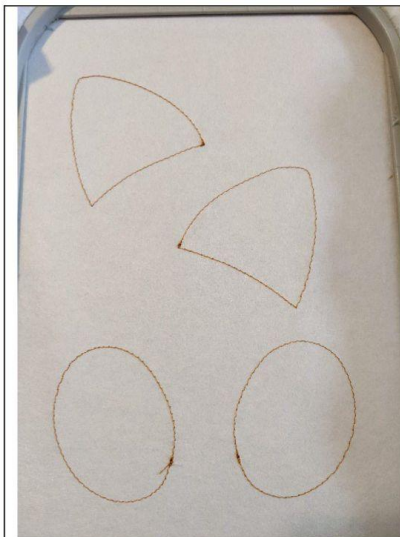

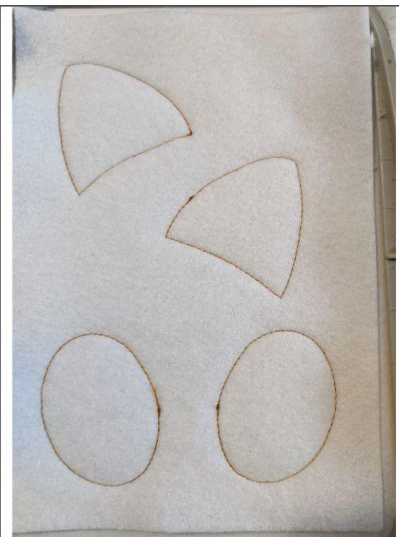
BOTTOM EARS AND PAWS



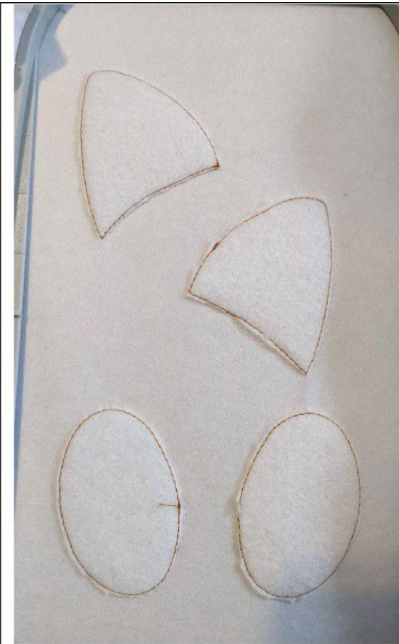
Seam 1: this seam is done on your stabilizer to indicate the location of your fleece



Put your fleece on the seam, take care to hide all the seams



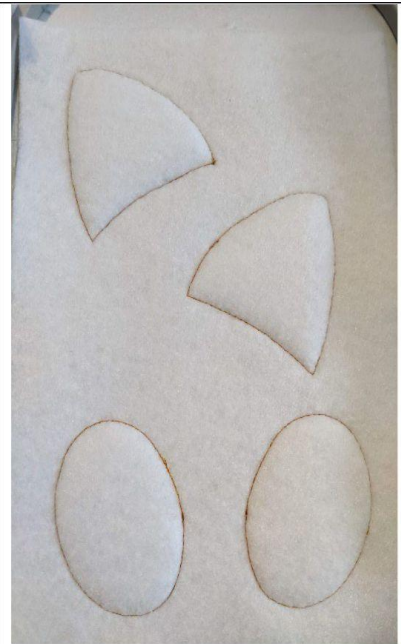
Seam 2: this seam will hold your fleece in place



Cut excess fleece all the way around



Put your Acrylic felt piece taking care to hide all the fleece parts



Seam 3: This seam will hold your felt in place



Cut excess felt all the way around



Put on your Minky, taking care to cover all the pieces with felt



Put on your water-soluble stabilizer



Seam 4: this seam will hold your stabilizer and Minky in place



Sewing 5: embroidery stitches



Put your Acrylic felt piece on the back of your project (back of the frame) well hold in place



Seam 6: this seam will join your front fabric with your felt on the back of your frame



Cut excess felt on the back of your frame and excess fabric on the front of your frame

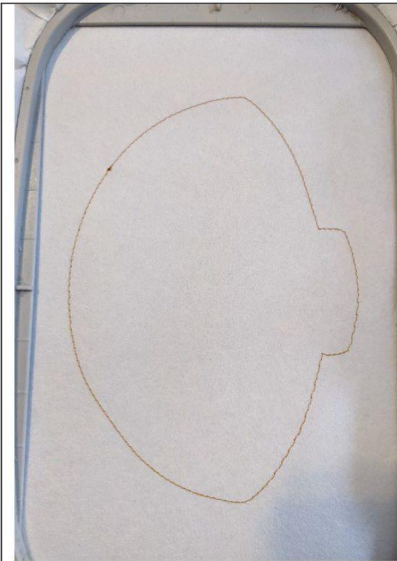


Sewing 7: Embroidery stitches



Get out of the frame, remove your stabilizer and set aside until mounting

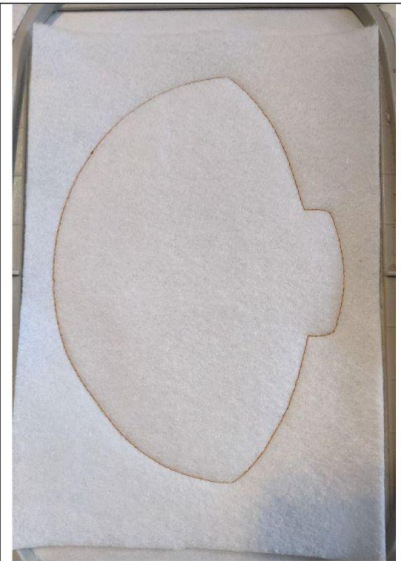
THE HEAD



Seam 1: this seam is done on your stabilizer to indicate the location of your fleece



Put your fleece on the seam, take care to hide all the seams



Seam 2: this seam will hold your fleece in place



Cut excess fleece all the way around



Put your Acrylic felt piece taking care to hide all the fleece parts



Seam 3: This seam will hold your felt in place



Cut excess felt all the way around



Seam 4: this stitch tells you the location for the sweater collar



Put your fabric on the seam



Seam 5: this seam will hold your fabric in place



Cut excess fabric all around



Seam 6: this seam tells you the location of your white Minky



Put your white Minky on the seam



Put your water-soluble stabilizer on top of your Minky

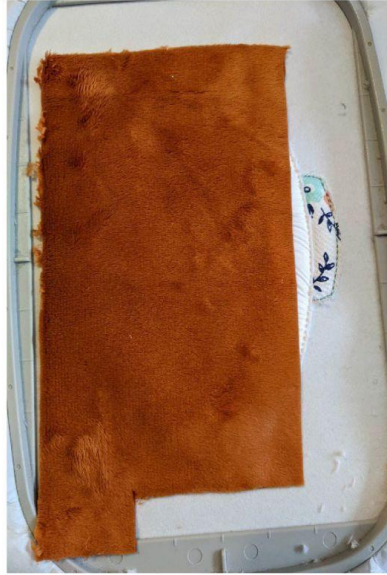


Seam 7: this seam will hold your Minky and stabilizer in place



Turn off excess Minky and stabilizer

Seam 8: this seam shows you the location for your orange Minky



Put your Minky on the seam



Seam 9: this seam will hold your Minky in place



Cut off excess Minky all around



Sewing 10-11-12-13-14:
embroidery stitches



Put your Acrylic felt piece on the back of your project (back of the frame) well hold in place



Seam 15: this seam will join your front fabric with your felt on the back of your frame



Cut excess felt all the way around

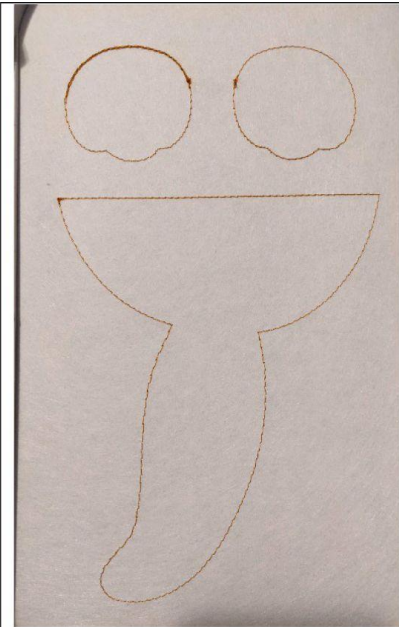


Sewing 16-17-18: satin stitches

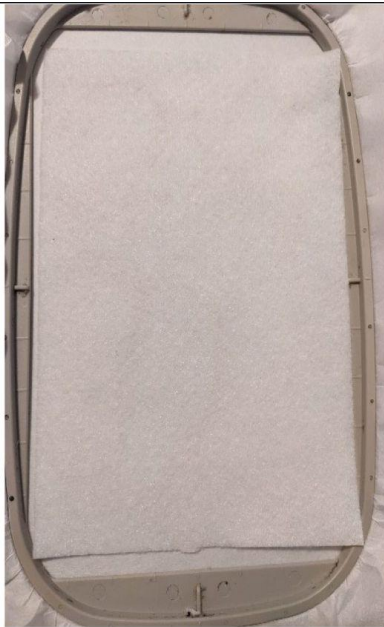


Get out of the frame, remove the stabilizers, set aside until mounting

THE TAIL AND LEGS OF THE TOP



Seam 1: this seam is done on your stabilizer to indicate the location of your fleece



Put your fleece on the seam, take care to hide all the seams



Seam 2: this seam will hold your fleece in place



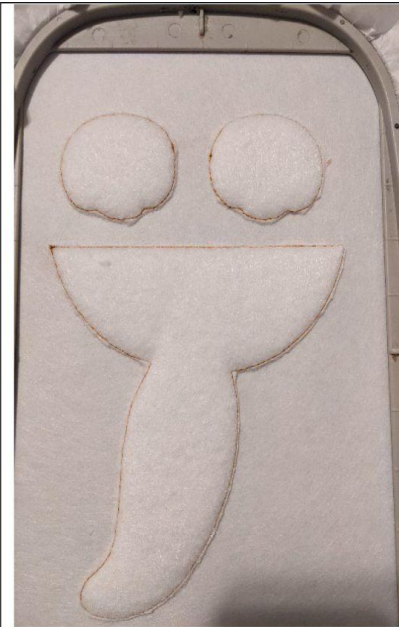
Cut excess fleece all the way around



Put your Acrylic felt piece taking care to hide all the fleece parts



Seam 3: This seam will hold your felt in place



Cut excess felt all the way around



Put your Minky on the legs



Seam 4: this seam will hold your Minky in place



Cut off excess Minky all around



Seam 5: this seam tells you the location for your orange Minky for the tail part



Put your Minky on the seam



Seam 6: this seam will hold your Minky in place



Cut off excess all around



Seam 7: This seam tells you the location of your white Minky for the tail



Put your Minky on the seam



Seam 8: this seam will hold your Minky in place



Cut off excess Minky all around



Seam 9: This seam tells you the location of your fabric for the sweater



Put your fabric on



Seam 10: this seam will hold your fabric in place



Cut excess fabric all around



Sewing 11-12: embroidery stitches



Put your Acrylic felt piece on the back of your project (back of the frame) well hold in place



Seam 13: this seam will join your front fabric with your felt on the back of your frame



Remove excess felt all the way around

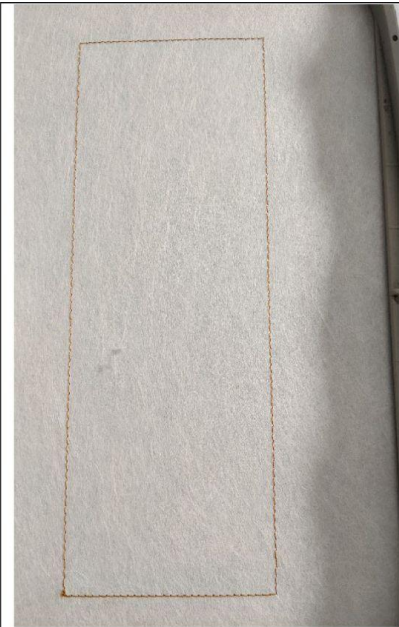


Sewing 14-15-16: satin stitches



Get out of the frame, remove your stabilizer and set aside until mounting

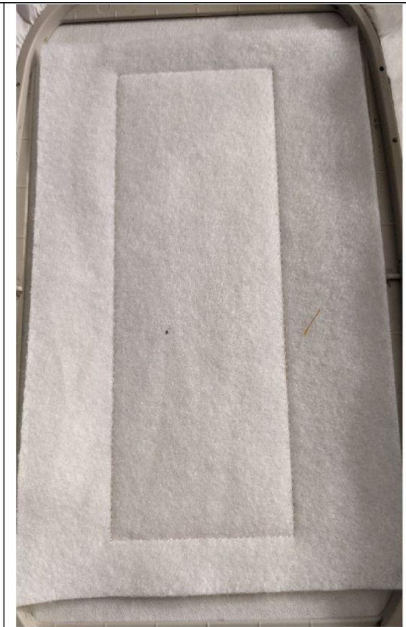
THE SIGN



Seam 1: this seam is done on your stabilizer to indicate the location of your fleece



Put your fleece on the seam, take care to hide all the seams



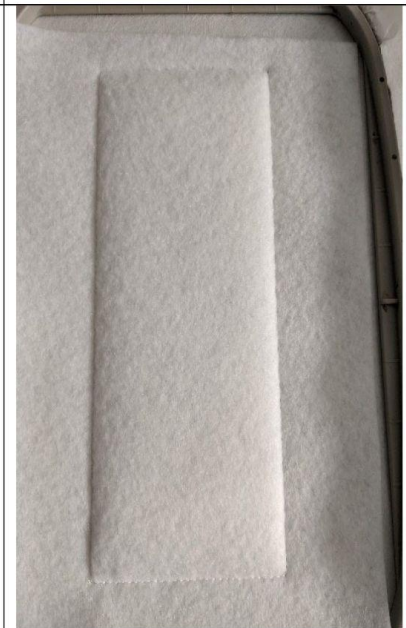
Seam 2: this seam will hold your fleece in place



Cut excess fleece all the way around

Sewing 5: embroidery stitches

Cut excess fabric on the front



Cut excess felt on the back



Seam 7: Satin stitches

ASSEMBLY



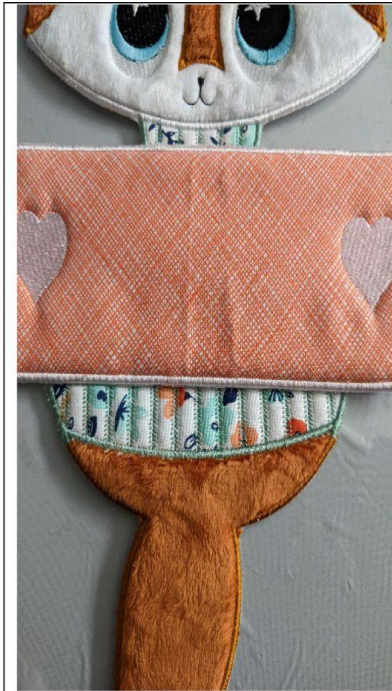
You should have all these parts to do the assembly



With your hot glue gun, stick your fox's neck on the back of the sign



Stick the ears on the back of the head



Stick the lower body on the back of the sign



Stick the small paws of the top, a part on the sign and a part on the bottom of the face



Stick the bottom legs, a small part on the sign and a part on the lower body
