
Stitched Out Design

Materials / Cutting Chart

Materials	Number & Size of Cuts
Fabric for Front	1 cut at 5.75 x 5.75 inches
Felt-Backed Tablecloth Vinyl	1 cut at 5.75 x 5.75 inches
Heat-N-Bond Lite	1 cut at 5.75 x 5.75 inches
Puffy Foam	1 cut at 5.75 x 5.75 inches
Water-Soluble Stabilizer (Cloth Type-Pelon, 541,	Enough for a 5x7 inch
Wash-N-Gone from Joann's works great.)	embroidery hoop

The Color Sequence Chart below will be referenced throughout these instructions.





8. Remove hoop from machine, place on a flat surface and carefully cut away excess foam from around the outside of the stitches. 9. Using a hot iron, press the Heat-N-Bond Lite to the back of the front, fabric piece. 10. When cool enough to touch, remove the paper backing from the fabric and place the fabric over the foam piece. 11. Secure with tape at top and bottom. < 12. Return hoop to machine and sew #3 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the front fabric to the project. -13. Change needle thread to green; bobbin can still be white. 14. Sew #4 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the green part of the front design.

15. Change needle thread to gold and sew #5 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the remainder of text of the design.



16. Change needle thread to red and sew #6 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the heart.



17. Remove hoop from machine, place hoop face down on flat surface (back of hoop facing upward) and trim all thread tails.



18. Place the Felt-Backed, vinyl, tablecloth piece over the back of the hoop-line it up with the front fabric piece.

19. Secure with tape in all four corners.

- 20. Return hoop to machine.
- 21. Change needle thread to white and sew #7 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will attach the vinyl backing to the project.



22. Remove hoop from machine, place up-side-down on a flat surface and using sharp scissors, carefully cut away excess vinyl from around the outside of the stitches.



23. Turn hoop over (right side up) and using sharp scissors, carefully cut away excess front fabric from around the outside of the stitches.



24. Return hoop to machine and sew #8 in the Color Sequence Chart. These stitches will create the satin border around the project.
