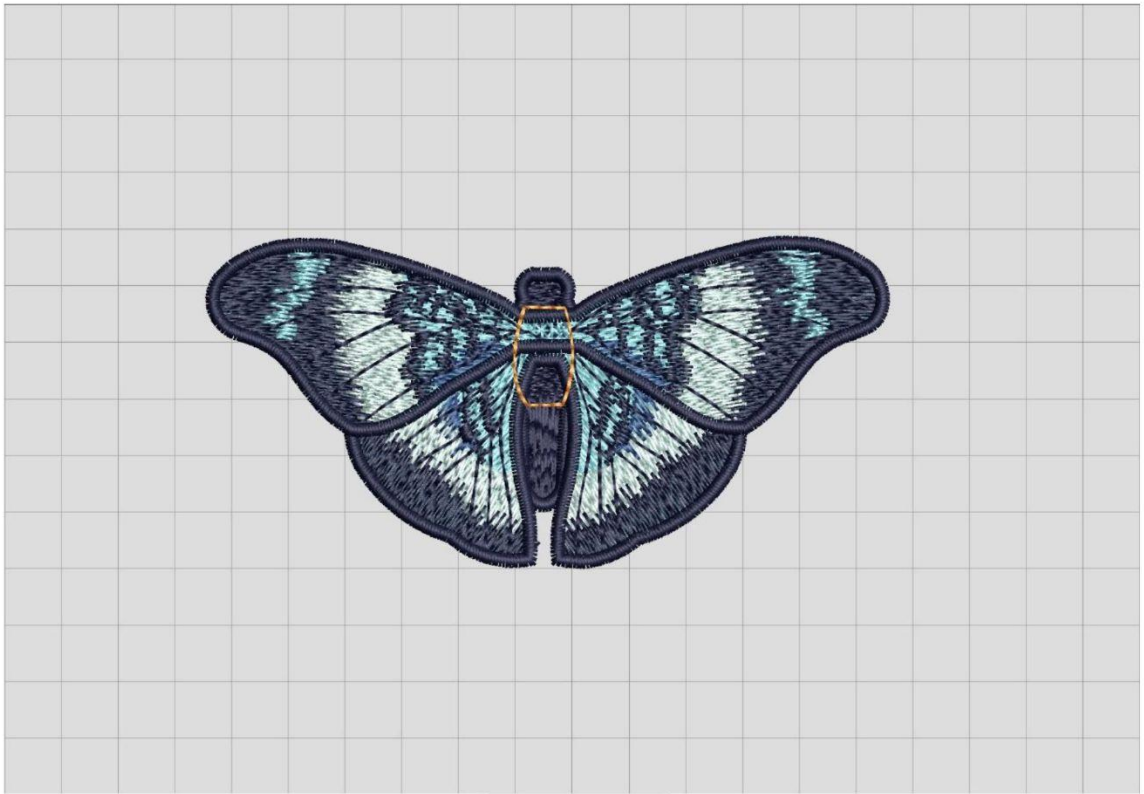
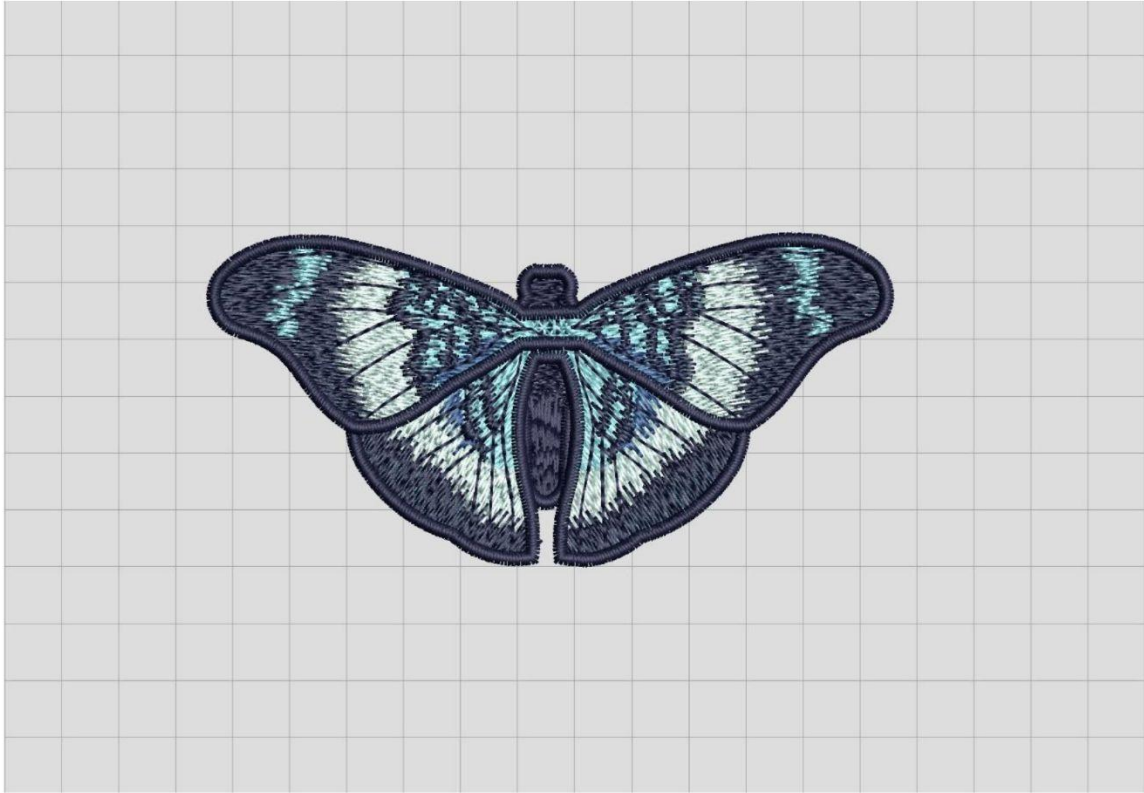


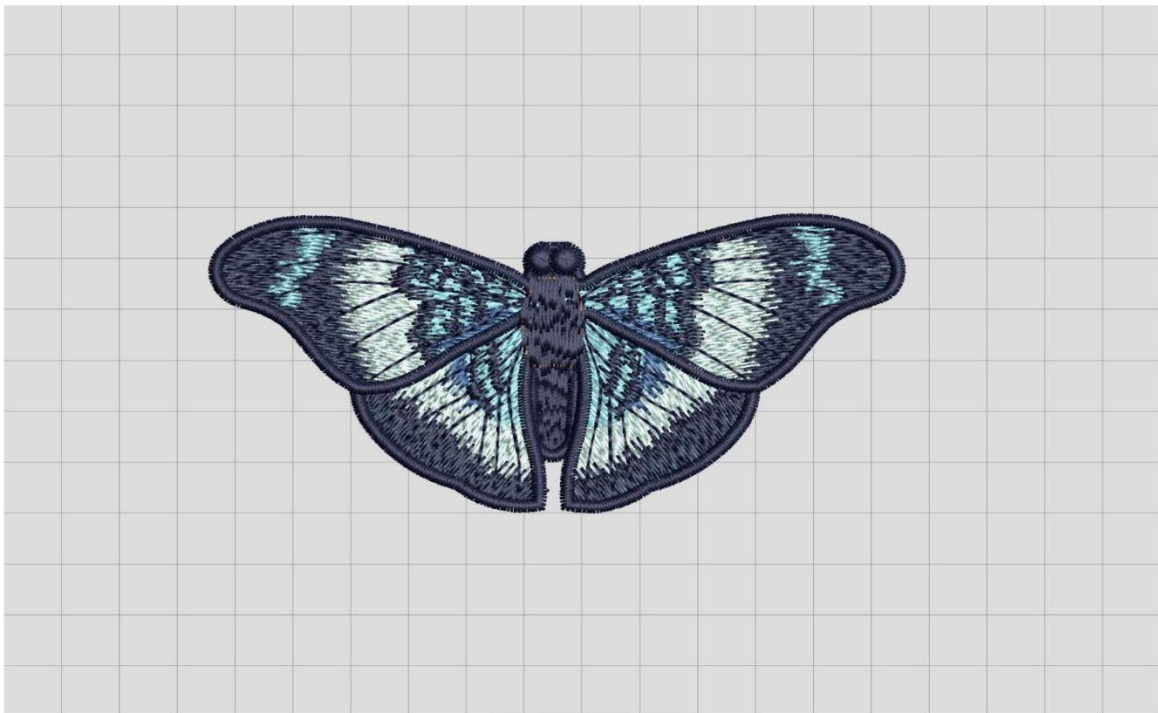
Guidelines for embroidering jewelry set design FSL "Butterflies Earrings and necklace"

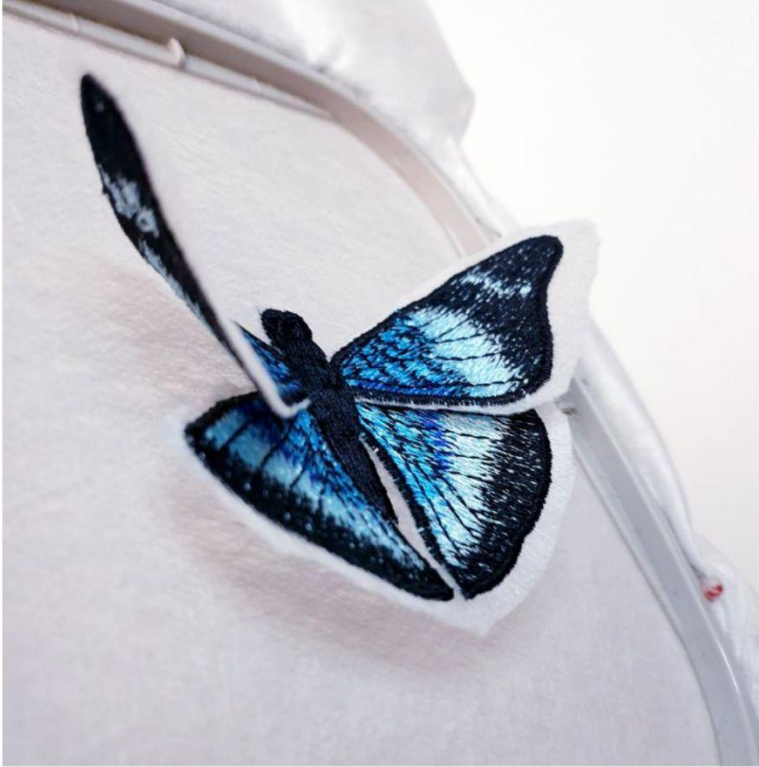
You can also make not only a necklace or a pendant, but also a brooch or a hair clip. To do this, you will not need to make holes for the connectors, instead, fix a mount or a lock on the back of the butterfly's body (it can be glued or sewed).

1. Put a dense water-soluble stabilizer in the hoop. If your stabilizer is not dense enough, use two layers of stabilizer. The stabilizer should be well fixed in the hoop, should not have waves and folds and be quite dense (as shown on the photo).
2. The lower thread should be of the same color as the upper one to get a beautiful embroidery result.
3. Embroider the butterfly wings design for making earrings and a necklace.
4. Remove the embroidery from the hoop, cut the excess stabilizer off, wash the stabilizer out.
5. Embroider the first color of the butterfly's body on a water-soluble stabilizer.
6. Embroider the second color of the butterfly's body, which will show the location of the wings.
7. Attach the wings, as shown on the pic, and holding it a little with your hand, repeat the embroidery of the second color and sew the wings to the butterfly's body thereby.



8. Embroider the third color of the butterfly's body





9. Remove the embroidery from the hoop, cut the excess stabilizer off, wash the stabilizer out.

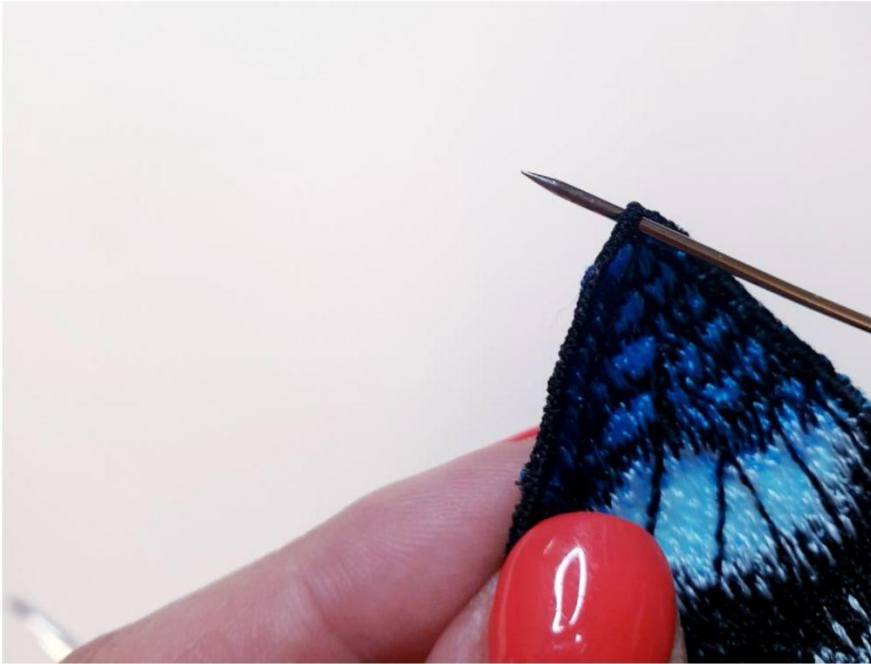






10. Dry

11. Make holes with a thick needle or an awl. Using this method, you do not tear the threads to get a hole, but only pushes them apart in different directions.









Thread and fasten the rings-connectors for jewelry, ear wires and a chain into the holes. The butterfly's body can be decorated with rhinestones or beads to your liking.
