The best ITH Easter Bunny Basket ever! ITH Easter Bunny Basket is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 60 minutes.

Materials: Skill Level : Beginner

Time Required : 01:00 hours

- 5" x 7" 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop. •
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

Final Product: What You Will Create



Step 1:

For the basket part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run colorstop 1 as a placement line.



Step 2:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 3.



Step 3:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 4.



Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 5:

You need to do two of them.



Step 6:

For the basket handle part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 7:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with blue fabric with the

help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 3.



Step 8:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 4.



Step 9:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 10:

You need to do two of them.



Step 11:

For the bunny part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run colorstop 1 as a placement line.



Step 12:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 7.



Step 13:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 8



Step 14:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 15:

You need to do two of them



Step 16:

We put all the pieces together.



Step 17:

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue, join the tabs located at the ends, taking the external backstitch as a reference, then fold the central tab (the one with a triangular shape) covering the union between the previously joined tabs. Attach the basket handle to the end of the central tab from one end to the other and finally fix the rabbit's face in the center, thus covering the junction between the tabs and the basket handle, as suggested by the reference image. Use complementary decoration. Have fun doing this beautiful project
