

# ITH Bunny Hanger

The best ITH Bunny Hanger ever! ITH Bunny Hange is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 60 minutes.

**Skill Level:** Beginner

**Time Required:** 01:00 hours

## **Materials:**

- 4" x 4 - 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting.
- Repositionable adhesive spray.
- Fabric scissors.

## **Designs used in this project:**



**Step 1:**

For the A01 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



**Step 2:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



**Step 3:**

Cover the placement line with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3 and 4.



**Step 4:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 5.

**Step 5:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, and the center part with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 6:**

For the A02 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



**Step 7:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



**Step 8:**

Cover the placement line with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stops 3 and 4.



**Step 9:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 5.



**Step 10:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



**Step 11:**

For the A03 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



**Step 12:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



**Step 13:**

Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stops 3 through color-stop 8.



**Step 14:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 9.



**Step 15:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



**Step 16:**

For the A04 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



**Step 17:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



**Step 18:**

Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stops 3.





**Step 19:**

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



**Step 20:**

Run color-stop 6 and 7.



**Step 21:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 8.



**Step 22:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



**Step 23:**

For the A05 part, follow the steps of the A04 part.



**Step 24:**

We put all the pieces together.



**Step 25:**

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue. Join the ears of the bunny to the head, then, join the carrot to the leaf. The carrot will be the center part. So join the head of the bunny to the carrot at the height you prefer. Or as the reference image suggests.

Use complementary decoration.
