



PERSONALIZED ELEPHANT DECORATION

HEAD



Seam 1: the first seam is done on your stabilizer to tell you the location of your fleece



Put your fleece to cover the entire seam



Seam 2: this seam will hold your fleece in place



Cut excess fleece all the way around



Put your piece of acrylic felt. You can skip this step (optional)



Seam 3: This seam will hold your felt in place. If you don't put on felt, skip that seam



Cut excess felt all the way around



Put your Minky on the seam so as to hide the whole seam



Put your water-soluble stabilizer on your Minky



Seam 4: this seam will hold your Minky and water-soluble stabilizer in place



Sewing 5-6-7-8-9: embroidery stitches



Put your 2nd piece of acrylic felt on the back of your frame so as to cover all the seams



Seam 10: this seam will hold your back felt in place



Cut excess felt on the back of your project



Turn off the Minky and water-soluble stabilizer all around



Sewing 11: embroidery stitches



Get out of your frame and remove your tear nonwoven stabilizer and water-soluble stabilizer

RIGHT EAR AND LEGS



Seam 1: the first seam is done on your stabilizer to tell you the location of your fleece



Put your fleece to cover the entire seam



Seam 2: this seam will hold your fleece in place



Cut excess fleece all the way around



Put your piece of acrylic felt. You can skip this step (optional)



Seam 3: This seam will hold your felt in place. If you don't put on felt, skip that seam

Cut excess felt all the way around each item



Put your Minky so as to cover all the seams



Put your water-soluble support



Seam 4: this seam will hold your Minky and stabilizer in place

Seam 5: this seam tells you the location of your cotton piece for the ears



Put your cotton piece on the seam



Seam 6: this seam will hold your fabric on your Minky



Cut excess fabric all around



Sewing 7 and 8: embroidery stitches



Put your piece of Acrylic felt on the back of your frame, taking care to hide all the seams



Seam 9: this seam will hold your felt in place




Cut excess felt all around the elements



Sewing 10-11: embroidery stitches

MAKE THE LEFT EAR AND PAWS THE SAME WAY

THE BOTTOM AND THE SIGN



Seam 1: the first seam is done on your stabilizer to tell you the location of your fleece



Put your fleece to cover the entire seam



Seam 2: this seam will hold your fleece in place



Cut excess fleece all the way around



Put your piece of acrylic felt. You can skip this step (optional)



Seam 3: This seam will hold your felt in place. If you don't put on felt, skip that seam




Cut excess felt all the way around




Put your Minky on the bottom part of the elephant



Seam 4: this seam will hold your Minky in place



Cut off excess Minky all around



Seam 5: This seam tells you the location of your cotton piece



Put your cotton on the seam



Seam 6: this seam will hold your cotton in place



Cut off excess all around



Sewing 7: embroidery stitches



Put your piece of cotton for the sign on the location of the sign



Seam 8: this seam will hold your cotton in place



Cut off excess all around



Put your felt on the back of your frame, hold in place



Seam 9: this seam will hold your felt in place on the back of your project



Cut excess felt all the way around



Sewing 10 and 11: embroidery stitches Thinking outside the box Remove your non-woven stabilizer to tear

ASSEMBLY



You must have the items here on it



With your hot glue gun, stick the head centered with the lower body



Stick the ears on the back of the head



Stick the top little paws on the sign. Be careful if you have put a name not to hide the name



Stick the paws on the bottom, stick on the sign and the lower body, putting them so as not to hide the name if you have put a name



Take a small ring with a ribbon, stick on the back of your project, here I put a small felt heart so that it is more aesthetic
