Santa ITH

The best Santa ITH ever! Santa ITH is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 60 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner **Time Required:** 01:00 Hour.

Materials:

- 5" x 7" 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting.
- Repositionable adhesive spray.
- Fabric scissors.

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

For the A01 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



Step 2:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 3:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with sky blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 4:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 5:

Run color-stop 10 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green light fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 6:

Run color-stop 12 through color-stop 35.



Step 7:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 36.



Step 8:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 9:

For the A02 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 and 3.



Step 10:

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric. Do it the same way for the other part of the hat.



Step 11:

Run color-stop 8 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 9. Cut the excess fabric. Do it the same way for the other part of the hair.



Step 12:

Run color-stop 12 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with khaki fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 13. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 13: Run color-stop 14 through color-stop 21.



Step 14:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 22.



Step 15:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 16:

For the A03 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 4.



Step 17:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 5.



Step 18:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 19:

For the A04 part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 5.



Step 20:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 6.



Step 21:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 22:

We put all the pieces together.



Step 23:

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue, The A01 part will be the center part, join the A02 to the A01 and then join the A03 and the A04 in the front part of the A02 part at the height you prefer.

Use complementary decoration.
