



## PENGUIN BLANKET

### LIST OF PENGUIN MATERIALS:

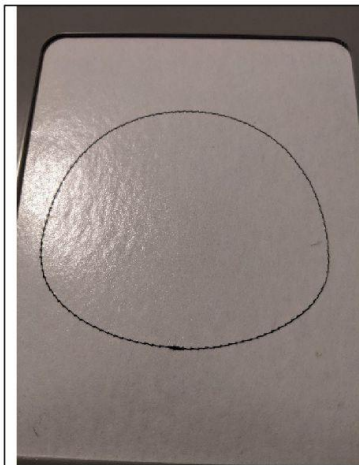
- 4 pieces of 12x12cm high Minky black
- 1 pieces of 10x12cm high Minky white
- 2 pieces of 26x26cm for the cover (color of your choice)
- 4 snaps

Tear stabilizer, water-soluble stabilizer

Thread, hand sewing needle

### THE HEAD



Seam 1: this seam is done on your stabilizer to tell you the location of your black Minky



Put your black Minky on the seam, taking care to hide the entire seam



Seam 2: this seam will hold your Minky in place



Remove excess minky from the inside of the seam



Put on your white Minky to cover the entire inside of the face



Put on your water-soluble stabilizer



Seam 3: this seam will hold your white Minky and water-soluble stabilizer in place





Cut the excess fabric all around the face, leaving a little more at the bottom







Sewing 4-5-6-7-8-9: embroidery stitches

#### THE ARMS

		
<p>Put your first piece of 12x12cm on your stabilizer to tear</p>	<p>Seam 1: this seam will hold your Minky in place</p>	<p>Seam 2: this seam is to tell you the location of your snaps</p>

		<p>Thinking outside the box Cut excess fabric all around except when opening. Leave a little more fabric at the opening site. Put in place</p>
<p>Put your 2nd piece place against place on your work.</p>	<p>Seam 3: this seam will join your 2 pieces of Minky together</p>	

#### BLANKET

<p>Print your pattern, cut your pieces of fabric. Do the sewing as indicated on the pattern</p>	<p>You can use the file to tell you the location of your snaps on the cover</p>	<p>Put your blanket in place</p>
		
<p>The first seam is done on your stabilizer to tell you the location</p>	<p>Put your blanket in the desired place</p>	<p>Seam 2: this seam will show you the location for your snaps</p>

 <p data-bbox="277 737 621 800">Put your buttons on the arms and on the cover</p>	<p data-bbox="643 268 984 533">Put your stuffing in your arms and head. Close openings with an invisible seam Put your head on your arms and sew with an invisible seam, go around at least 3 times.</p>	
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
