

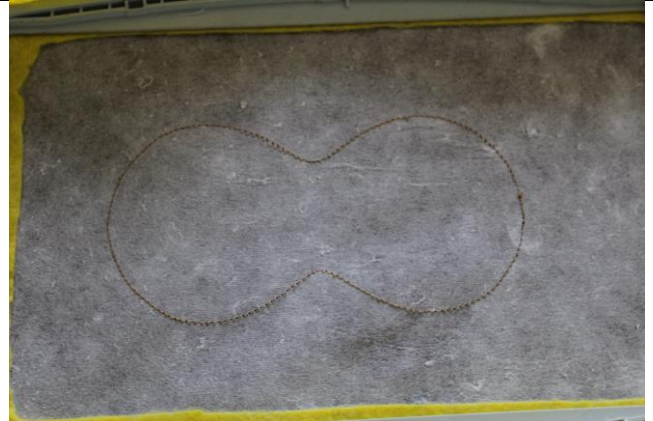
# Coin Wallet «seashell»

Fabric 1 – 11cm x 20cm - I used vinyl  
Fabric 2 – 11cm x 20cm - white calico, coarse calico  
Fabric 3 – 2 x 11 cm x 20cm - Lining  
1 button

**1 hoop**  
Select file 1



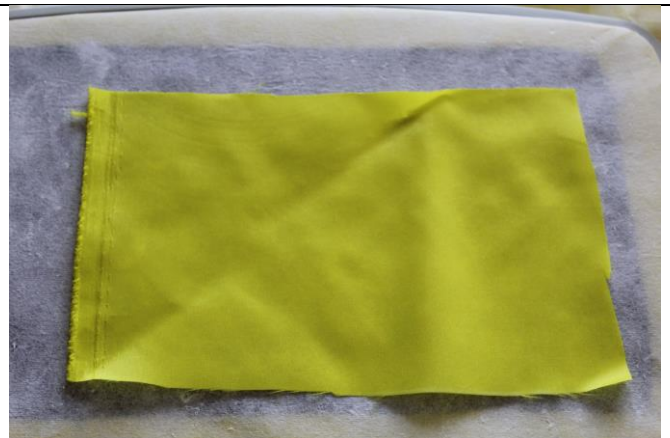
Hoop tear away stabilizer.



Fabric placement stitch. ( color 1)



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side



Place fabric3, to the BACK. Use adhesive tape to hold these layers in place while stitching.



Turn the hoops to the right side. Place fabric1 over outline. Use the glue



Stitch Color 2



Cut away the excess fabric.



Turn the hoop. Cut away the excess fabric



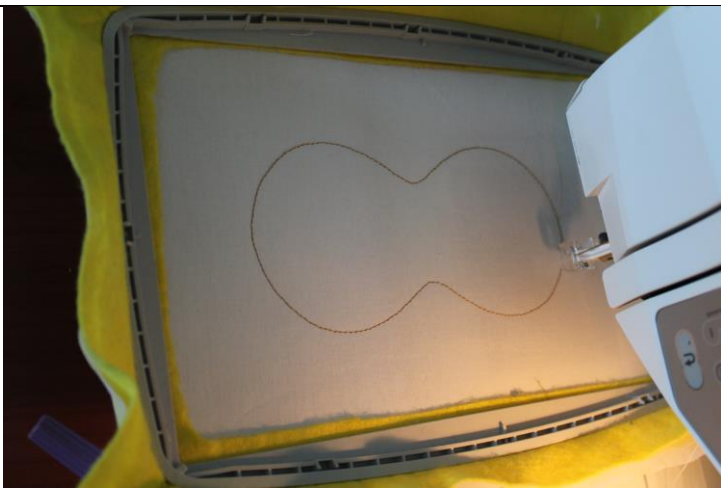
Stitch Color 3  
Remove the hoop from your machine.



Remove stabilizer.

## 2 hoop

Select file 2



Hoop tear away stabilizer and fabric2.  
Stitch Color 1-6

The main thing is very tight to pull the fabric in the Hoop. (It is very important)

Thread pick on the attached map colors and also focus on your color perception.

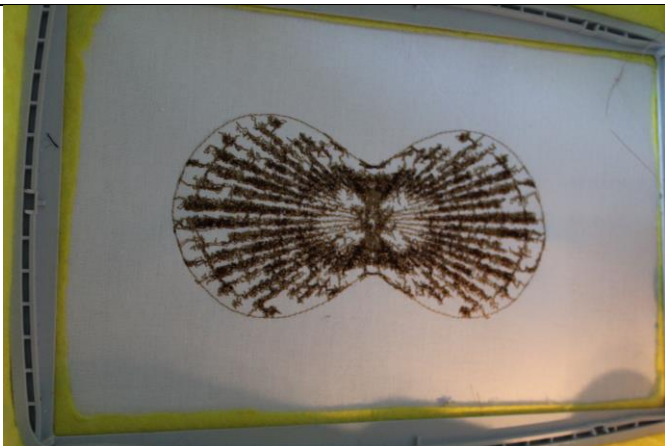
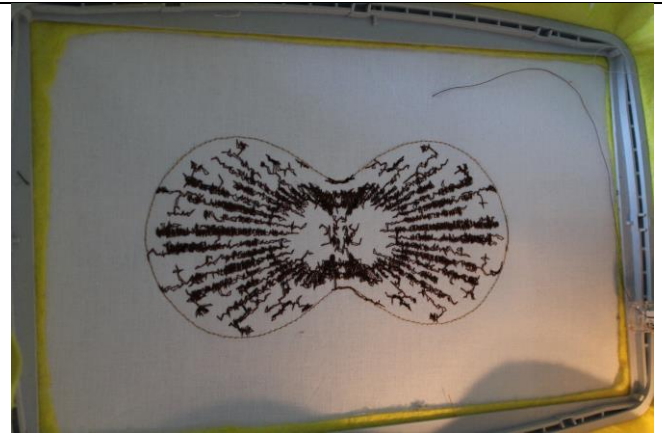
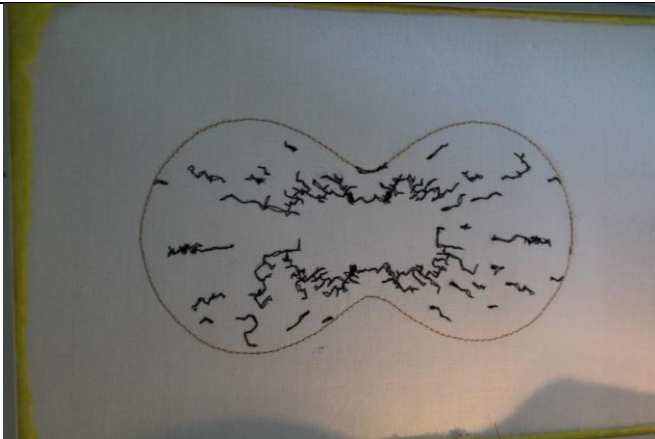
On home embroidery machines it is recommended to disable the knife.

It is extremely important to trim jump stitches after every color!

I recommended to embroider on a light fabric (white)



I used these colors





Place embroidery 1 wrong side up, securing it with tape. Combine lines



stitch color 7



Place fabric 3 (lining) wrong side up. stitch color 8



trim the seam to about 1/4 inch



turn the inside out. Hand stitch the opening closed



Now turn the right side out.



Iron your work.



To put the buttons
