

FELT GNOME

This fact in a frame of 13x18cm



MATERIALS:

Hat: 1 piece of 14x19cm in red felt and one in white felt for the back

Coat and sleeve: 1 piece of 17x12cm in green and one in white felt for the back

Beard, sleeve lapels and tassel: 1 piece of 17x14cm of fur and one of white felt for the back

Reverse of the hat : 2 pieces of 11x6cm of white felt

Nose: 1 piece of 4x3cm skin color and a white felt for the back

Boots: 1 piece of 11x7cm red color and a piece of white felt for the back

The legs: 2 pieces of 7x10cm of white felt

The mittens : 1 piece of 7x4cm red color and 1 piece of white felt for the back





Batting (wadding) to put between your layers of felt

Support d guilty, hot glue, here I put 2 sticks and small pot at the back to make it stand upright, small chisel, rope and a decoration (here it is a star but you can put what you want) (star not included)

<p>Make all the articles one by one. Once the items are made with the embroiderer, see the assembly</p> <p>All items are made the same way</p>	 <p>The first seam is always done on your support to indicate the location of your fabric</p>	 <p>Put your batting on your support, taking care to hide the seam on your support</p>	 <p>Make the next seam that will keep your batting on your support</p>
 <p>Remove excess beating all round</p>	 <p>Put your felt on your batting taking care to hide all the batting</p>	 <p>Make the next seam that will hold your felt on your support</p>	 <p>Make the embroidery stitches on your piece. Some pieces do not have an embroidery stitch, you will only have to move on to the next step.</p> <p>The next step is to do the bumblebee point all the way.</p>
 <p>Take your frame out of your machine, turn on the back of your frame</p>	 <p>On the back of your frame (project) put your</p>	 <p>Make the last seam that will sew your pieces of fabric on the place and</p>	 <p>You should have this on the other side</p>

	<p>piece of felt white and hold well in place</p>	<p>on the back of your frame together.</p>	<p>Remove from your frame, cut off excess fabric, taking care not to cut the fabric.</p> <p>For fur fabrics, put on the back to cut so that it is easier to see where the seam to cut well.</p>
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ASSEMBLY

			
<p>You should have all these parts before you start your assembly. The assembly is done with hot glue</p>	<p>Start by sticking your legs under your shoes</p>	<p>Put the pompoms on the shoes and on the legs, the pompom will be a little more on the shoe than on the legs</p>	<p>Make the 2 arms, stick the mitten on the beginning of the lapel (fur) then take the coat sleeve and stick it also on the lapel, you will have the mitten and the sleeve half half on the reverse</p>

			
	<p>Put the back of the hat on the hat</p>	<p>Stick the beard on the coat following the curve</p>	<p>stick your hat on the beard, always stick just to the brim of the piece, do not encroach too much on the other piece</p>
			
<p>Sticking your arms under the coat</p>	<p>Stick your nose on the beard and legs under your coat.</p>	<p>If you want it to stand upright, stick 2 sticks on the back at the level of the legs and I put small plastic pots stick on the 2 beats to keep it upright</p>
