The best ITH Cow ever! ITH Cow is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 45 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 00:45 minutes.

Materials:

- 4" x 4 - 5" x 7".
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting.
- Repositionable adhesive spray.
- Fabric scissors.

Step 1:

For the A01 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.

**Step 2:**

Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stops 3 and 4. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 3:**

Run color-stop 5 through color-stop 8.



Step 4:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 9.

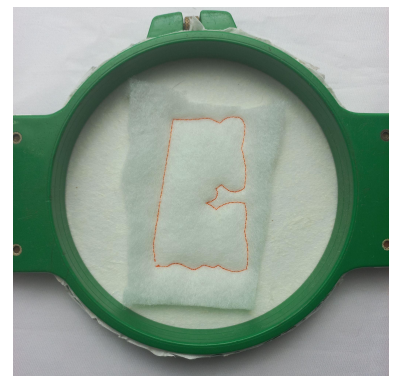
**Step 5:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 6:**

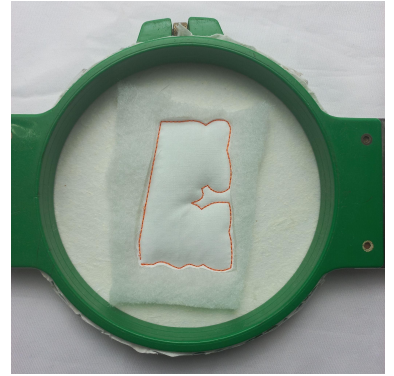
For the A02 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



Step 7:

Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stops 3 and 4. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 8:

Run color-stop 5 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 6. Cut the excess fabric.



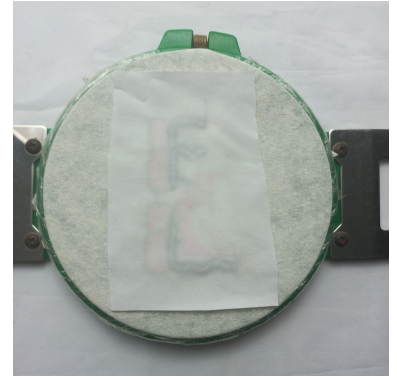
Step 9:

Run color-stop 7 through color-stop 9.



Step 10:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 10.

**Step 11:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 12:**

For the A03 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



Step 13:

Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stops 3 and 4. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 14:

Run color-stop 5 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 6. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 15:

Run color-stop 7 through color-stop 10.



Step 16:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 11.

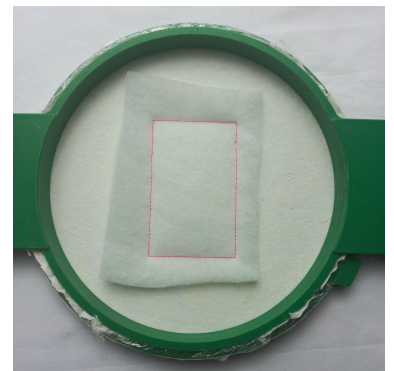
**Step 17:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 18:**

For the A04 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



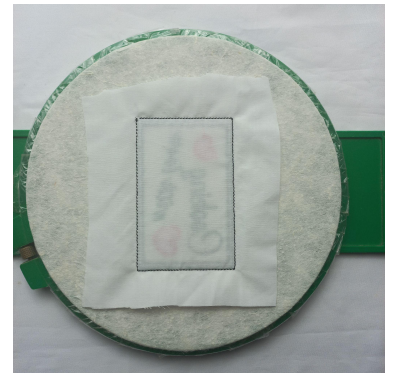
Step 19:

Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3 through color-stop 5.



Step 20:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 6.



Step 21:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 22:

We put all the pieces together.

**Step 23:**

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue. The A02 part will be the center part, join the A02 part to the A01 part, and then join the parts to the A03 part. Finally, join the A04 part to a stick and join all these parts to a stick in the back part of the project at the height you prefer. Or as the reference image suggests.

Use complementary decoration.
