

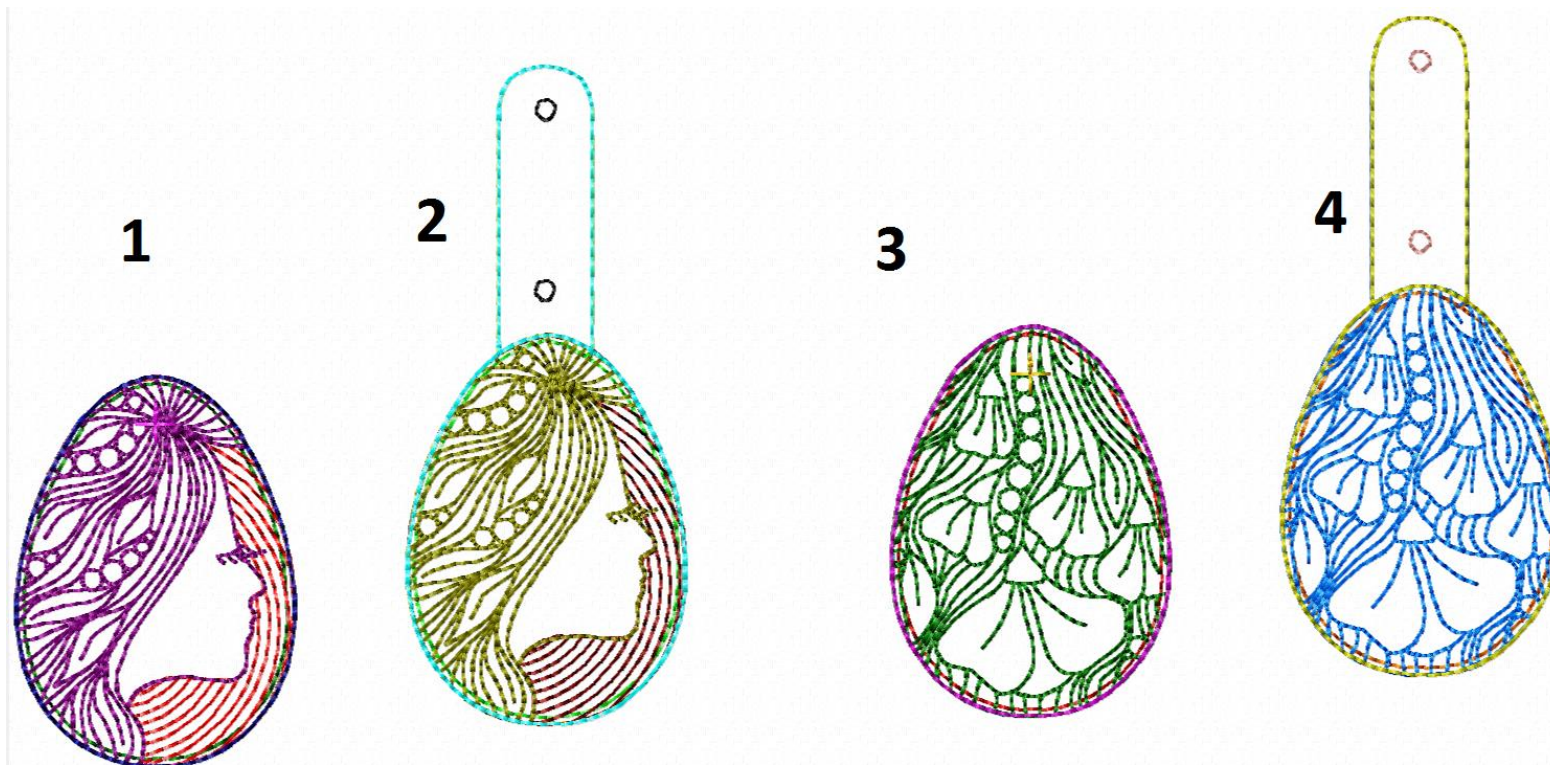
## Fob

**Pay attention** this is a universal instruction.

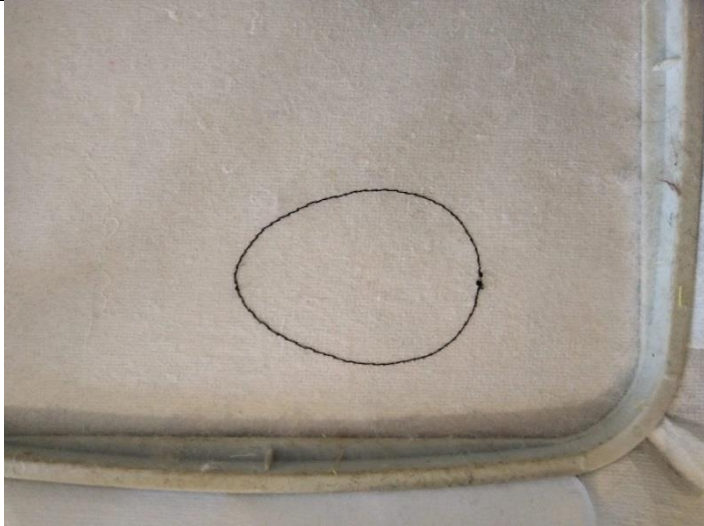
This instruction will work with most of my key fobs. So the patterns in the photo may be different (I'm sorry). But Photos with this purchased design will be placed next.

**Necessary materials.**

I use eco-leather and vinyl leather with a thickness of 0.6-0.85 mm

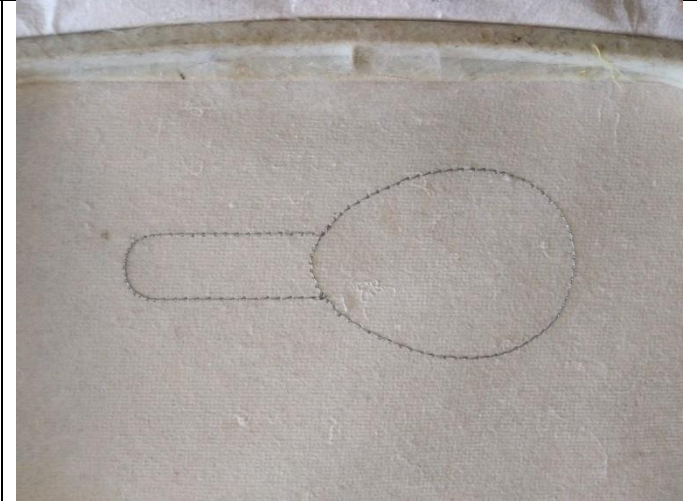

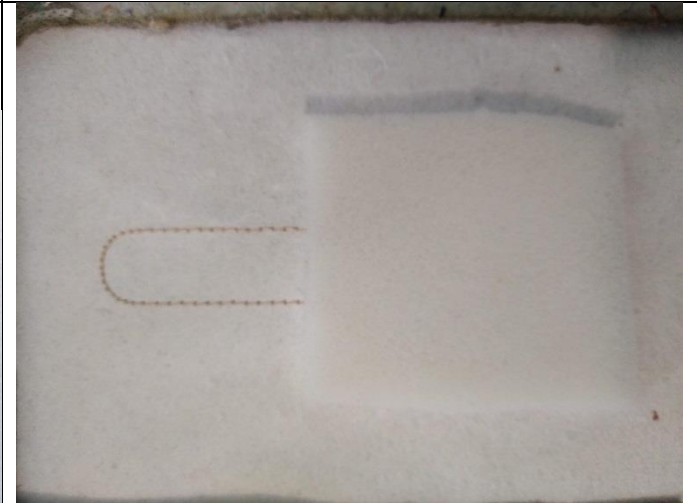


Hoop tearaway or cutaway stabilizer of medium density.

Stitch Color 1



Put polyester batting.  
Optional. You can skip this step. But there will be no volume. 2 options for comparison

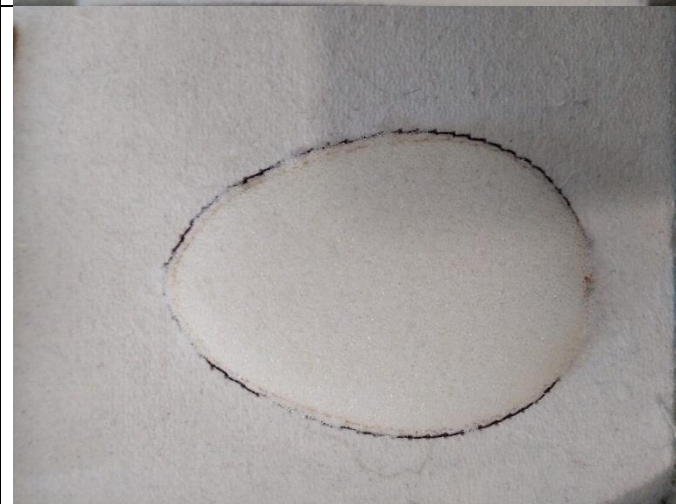
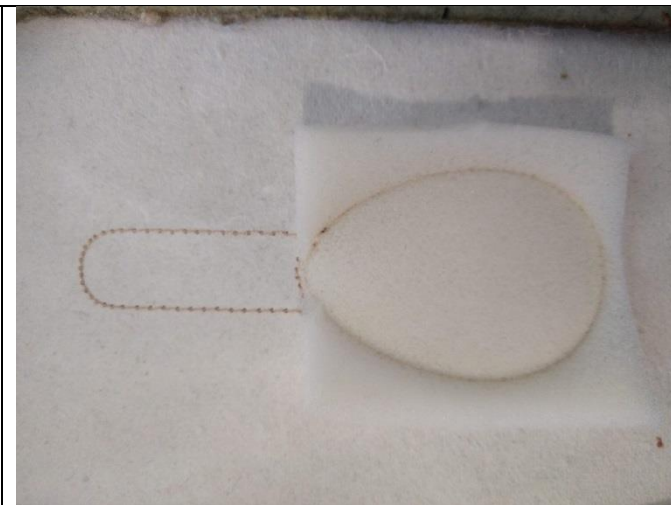




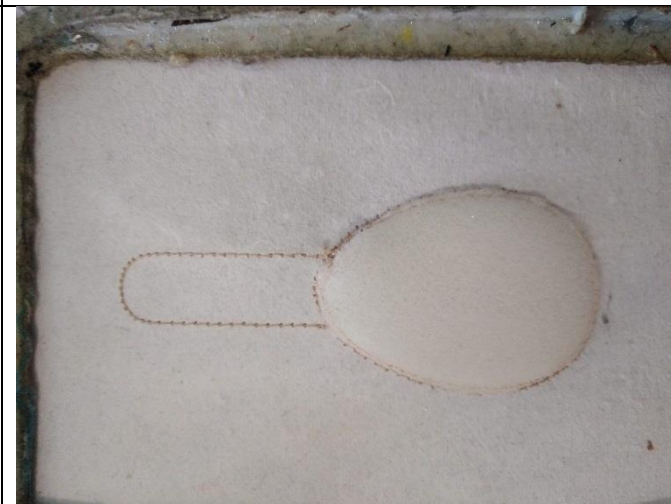


Stitch Color 2

You can skip this step. But there will be no volume.



Cut off the exceed the polyester batting around near stitch.







Put the main fabric face up.

Use the glue

*To make double-sided embroidery.*

*At this stage*

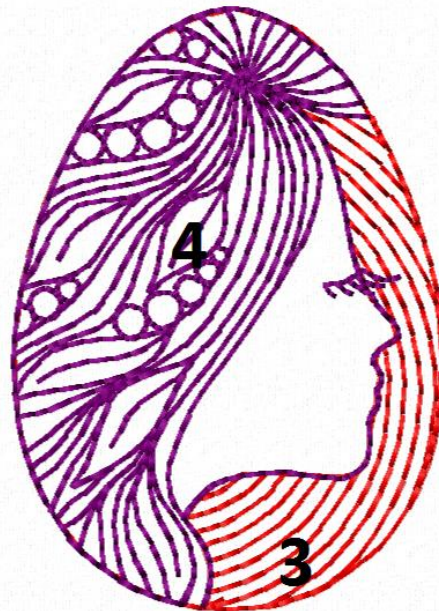
*Turn the hoop to the back side*

*Use adhesive tape to hold these layers in place while stitching.*



Stitch Color 3 – 4







Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side

Put the main fabric face up.

Use adhesive tape to hold these layers in place while stitching.

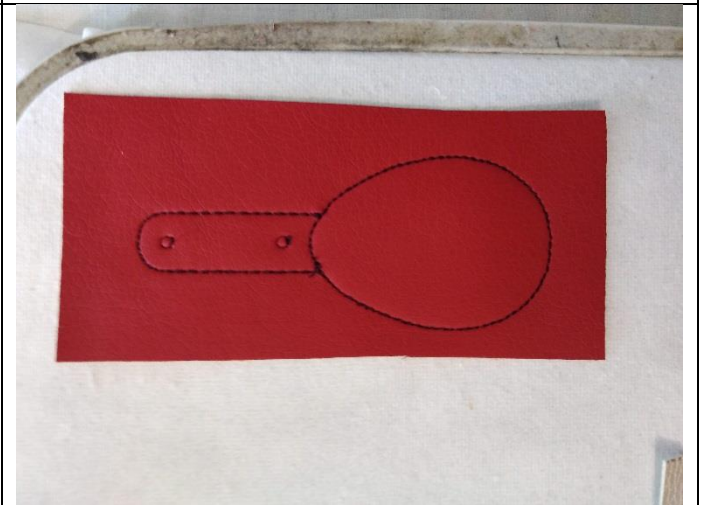
*If you are doing double-sided embroidery, skip this step*

To get 2-sided embroidery you should use the same thread for the needle thread and bobbin thread

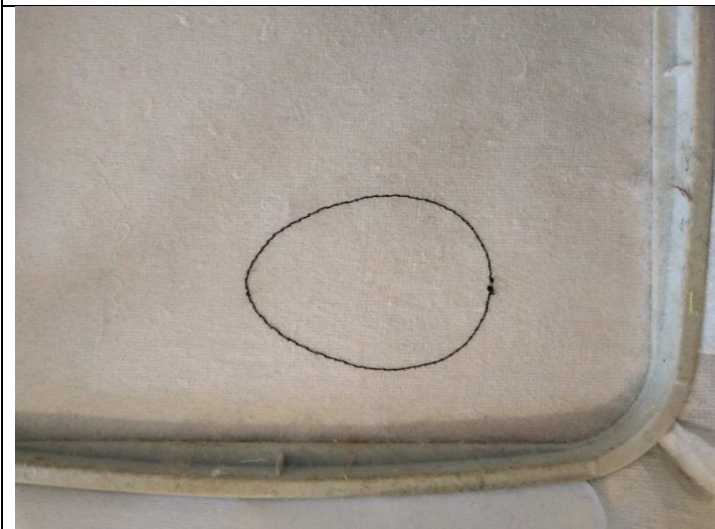
Stitch Color 6 - the placement for eyelet or a button





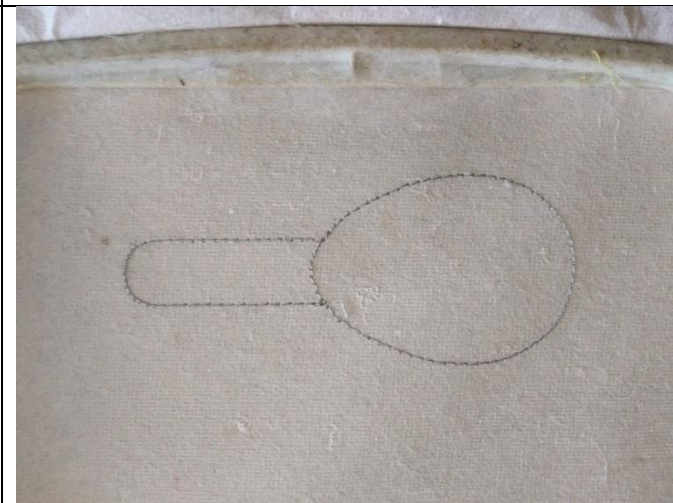
Trim the seams to about 2-3 mm.

Hoop tearaway or cutaway stabilizer of medium density.

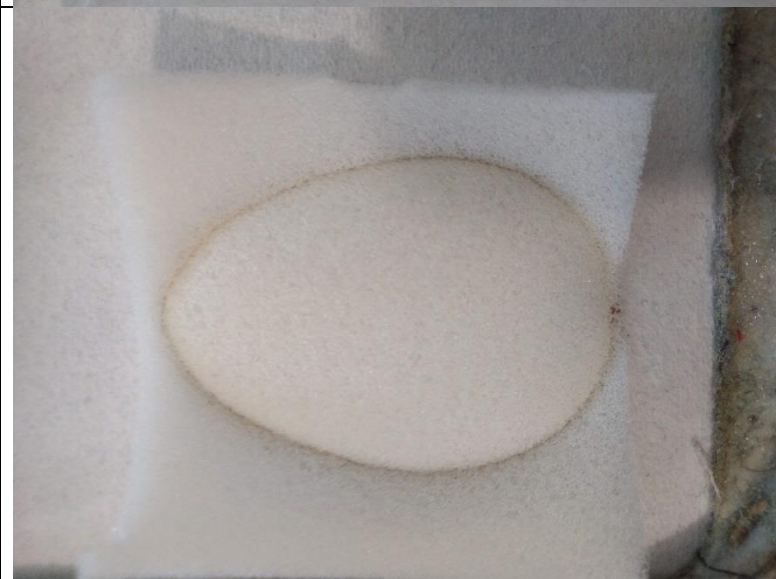
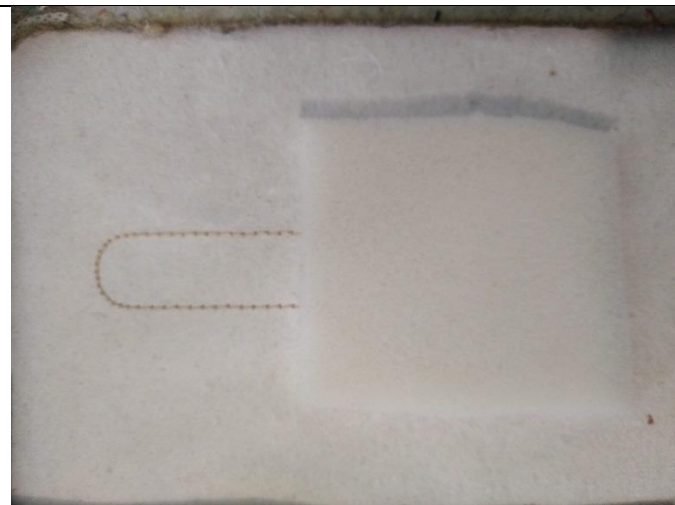

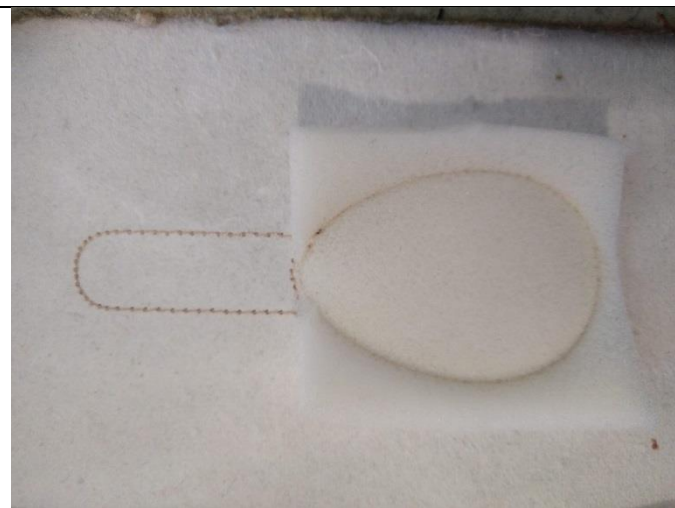


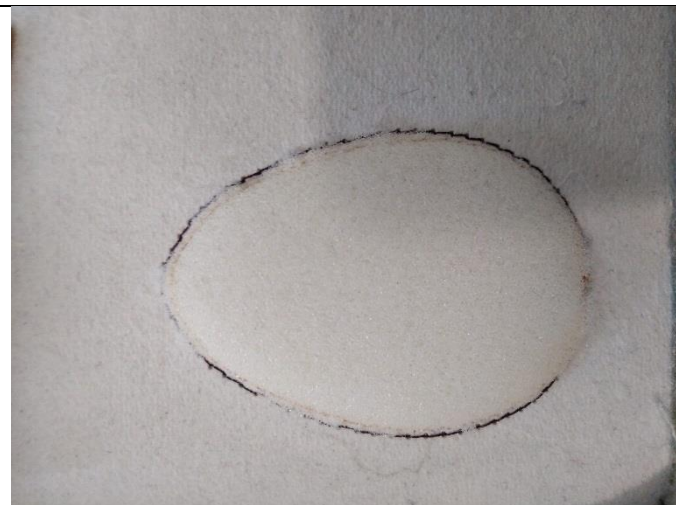


Put polyester batting.

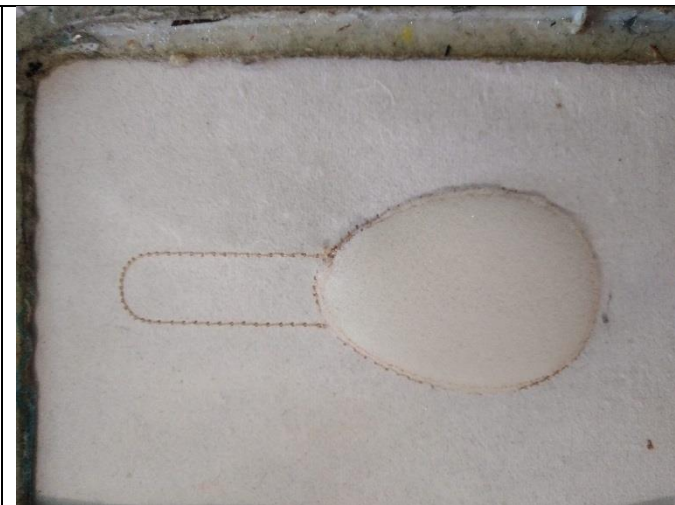


Stitch Color 2

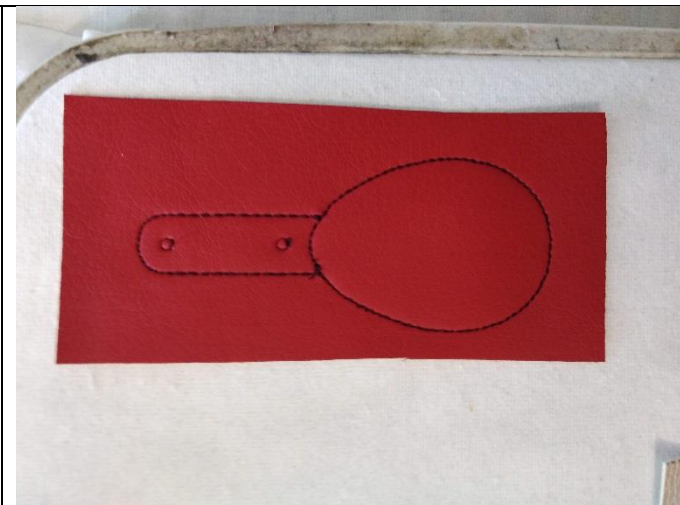




#### Stitch Color 4

To get 2-sided embroidery you should use the same thread for the needle thread and bobbin thread

Trim the seams to about 2-3 mm.
