

Roll up case

Necessary materials.

For 7x11

Fabric - eco-leather, vinyl, cotton linen - 8" x 12" (20 x 30 cm)

Lining - 8" x 12" (20 x 30 cm)

Polyester batting - 8" x 12" (20 x 30 cm)

For pockets

1 pocket – Fabric - 10" x 12" (25 x 30 cm) - Fold the piece in half and press with an iron.

2 pocket - Fabric - 8" x 12" (20 x 30 cm) - Fold the piece in half and press with an iron.

Or eco-leather, vinyl - 4" x 12" (10 x 30 cm)

For 6x10

Fabric - eco-leather, vinyl, cotton linen - 7" x 11" (18 x 28 cm)

Lining - 7" x 11" (18 x 28 cm)

Polyester batting - 7" x 11" (18 x 28 cm)

For pockets

1 pocket – Fabric - 9" x 11" (22 x 28 cm) - Fold the piece in half and press with an iron.

2 pocket - Fabric - 7" x 11" (18 x 28 cm)- Fold the piece in half and press with an iron.

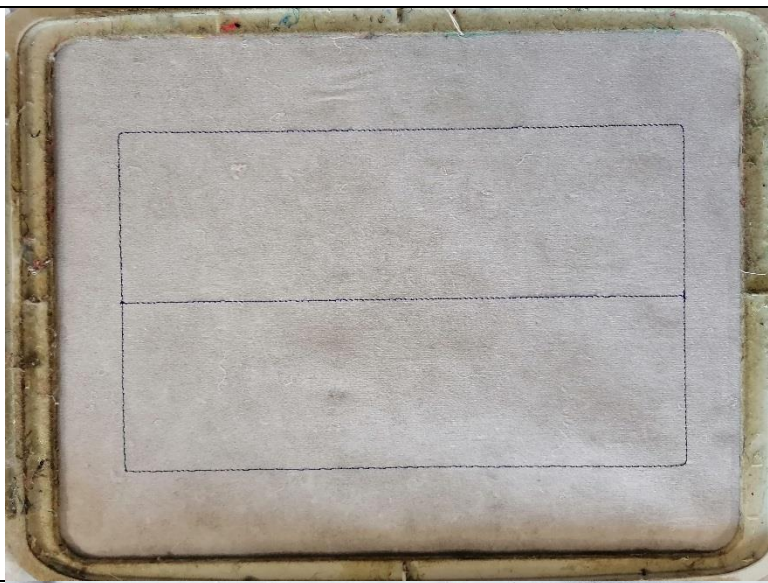
Or eco-leather, vinyl - 3,5" x 12" (8 x 28 cm)

Download the archive to your computer. Extract the files from the archive.

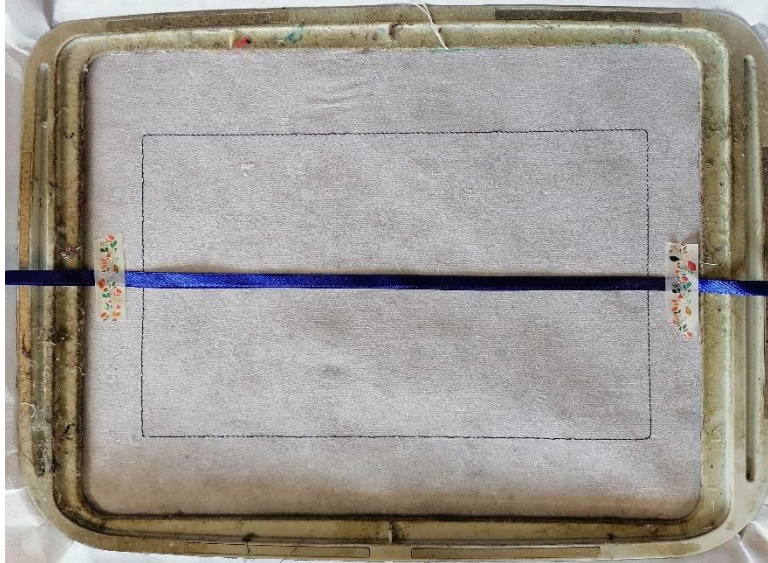
Download file to your embroidery machine in the way you are used to.



Hoop tearaway or water-soluble stabilizer.



Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for design



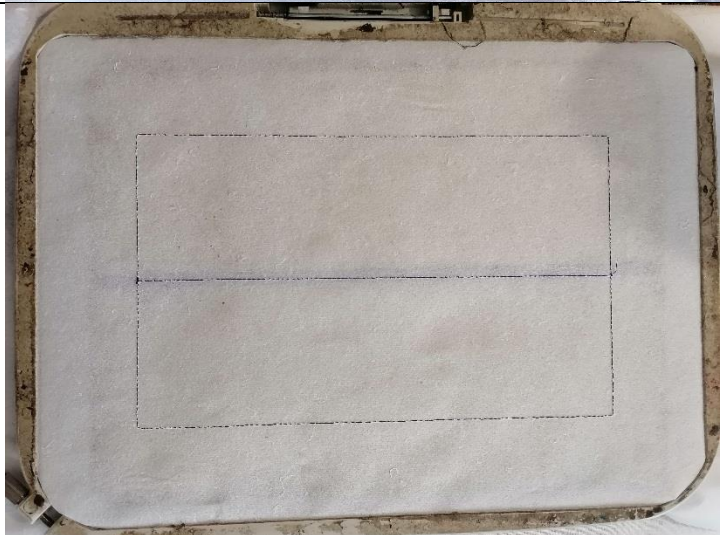
Put a ribbon for the ties.

Fix the adhesive tape



Put polyester batting.

You can use temporary fixation glue



Turn the hoop over so the wrong side is up.



Place Lining right side up.

You can use temporary fixation glue



Stitch Color 2



Cut off the exceed the polyester batting around near stitch.

I recommend cutting the polyester batting at this stage to avoid thick seams.

Be careful not to cut the tape



Put the main fabric face up.
You can use temporary fixation glue



Stitch Color 3



Put the piece for pockets (1) with the folded part to the stitch.



Fix the adhesive tape



Put the piece for pockets (2) from fabric or vinyl 1 inch below the control line



Fix the adhesive tape



Stitch Color 4 - secure the pockets



Stitch Color 5 - wide pockets



Stitch Color 6 - narrow pockets

You can not embroider this color and leave wide pockets.

I did so on this product



Stitch Color 7 - zigzag for cutting



Cut off the exceed material around near zigzag stitch on both sides of the hoop.



Be careful not to cut the tape



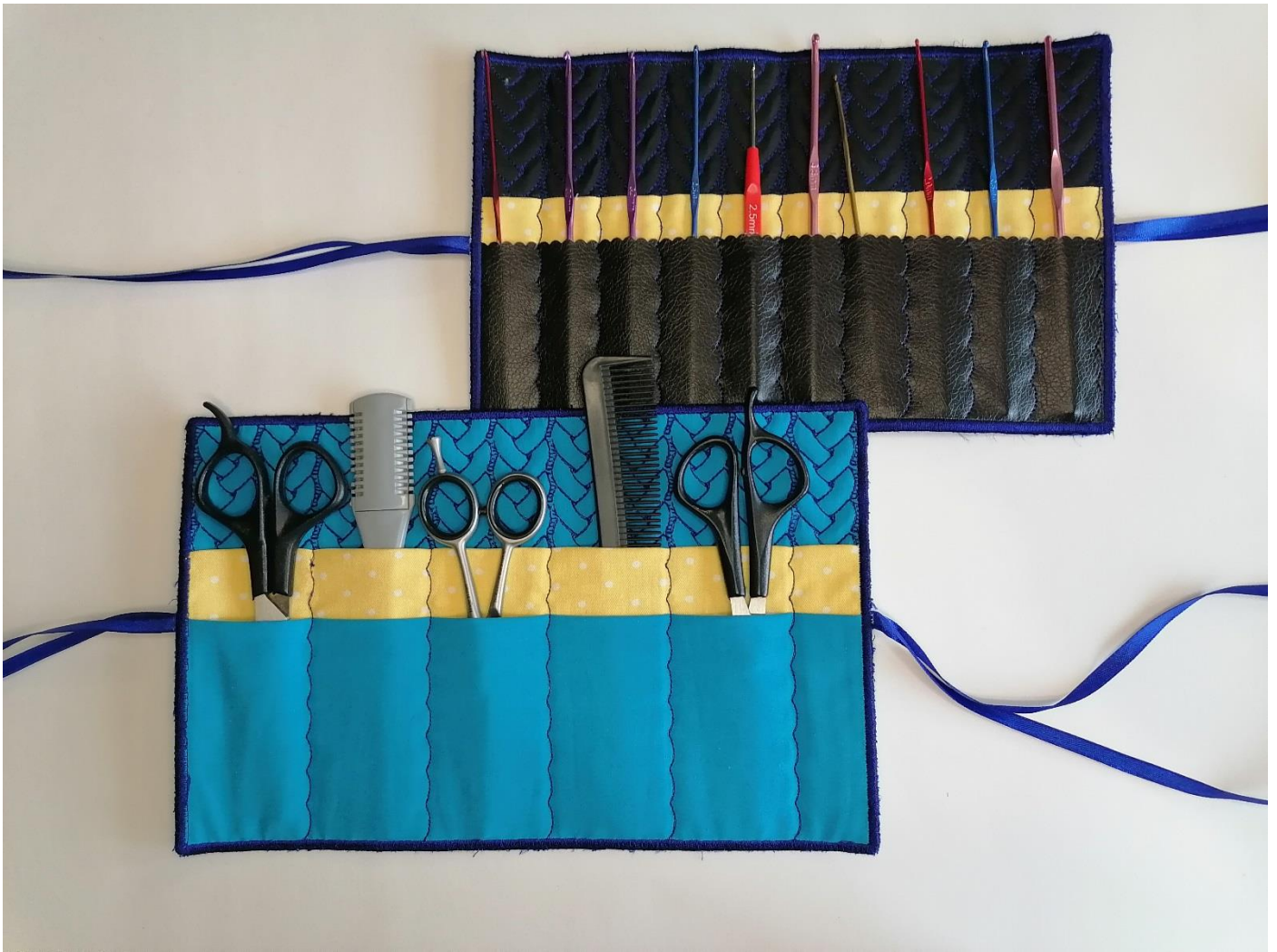
Stitch Color 8 - satin border

Cut stabilizer. Remove the stabilizer residues with a wet sponge
