# **ITH Welcome Gnome Two**

The best ITH Welcome Gnome Two ever! ITH Welcome Gnome Two is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 90 minutes.

**Skill Level:** Beginner **Time Required:** 01:30 hours

#### Materials:

4" x 4 - 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.

- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

# **Designs used in this project:**



### Step 1:

For the A01 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



#### Step 2:

Cover the placement line with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3 through color-stop 5.



# Step 3:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 6.



#### Step 4:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



# Step 5:

For the A02 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



#### Step 6:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



# Step 7:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



# Step 8:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



#### Step 9:

Run color-stop 10 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11. Cut the excess fabric.



# Step 10:

Run color-stop 12 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 13. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 11: Run color-stop 14.



# **Step 12:**

Run color-stop 15 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 16. Cut the excess fabric.



**Step 13:** Run color-stop 17 through color-stop 25.



**Step 14:** 

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fuchsia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 26.



# **Step 15:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



#### **Step 16:**

For the A03 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



# **Step 17:**

Cover the placement line with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 4. Cut the excess fabric.



#### **Step 18:**

Run color-stop 5 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with khaki fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 6. Cut the excess fabric.



# **Step 19:**

Run color-stop 7 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with khaki fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 8. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 20:

Run color-stop 9 through color-stop 16.



# **Step 21:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 17.



# Step 22:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



# **Step 23:**

For the A04 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



# **Step 24:**

Cover the placement line with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 4. Cut the excess fabric.



# Step 25:

Run color-stop 5 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with khaki fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 6. Cut the excess fabric.



# Step 26:

Run color-stop 7 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with khaki fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 8. Cut the excess fabric.



# Step 27:

Run color-stop 9 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 10. Cut the excess fabric.



# **Step 28:**

Run color-stop 11 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 12. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 29:

Run color-stop 13 through color-stop 20.



# **Step 30:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 21.



# **Step 31:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



# **Step 32:**

For the A05 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.




# **Step 33:**

Cover the placement line with gray light fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3 through color-stop 5.



**Step 34:** 

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with a gray fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 6.



Step 35:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



**Step 36:** 

For the A06 part follow the steps of the A05 part.



#### **Step 37:**

We put all the pieces together.



# **Step 38:**

The path will be the lower center part divided into two parts. With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue, join the parts to form one, fixing the endings in the back parts. Fix the orange pumpkin to the path. Then join the mushroom and finally join the green pumpkin. The banner will be the upper center part join to the ribbon at the height you prefer.

Or as the reference image suggests Use complementary decoration. Have fun doing this beautiful project.
