Guidelines for embroidering design Calla lilies FSL

Using this design you can create earrings, a ring, a pendant, a hair clip or a brooch.

In this manual I will show you two options for assembling earrings; one ordinary is two identical earrings and the other is a more modern and fashionable option – two different earrings (a leaf and a flower).

- Put a dense water-soluble stabilizer into the hoop (if your stabilizer is not dense enough, use two layers of stabilizer)
 The stabilizer should be well stretched in the hoop, should not have waves and folds, and should be quite dense.
- 2. The lower thread should be of the same color as the upper one to get a beautiful embroidery result
- 3. Embroider the design



4. Remove the embroidery from the hoop, cut the excess stabilizer off, wash the stabilizer out





5. Dry and shape the petals (no need to make them very straight, it is better to form small curves, then you will get a more natural look after drying)


Usually, after washing out the stabilizer in very warm water, the petals acquire natural curves, slightly bending. Try to maintain this look, help a little to form more natural curves with your hands. Do not wash the stabilizer too much, so that the earrings hold their shape after drying and remain "starched".




6. If you decide to make different earrings: embroider the middle of the flower with beads and sew it to the center of the petal (we sew only the beginning of the middle, just to fix it on the petal). We sew the base of the petal (connecting its sides), as shown on the pic. Then you need to make holes with an awl in the petal and leaf and attach the connectors and seams. With this method of attaching the connector, you just push the stitches a little, so it is completely safe, and the embroidery will not dissolve.




















7. If you want to make a variant of the same earrings: embroider the middle of the flowers with beads and sew them to the center of the petals (we sew only the beginning of the middle, just to fix it on the petal). We sew the base of the petal (connecting its sides), as shown on the pic. Then we sew the base of the flower to the middle of the leaf and also sew the base of the leaf (connecting its sides), as shown on the pic.

Then you need to make holes with an awl in the leaf and attach the connectors and seams. With this method of attaching the connector, you just push the stitches a little, so it is completely safe, and the embroidery will not dissolve.
