The best ITH Cat in the Pocket ever! ITH Cat in the Pocket is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 50 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 00:50 minutes

Materials:

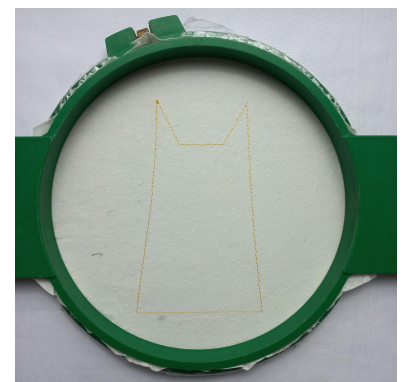
- 4" x 4 - 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

Designs used in this project:



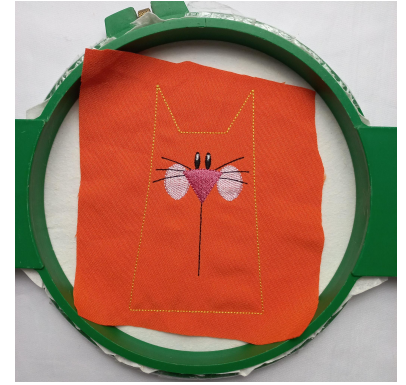
Step 1:

For the Cat part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop, and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 2:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 6.

**Step 3:**

Cover the project with a piece of orange fabric and run color-stop 7.

**Step 4:**

Remove the project from the hoop and cut the outline with sharp scissors leaving a homogeneous margin. Save for later.



Step 5:

For the Tail part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop, and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 6:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with orange fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



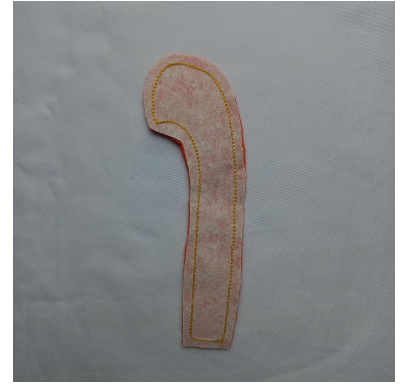
Step 7:

Cover the project with a piece of orange fabric and run color-stop 3.



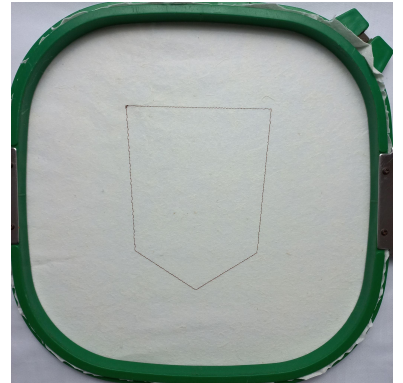
Step 8:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut the outline with sharp scissors leaving a homogeneous margin. Save for later.



Step 9:

For the Pocket part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop, and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



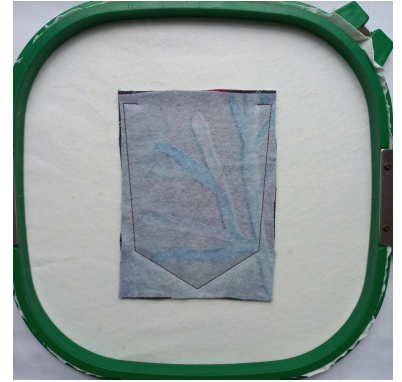
Step 10:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and color-stop 3.



Step 11:

Cover the project with a piece of printed fabric and run color-stop 4.



Step 12:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut the outline with sharp scissors leaving a homogeneous margin. Save for later.



Step 13:

Gather all the pieces and turn them inside out like socks.



Step 14:

Fill out the project and close the piece with the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue as they are arranged in the image.
