# **ITH Spring Gnome MUG RUG**

The best ITH Spring Gnome Mug Rug ever! ITH Spring Gnome Mug Rug is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 60 minutes.

**Skill Level:** Beginner **Time Required:** 01:00 hours

#### Materials:

- 4" x 4 5" x 7" 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

**Designs used in this project:** 



## Step 1:

For this project tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



#### Step 2:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stops 2 and 3.




#### Step 3:

Run the color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



# Step 4:

Run the color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



## Step 5:

Run the color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



## Step 6:

Run color-stop 10 through color-stop 12.



**Step 7:** Run the color-stop 13 as a placement line.



Step 8:

Cover the placement line with green fabric facing down, and run color-stop 14.



## Step 9:

Now fold the fabric by the stitching made by the color-stop 14. And run color-stop 15 (Like the image suggests).



Step 10:

Run the color-stop 16 as a placement line.



**Step 11:** 

Cover the placement line with green fabric facing down, and run color-stop 17.



## **Step 12:**

Now fold the fabric by the stitching made by the color-stop 17. And run color-stop 18 (Like the image suggests).



**Step 13:** Run the color-stop 19 as a placement line.



**Step 14:** 

Cover the placement line with green fabric facing down, and run color-stop 20.



# **Step 15:**

Now fold the fabric by the stitching made by the color-stop 20. And run color-stop 21 (Like the image suggests).



## Step 16:

Run the color-stop 22 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with khaki fabric and run color-stop 23. Cut the excess fabric.



## **Step 17:**

Run the color-stop 24 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with gray fabric and run color-stop 25. Cut the excess fabric.



#### **Step 18:**

Run the color-stop 26 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric and run color-stop 27. Cut the excess fabric.



## **Step 19:**

Run the color-stop 28 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuchsia fabric and run color-stop 29. Cut the excess fabric



#### Step 20:

Run the color-stop 30 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric and run color-stop 31. Cut the excess fabric.



#### **Step 21:**

Run the color-stop 32 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuchsia fabric and run color-stop 33. Cut the excess fabric.



## Step 22:

Run the color-stop 34 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric and run color-stop 35. Cut the excess fabric.



#### **Step 23:**

Run the color-stop 36 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with sky blue fabric and run color-stop 37. Cut the excess fabric.



#### **Step 24:**

Run the color-stop 38 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with sky blue fabric and run color-stop 39. Cut the excess fabric.



# Step 25:

Run the color-stop 40 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric and run color-stop 41. Cut the excess fabric.



**Step 26:** 

Run color-stop 42 through color-stop 52.



## Step 27:

Run the color-stop 53 as a placement line.



Step 28:

Cover the placement line with green fabric facing down, and run color-stop 54.



Step 29:

Now fold the fabric by the stitching made by the color-stop 54. And run color-stop 55 (Like the image suggests).



## **Step 30:**

Cover the project with a green fabric and run color-stop 56.



## **Step 31:**

Remove the project from the hoop and cut the outline with sharp scissors leaving a homogeneous margin.



# **Step 32:**

Turn the pieces inside out like a sock.



## **Step 33:**

Close the piece with the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue as they are arranged in the image.
