Provence-style bike.

This embroidery is quite dense. It's better to use cotton or linen fabrics (cotton/linen is used on the presented sample). Fabric is glued with filmoplast. There is a tear-off stabilizer in the hoop and thermally degradable foil on the top. For embroidering some FSL flowers use a watersoluble stabilizer. If your watersoluble stabilizer is not dense enough, use two layers.

1. Embroider FSL flowers. Flowers can be made colorful or in one color scheme, according to your taste.



2. Wash the water-soluble stabilizer and dry the flowers.



3. Fix tear-off stabilizer in the hoop. The fabric needs to be glued with filmoplast from the inside. You can use thermally degradable foil on the top. The fabric is put on the stabilizer fixed in the hoop. Fix the fabric with glue-spray or with basting stitch.



4. Embroider the first 10 colors of the design.



5. Next, prepare the flowers for sewing. Apply the flower to the place of sewing and make a fastening stitch. Sew all the flowers consistently in this way. The 11-17 colors in the design are made in different color only for the embroidery machine to make a stop so you could fasten the next flower.



6. Embroider the middles of the flowers.



You can skip steps 5-6 and sew flowers by hand, using beads or paillettes.

7. Admire the finished result!
