

Three Little Pigs Puppets

The best Three Little Pigs Puppets ever! Three Little Pigs Puppets are made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 50 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 00:50 minutes.

Materials:

- 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" - or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Batting.
- Repositionable adhesive spray.
- Fabric scissors.

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

For the First little pig tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2. In this color, the placement line of the first ear is included.

**Step 2:**

Cover the placement line with fuschia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 3. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 3:**

Run color-stop 4 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuschia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 5. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 4:

Run color-stop 6 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 7. Cut the excess fabric. Do the same for the other paw.

**Step 5:**

Run color-stop 10 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 11. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 6:**

Run color-stop 12 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 13. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 7:

Run color-stop 14 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 15. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 8:**

Run color-stop 16 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 17. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 9:**

Run color-stop 18 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuschia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 19. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 10:

Run color-stop 20 and 21.



Step 11:

Cover the project with a black fabric facing down, and run color-stop 22.



Step 12:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut the outline with sharp scissors leaving a homogeneous margin.



Step 13:

Turn the pieces inside out like a sock.

**Step 14:**

For the Second little pig tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.

**Step 15:**

Run color-stop 3 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuschia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 4. Cut the excess fabric. Do the same for the other ear.



Step 16:

Run color-stop 7 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 8. Cut the excess fabric. Do the same for the other paw.

**Step 17:**

Run color-stop 11 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 12. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 18:**

Run color-stop 13 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 14. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 19:

Run color-stop 15 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with sky blue fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 16. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 20:

Run color-stop 17 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuschia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 18. Cut the excess fabric.



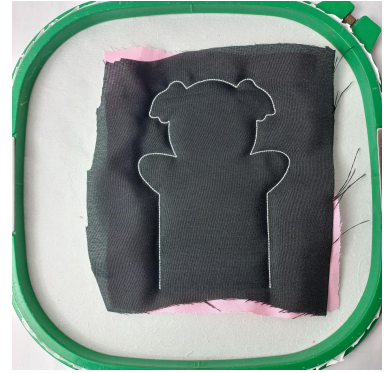
Step 21:

Run color-stop 19 and 20.



Step 22:

Cover the project with a black fabric facing down, and run color-stop 21.



Step 23:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut the outline with sharp scissors leaving a homogeneous margin.



Step 24:

Turn the pieces inside out like a sock.



Step 25:

For the Third little pig tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and pink fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.

**Step 26:**

Run color-stop 3 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuschia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 4. Cut the excess fabric. Do the same for the other ear.

**Step 27:**

Run color-stop 7 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 8. Cut the excess fabric. Do the same for the other paw.



Step 28:

Run color-stop 11 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 12. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 29:**

Run color-stop 13 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 14. Cut the excess fabric.

**Step 30:**

Run color-stop 15 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with yellow fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 16. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 31:

Run color-stop 17 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with fuschia fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 18. Cut the excess fabric.



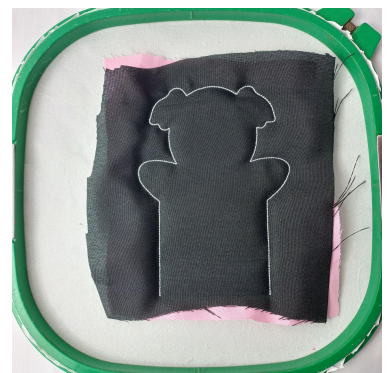
Step 32:

Run color-stop 19 and 20.



Step 33:

Cover the project with a black fabric facing down, and run color-stop 21.



Step 34:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut the outline with sharp scissors leaving a homogeneous margin.



Step 35:

Turn the pieces inside out like a sock.



Step 36:

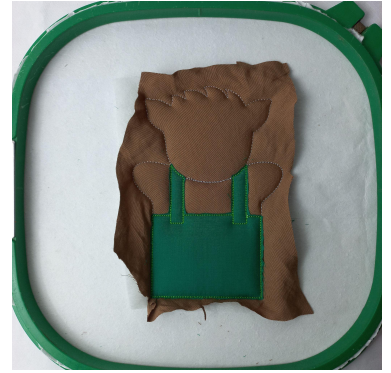
For the little wolf tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with batting and brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2.



Step 37:

Run color-stop 3 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with green fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 4. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 38:

Run color-stop 5 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 6. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 39:

Run color-stop 7 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with khaki fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 8. Cut the excess fabric. Do the same for the other ear.



Step 40:

Run color-stop 11 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with khaki fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 12. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 41:

Run color-stop 13 as a placement line. Cover the placement line with black fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 14 and 15. Cut the excess fabric.



Step 42:

Run color-stop 16 through color-stop 19.



Step 43:

Cover the project with a black fabric facing down, and run color-stop 20.



Step 44:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut the outline with sharp scissors leaving a homogeneous margin.



Step 45:

Turn the pieces inside out like a sock.



Step 46:

We put all the pieces together and enjoy this beautiful project.
