5x7' Framework

Final measurement: 13" high x 10" wide

REINDEER BODY



The first sewing is done on your stabilizing to tear



Put your fleece on to cover the seam



Seam 2: This seam will hold your fleece on your stabilizer



Cut the excess fleece all the way



Seam 3: this seam shows you the location of your fabric for the wood legs



Put your fabric on the seam taking care to hide all the seam



Seam 4: This seam will keep your fabric in place



Cut excess fabric all the way



Seam 5: This seam shows you the location of your body fabric



Put your fabric on the seam



Seam 6: This seam will keep your fabric in place



Cut excess fabric all the way



Sewing 7: embroidery stitches



Put your fabric for the scarf on the part of the scarf



Seam 8: This seam will keep your fabric in place



Cut excess fabric all the way

THE BODY OF THE SNOWMAN

Put your piece of fabric on the pompon, if you work with a plush fabric, put a hydrosolyblle stabilizer

Stitch 10: This stitch will join your front with your back frame fabric

REINDEER HEAD ORNAMENT



The first sewing is done on your stabilizing to tear



Put your fleece on to cover the seam



Seam 2: This seam will hold your fleece on your stabilizer



Cut the excess fleece all the way



Put your fabric for wood



Seam 3: This seam will keep your fabric in place



Cut excess fabric all the way



Sewing 4: embroidery stitches in the woods



Put your fabric on the sheets



Seam 5: This seam will keep your fabric in place

Sewing 6: embroidery stitches in sheets



Put your fabric on the berries



Seam 7: This seam will keep your fabric in place

Put your fabric on your ears

Put your felt piece on the back of your work (back of the frame)




Seam 11: This seam will join your front with your back frame fabric

The first sewing is done on your stabilizing to tear

Seam 3: This seam tells you the location of your fabric for the lower face



Put your fabric on the seam taking care to hide all the seam



Seam 4: This seam will keep your fabric in place



Cut excess fabric all the way




Put your fabric on the top of your face



Seam 5: This seam will keep your fabric in place



Cut excess fabric all the way



Stitch 6: embroidery stitches in the top and bottom of the face



Put your fabric for the nose



Seam 7: This seam will keep your fabric in place

Sewing 10-11: Embroidery stitches

THE SNOWMAN'S HEAD



The first sewing is done on your stabilizing to tear



Put your fleece on to cover the seam



Seam 2: This seam will hold your fleece on your stabilizer



Cut the excess fleece all the way



Put your fabric on the snowman's head



Seam 3: This seam will keep your fabric in place




Cut excess fabric all the way



Stitch 4: embroidery stitches in the face of the snowman



Put your fabric for the nose of the snowman





Sewing 8-9: Embroidery stitches

ASSEMBLING



You should have this before you start gluing, to help you, you can do a mounting without the glue before sticking to the hot glue gun



Start by sticking the man's head on the scarf



Stick the hat on the head and along the body



In the pom-pom, make an incision close to a bumblebee spot



Insert the bottom of the hat into the pompom



Come stick the snowman on the body of the Reindeer, make coincide the arm of the man, the body of the snowman goes to the back of the body of the reindeer but the head goes on the front of the body of the reindeer



Stick the head on the front of the Reindeer's body and on the front of the snowman's head



Stick the nose of the snowman



Stick the right wood (facing you) on the back of the head and ears.



Glue the wood with the berries on the front of the head



Grab your tie with your ribbon to hang your work
