11. Embroider the connecting line.



12. Take the embroidery from the Hoop, remove the stabilizer and trim the excess fabric along the contour



13. Turn the toy on the front side



14. Conduct a wet-heat treatment, turning the allowances of the fabric of the hole for stuffing inside.

Fill the toy with any volume filler and sew up the hole.

Guidelines for embroidery of a Christmas toy Star

Prepare a tear-off stabilizer, a cut of multi-colored fabrics, threads for machine embroidery.



1. Fix the detachable stabilizer in the Hoop. Embroider the first color on the stabilizer (this is the outline of the star) and the place where the main fabric is attached.



2. Attach the main fabric to the contour. Embroider the next color; this is the contour of the attachment of a colored piece of the fabric.



3. Attach the fabric to the contour.



4. Make a connecting line.



5. Trim excess fabric close to the line. You may not cut the allowances close on the sides, as they will be in the side seams.




6. We work with the next cut of the colored fabric similarly, repeating points 2-5.









- 7. Repeat these steps with the remaining colored cuts of the fabric, according to the project.
- 8. When all the scraps are sewn, decorative stitching is performed.



9. If the toy is planned for the Christmas tree, you can sew a decorative cord for the loop. Attach the cord loop inside with masking tape, which is then easy to remove.



10. We put the fabric on top of the face inside - this is the back of the toy.



11. Embroider the connecting line



12. Remove the embroidery from the Hoop, remove the stabilizer and trim the excess fabric along the contour.



13. Turn the toy on the front side.



14. Do a wet-heat treatment, turning the allowances of the fabric of the hole for stuffing inside.

Fill the toy with any volume filler and sew up the hole.
