# ITH BEE MUG RUG

The best ITH Bee Mug Rug ever! ITH Bee Mug Rug is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 60 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 01:00 hours

# Materials:

- 4" x 4 5" x 7" 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

Designs used in this project:



#### Step 1:

For this project tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

# Step 2:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stops 2.

**Step 3:** Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stops 3 and 4.







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## Step 4:

The color-stop 4 is a placement line. Cover the placement line with a pink fabric facing down and run color-stop 5.





Step 5:

Now fold the fabric by the stitching made by the color-stop 5. And run color-stops 6 (Like the image suggest).

**Step 6:** Run color-stop 7.



#### Step 7:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric, and run color-stop 9 and 10. Cut the excess fabric.

## Step 8:

Run color-stop 11 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with organza fabric, and run color-stop 12 and 13. Cut the excess fabric.

Step 9:

Run color-stop 14 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with brown fabric, and run color-stop 15. Cut the excess fabric.







# Step 10:

Run color-stop 16 through color-stop 21.

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**Step 11:** Cover the project with a yellow fabric facing down, and run color-stop 22.

Step 12:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut the outline with sharp scissors leaving a homogeneous margin.



# Step 13:

Turn the pieces inside out like a sock.



# Step 14:

Close the piece with the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue as they are arranged in the image.

Have fun doing this beautiful project.
