Guidelines for embroidering design Earrings FSL Fuchsia

You will need: a dense water-soluble stabilizer, threads, scissors, ear wires and connectors for jewelry.

- Put a dense water-soluble stabilizer into the hoop (if your stabilizer is not thick enough, use two layers folded in perpendicular directions to each other and fasten them together with a small amount of glue-spray) The stabilizer should be well stretched in the hoop, should not have waves and folds, and should be quite dense.
- 2. Embroider the designs. The lower thread should be of the same color as the upper one to get a beautiful embroidery resul.
- 3. Remove the embroidery from the hoop, cut the excess stabilizer off, wash the stabilizer out. While drying, immediately shape the parts into the desired shape. The lower petals and stamens should be facing downward. The upper petals (four-leaf) look up and to the sides. And the two-leaf will point up. Connectors and hooks will be attached to it.

When the details are washed out in warm water, the petals acquire natural curves, leave them and do not straighten the petals too much, so that the flowers look as natural as possible.


Assembling the flower:

All parts are stitched in the center. You can also decorate the middle with beads or rhinestones.

- 1. Stamens
- 2. Small petals
- 3. Large petals
- 4. Four-leaf
- 5. Two-leaf

The parts are sewn together in this order. For more details, see the photo below.
