ITH Spring Gnome with Flowers

The best ITH Spring Gnome with Flowers ever! ITH Spring Gnome with Flowers are made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 50 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner **Time Required:** 00:50 minutes.

Materials:

- 5" x 7" 6" x 10".
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting.
- Repositionable adhesive spray.
- Fabric scissors.

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

For the gnome body part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



Step 2:

Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3 and 4. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 3:

Run color-stop 5 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 6. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 4:

Run color-stop 7 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 8. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 5:

Run color-stop 9 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 10. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 6:

Run color-stop 11 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green light fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 12. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 7:

Run color-stop 13 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with blue sky fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 14. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 8:

Run color-stop 15 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 16. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 9:

Run color-stop 17 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with lilac fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 18. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 10:

Run color-stop 19 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuchsia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 20. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 11:

Run color-stop 21 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green light fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 22. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 12:

Run color-stop 23 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with blue sky fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 24. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 13: Run color-stop 25 through color-stop 33.



Step 14:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 34.



Step 15:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 16:

For the Hat part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



Step 17:

Cover the placement line with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3 and 4. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 18:

Run color-stop 5 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with lilac fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 6. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 19:Do the same for all the flowers and the leaf.



Step 20:

Run color-stop 29 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with sky blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 30. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 21:

Run color-stop 31 through color-stop 39.



Step 22:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the back of the hoop with white fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 40.



Step 23:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design, with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 24:

We put all the pieces together.



Step 25:

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue. Join the gnome body to the hat, and then join the gnome to the stick in the back part of the project at the height you prefer. Or as the reference image suggests.

You can use complementary decorations.
