

ITH Kitchen Sign

The best ITH Kitchen Sign! ITH Kitchen Sign is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 60 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 01:00 hours

Materials:

- 4" x 4 - 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

For the A01 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

**Step 2:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 4.

**Step 3:**

Run color-stop 5 and color-stop 6.



Step 4:

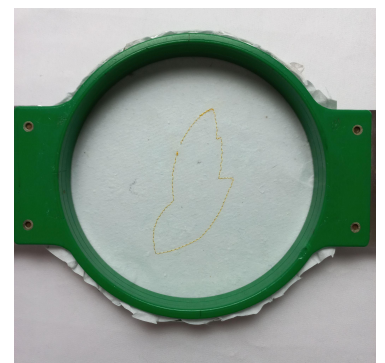
Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 7 to fix the fabric.

**Step 5:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

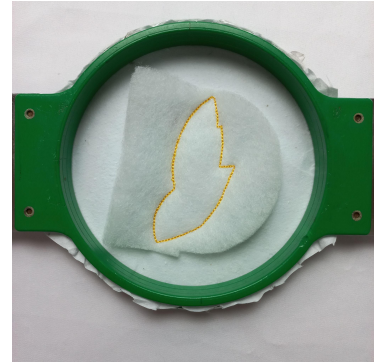
**Step 6:**

For the A02 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 7:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and color-stop 3.

**Step 8:**

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.

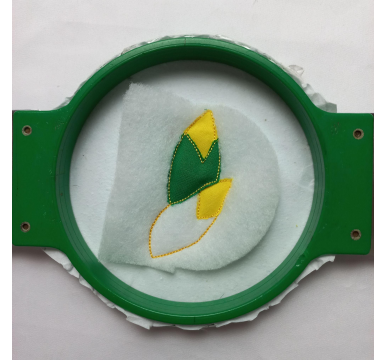
**Step 9:**

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 10:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 11:

Run color-stop 10 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green light fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11. Cut the excess fabric.



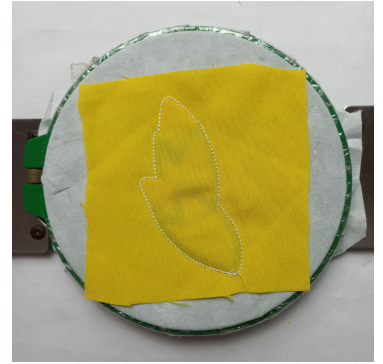
Step 12:

Run color-stop 12 through color-stop 15.



Step 13:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 16 to fix the fabric.



Step 14:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 15:

For the A03 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 16:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and color-stop 3.

**Step 17:**

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green light fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 18:**

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 19:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



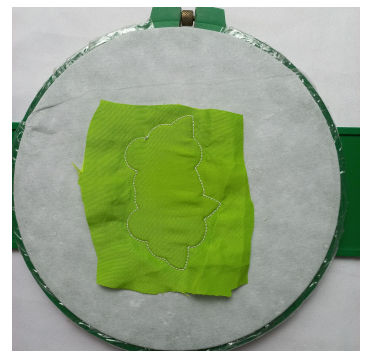
Step 20:

Run color-stop 10 through color-stop 13.



Step 21:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with green light fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 14 to fix the fabric.



Step 22:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 23:

For the A04 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 24:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and color-stop 3.



Step 25:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 26:**

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with sky blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 27:**

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 28:

Run color-stop 10 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 29:**

Run color-stop 12 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 13. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 30:**

Run color-stop 14 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuchsia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 15. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 31:

Run color-stop 16 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green light fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 17. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 32:

Run color-stop 18 through color-stop 29.



Step 33:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 30 to fix the fabric.



Step 34:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 35:

We put all the pieces together.



Step 36:

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue, The banner part will be the top center part. Join the part of the banner with the floral branches and the corn, fixing the endings in the back parts of the banner as the reference image suggests. Then fix the turkey on each at the height you prefer. Use complementary decoration. Have fun doing this beautiful project.
