Brooch-holder for baby's dummy

The brooch is attached to the baby's clothes, preventing it from falling out of the stroller while walking.

1 Prepare the necessary materials. Felt, thread, ribbon-band for pacifier, contact tape (velcro) and tear-off stabilizer in the hoop.



2 Embroidery start with stitching Velcro on the back side of the brooch holder.

Put a tear-off stabilizer in the hoop, fix felt on the temporary fixation glue, and sew a contour

Attach one of the parts of the velcro to the contour line and embroider the next color that will fasten the velcro

3 Remove excess velcro. Remove the embroidery from the hoop, remove excess stabilizer.



4 Next, the front side of the brooch is embroidered.



Fasten the tear-off stabilizer into the hoops, put a new piece of felt on the temporary fixation glue for embroidery of the front part. Embroidery the contour stitch to fix the felt and embroider the design.

5 Remove the hoop from the carriage and turn the hoop, from the wrong side to the textile glue, fasten the tape, the ends of the tape, outside the embroidery area, fasten with tape (to avoid slipping the ribbon and getting it under the embroidery)




6 From the wrong side of the hoop, put on of the temporary fixation glue and fix the reverse side of the brooch holder. making sure that the area with the sewn tape is in the middle of the brooch. Then embroider the contour lines. You can use one of the contour lines, but for reliability and accuracy both are better.



Remove the finished embroidery from the hoop, remove excess stabilizer, and also very carefully remove excess felt at the edges, in order to avoid cutting the band in the area of attachment.

Remove felt in layers - separately from the front and back side. The edges can be processed with a lighter flame, then the edges of the brooch will be smoother and more beautiful.

Conduct wet-heat treatment brooch. Secure the baby's dummy to the tape.



The second part of the velcro is attached to the clothes of the baby, and the brooch-holder is attached to it.

This example describes one of the options for attaching a brooch to clothes, but they can be varied. This design can be used not only as a holder for a pacifier, but also as an decoration.

Option 2:

All stages of the process, as in the first version, the difference is that a loop is added for attaching the ribbon with a baby,s dummy. Thanks to this option, the brooch becomes more functional, like a brooch-holder, and like a brooch-patch.

Embroidery start with stitching Velcro on the back side of the brooch holder.

1 Embroider the contour of the square



2 To this square, with the help of textile glue, fasten a piece of tape 7cm., Folded in half, forming a loop, which should protrude beyond the contour of the square by 0.7cm. Then in the finished product, this loop will not be noticeable.



3 From above we impose the first part of a contact tape, and we sew the fixing lines.




4 Remove excess contact tape along the contour. And removes the workpiece from the hoop.



Then everything is done as in the first embodiment.

In the hoop we fix the stabilizer and embroider the front part of the brooch. Before the contour lines (they are in design 4 and 5), remove the hoop from the carriage, and turn them over, on the wrong side, with temporary fixation glue, fasten the blank of the back side of the brooch. Carefully we watch that the eyelet does not get into the contour line, for reliability it can be fixed, lifting to the top, with masking tape. Embroider the contour and remove excess felt.

6 The front side of the brooch, eyelet does not look out. This is an option for a patch patch.



7 This is the variant of the pacifier-holder, if necessary, the pacifier is always easy to remove along with the tape.
