

ATTACHE TÉTINE ZÈBRE

MATERIALS

Mane: 2 pieces 3x4cm high

Ears: 2 pieces 9x6cm high

Head: 1 piece 9x10cm high and 1 piece 10x11cm high for the back of

the head

Nipple Strap Tape

Tearable support, water-soluble support, temporary glue, fill, tapestry thread, needle

THE EARS AND MANE



The first seam is done on your tearable support

Once this sewing is done, take your first piece of fabric and put the upside down on your support



Make the 2nd seam, this seam will hold your fabric on your support

Then put your 2nd piece of fabric, place against place



Make the last seam to unite your 2 pieces



This sewing is done on your support to indicate the location of your fabric



Put your first piece of fabric on the seam and water-soluble support taking care to hide the seam well



Make the seam that will hold your fabric on the support.
Do the embroidery stitches

Once these 2 steps are complete, put your 2nd piece of fabric, place against place



Make the last seam that will sew your 2 pieces of fabric together.

Step out of frame, remove excess fabric, turn upright and set aside.

HEAD



Seam 1: Seam on your support to indicate the location of your fabric



Put your first piece of fabric and your water soluble support. Take care to hide the seam



Seam 2: Seam to hold your fabric and water soluble support on your base support



Do the embroidery stitches Seam from 3 to 8



Seam 9: Seam to show you the location for your snout



Put your small piece of cloth for the snout



Sewing 10: Sew and remove excess fabric



Stitch 11 and 12: Put a small piece of water-soluble support and make the embroidery stitches



Seam 13: This seam tells you the location of your first ear



Put your first ear on this seam taking care to keep it in place



Sewing 14: sewing your ear on your head




Seam 15: Seam in the top of the head to indicate the location of the mane and the ribbon on the top of the head



Put your mane first over put your ribbon and hold securely in place



Sewing 16: sewing to hold your mane and top ribbon in place





Seam 19: Seam to indicate the location of the tape at the bottom of the nipple



Roll up your ribbon from top to top and put your ribbon from bottom place to place on the seam 19



Sewing 20: sewing to keep your bottom ribbon in place



Put your ribbons back towards the bottom of the teat and hold in place



Put your 2nd piece of fabric (fabric for the back of the head) side up



Sewing 20: this sewing will join your 2 pieces together.

For the back of the head, I always put the speed of my embroiderer to the lowest and I am my fabric so that the foot of the embroiderer does not remain stuck in the fabric



Go back to the place and fill it up



Close the opening with an invisible seam
