The best ITH Moon Santa ever! ITH Moon Santa is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 90 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 01:30 hours

Materials:

- 4" x 4 - 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

Designs used in this project:



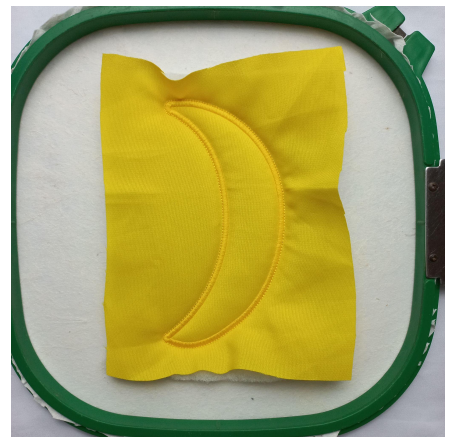
Step 1:

For the A01 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.

**Step 2:**

Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3 through color-stop 5.

**Step 3:**

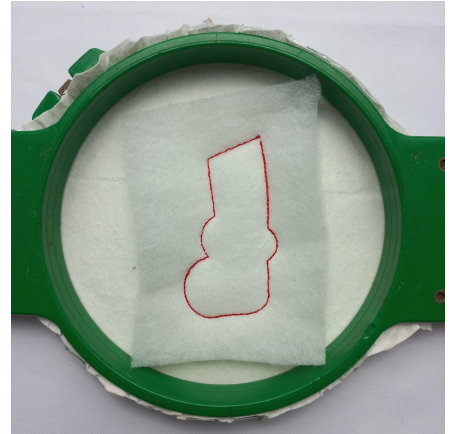
Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



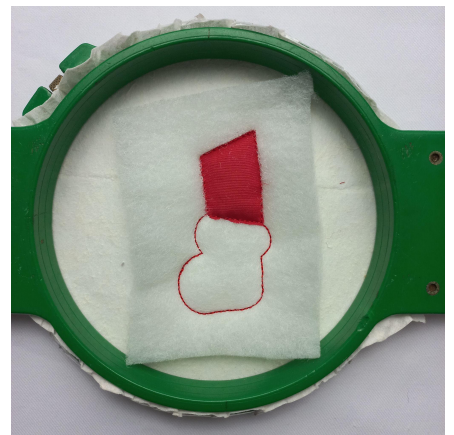
Step 4:

For the A02 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.

**Step 5:**

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 6:**

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 7:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 8:

Run color-stop 10 through color-stop 12.



Step 9:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 13.



Step 10:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 11:**

For the A03 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.

**Step 12:**

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 13:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 14:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 15:

Run color-stop 10 through color-stop 13.



Step 16:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 14.

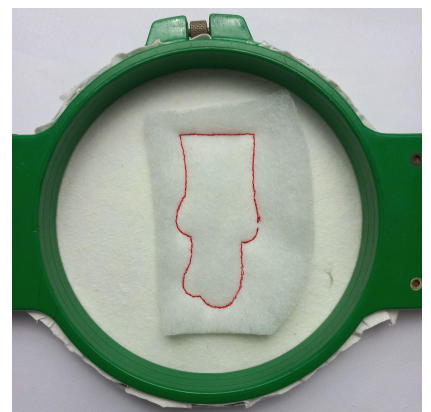
**Step 17:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 18:**

For the A04 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



Step 19:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 20:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 21:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 22:

Run color-stop 10 through color-stop 12.



Step 23:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 13.



Step 24:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 25:

For the A05 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.

**Step 26:**

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 27:**

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 28:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 29:

Run color-stop 10 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 30:

Run color-stop 12 through color-stop 17.



Step 31:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 18.

**Step 32:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 33:**

For the A06 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



Step 34:

Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3 through color-stop 4.



Step 35:

Run color-stop 5 through color-stop 10.



Step 36:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 11.



Step 37:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 38:

We put all the pieces together.



Step 39:

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue. The moon will be the center part. Join the belly to the border at the moon, join the arm to the belly, and then the head of the Santa, now join the second leg to the back part of the moon, fixing the endings in the back parts. The star will be the upper part fixing in the cordon. At the height you prefer.

Or as the reference image suggests. Use complementary decoration.
