ITH Welcome Santa and Reindeer

The best ITH Welcome Santa and Reindeer ever! ITH Welcome Santa and Reindeer are made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 50 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner **Time Required:** 00:50 minutes.

Materials:

- 5" x 7" 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting.
- Repositionable adhesive spray.
- Fabric scissors.

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

For the Santa's Face part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



Step 2:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 3:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 4: Run color-stops 8 and 9.



Step 5:

Run color-stop 10 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 6:

Run color-stop 12 through color-stop 14.



Step 7:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 15.



Step 8:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 9:

For the Santa's Hat part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



Step 10:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 11:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 12:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 13: Run color-stop 10 through color-stop 12.



Step 14:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 13.



Step 15:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 16:

For the Reindeer Face part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



Step 17:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 18:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 19:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 20:

Run color-stop 10 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 21:

Run color-stop 12 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 13. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 22: Run color-stop 14 through color-stop 20.



Step 23:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 13.



Step 24:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 25:

For the Reindeer Horns part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



Step 26:

Cover the placement line with brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 4. Cut the excess fabric. And run color-stop 5.



Step 27:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 6.



Step 28:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 29:

For the Plaque part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop, and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



Step 30:

Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 4. Cut the excess fabric. And run color-stops 5 and 6.



Step 31:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 7.



Step 32:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 33:

We put all the pieces together.



Step 34:

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue, The Santa face part will be the lower center part, join the hat to the face and then join the Reindeer head at the horns at the height you prefer. Once the parts be joined, stick the Santa to the Reindeer and finally join the Plaque part to the rest of the project. Use complementary decoration.
