

# The pencil case

(only 1 size)

Capacious pencil case. It can be used as a cosmetic bag.

The pencil case zipper has two sliders that make it very convenient to use

## Recommended fabrics.

The choice of fabric depends on your preferences.

I use eco-leather and vinyl leather with a thickness of 0.6-0.85 mm. If the skin is very thin, it should be glued with a thin dublerin. You can also use cotton linen, satin.

The filler – rubber foam with a thickness of 5 mm or polyester batting 80 or 100.

Necessary materials.

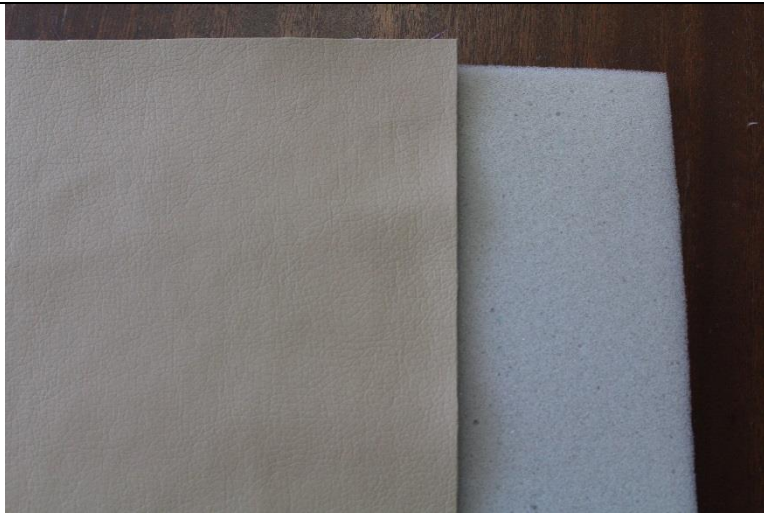
## Button - 4 pieces

Designation of files

**File 1** - Side panel parts (2 parts)

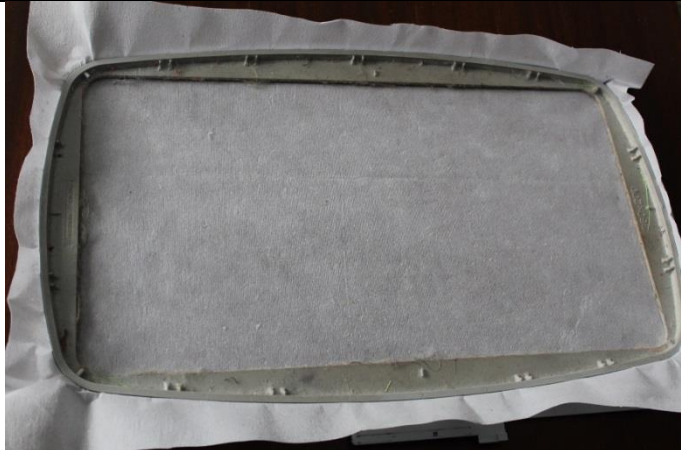
**File 2** - The main part of the pencil case

Download the archive to your computer. Extract the files from the archive. Download files 1, 2 to your embroidery machine in the way you are used to.

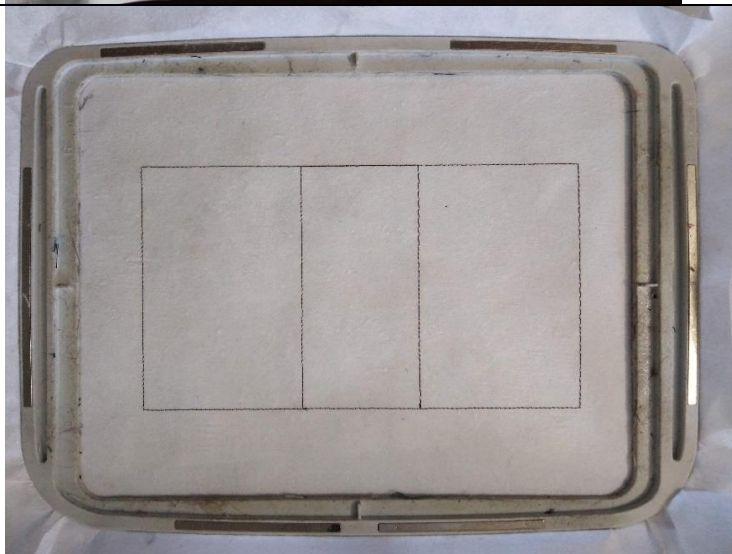


Fabric - eco-leather, vinyl  
Polyester batting

### File 1 - Side panel parts



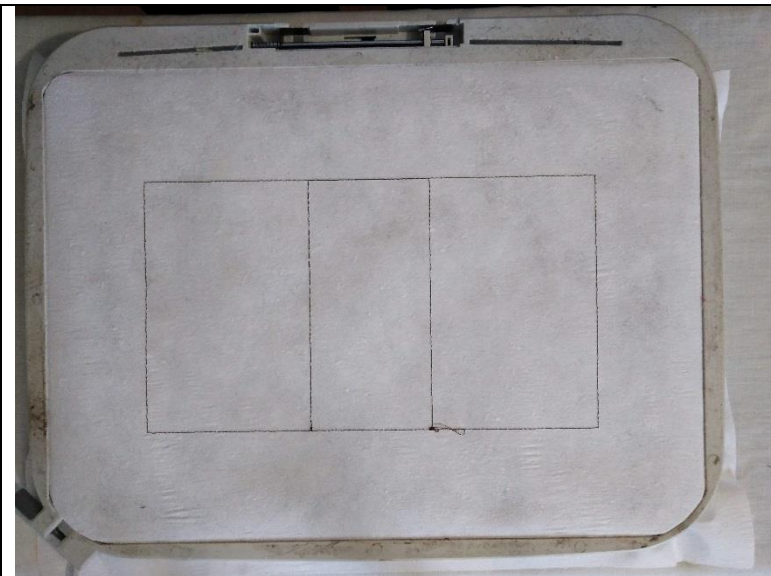
Select file 1.  
Hoop tearaway or water-soluble stabilizer.



Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for design

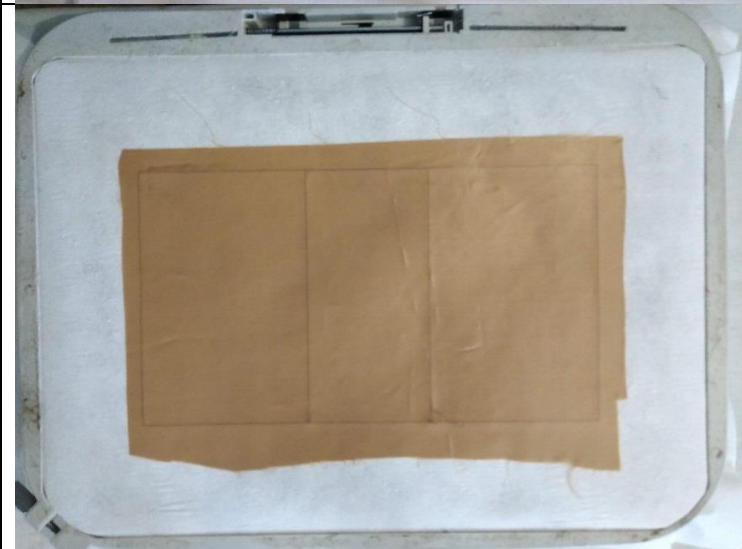


Put the lining **B** in the middle.  
Fix it with glue.



Turn the hoop over so the wrong side is up.

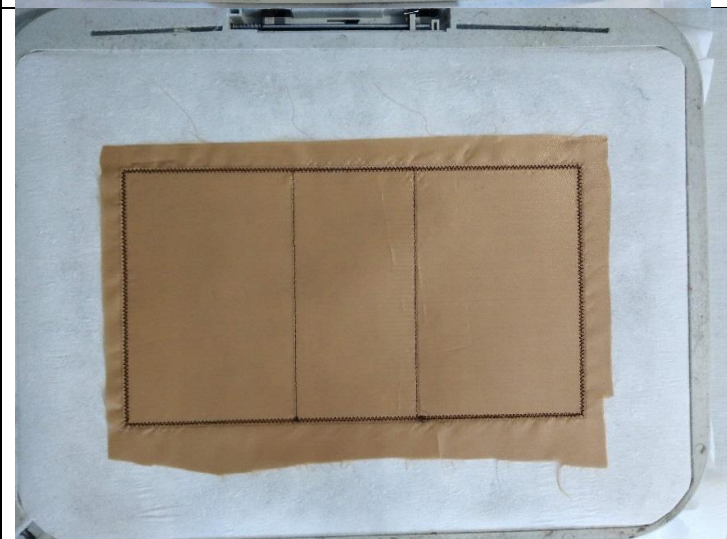
(back of hoop view)



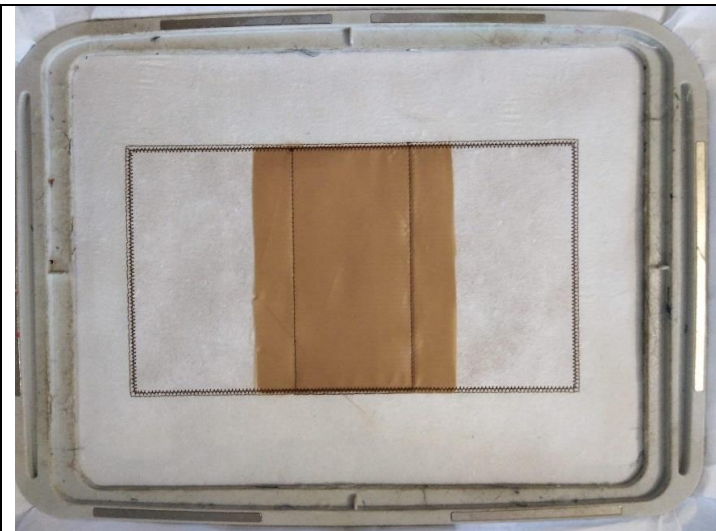
Place Lining **A** on the hoop right side up.  
Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.



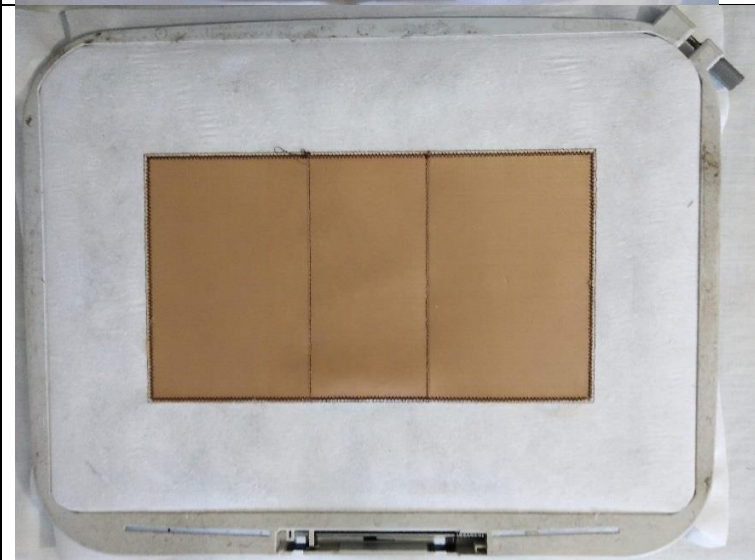
Stitch Color 2 - zigzag for trimming



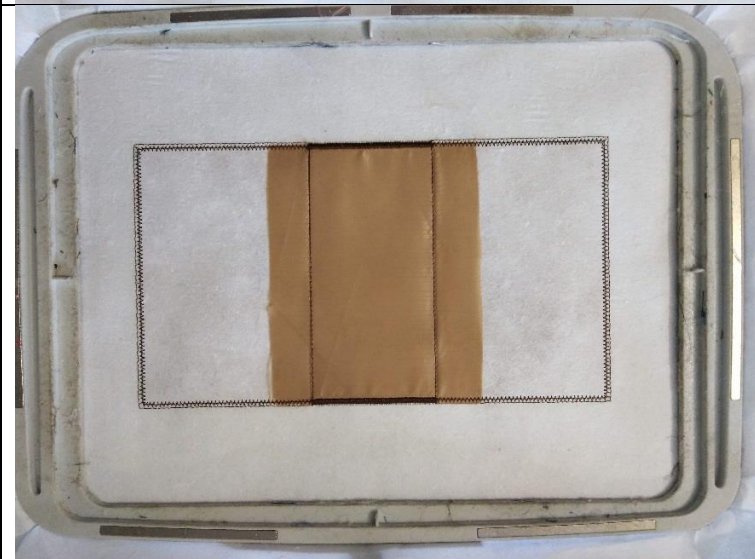
(back of hoop view)



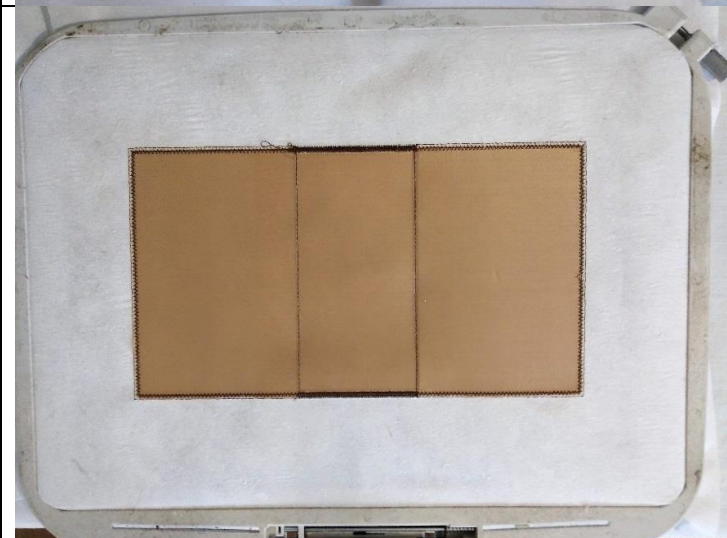
Cut off the exceed lining close to the zigzag-stitch on both sides of the hoop.



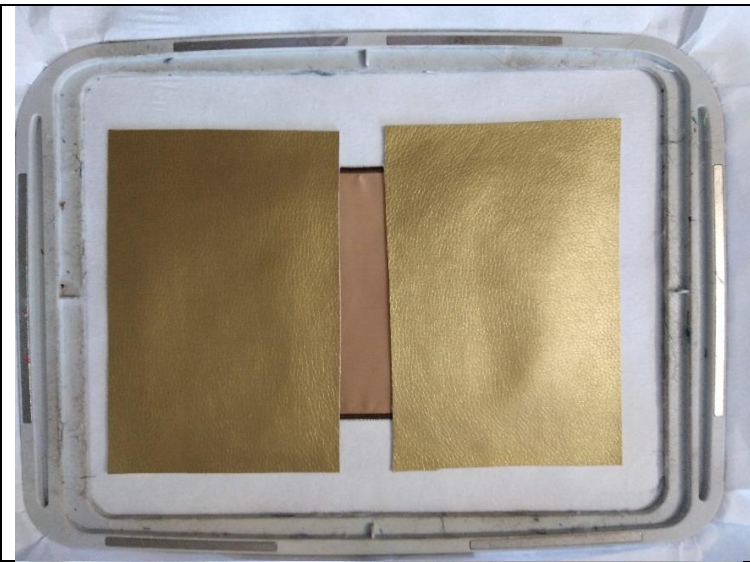
(back of hoop view)



Stitch Color 3 - satin border



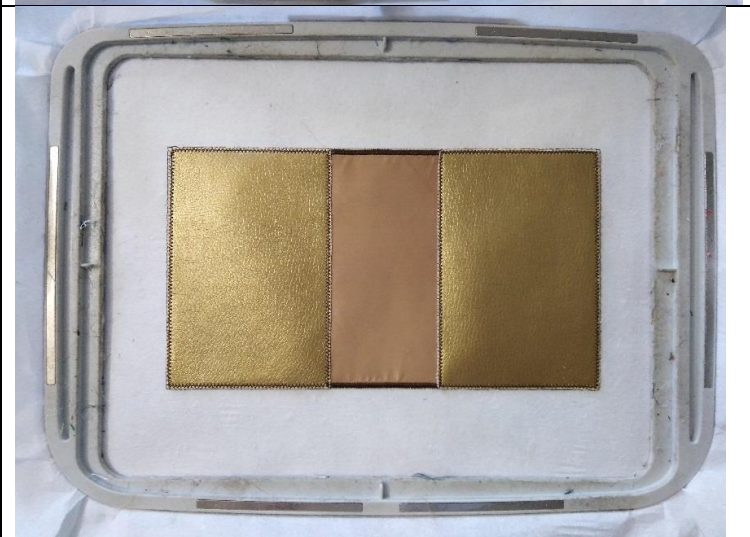

Put 2 pieces of the main fabric **C** (as in the photo)



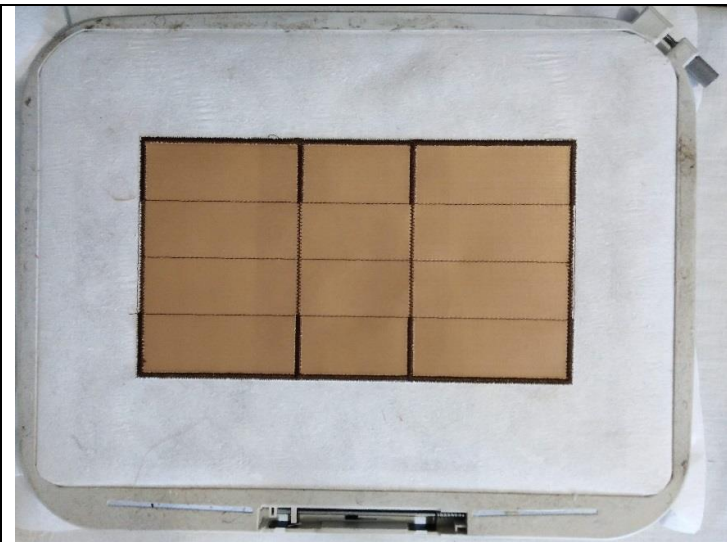
Stitch Color 4 - zigzag for trimming



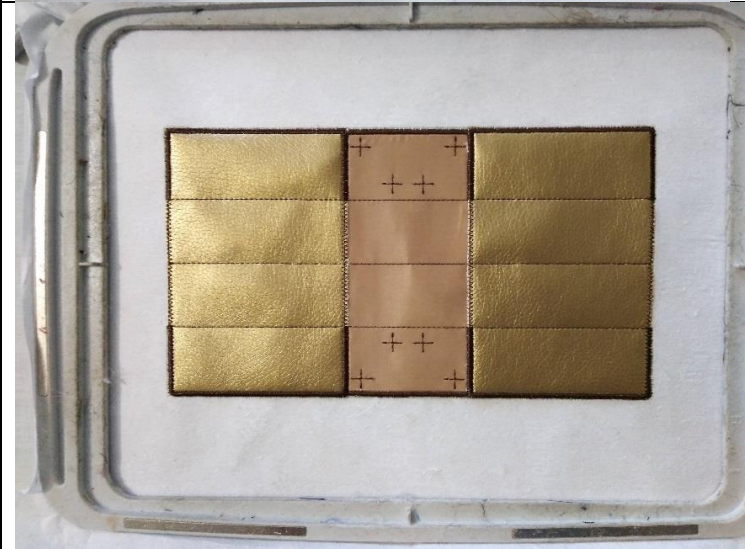
Cut off the exceed material around near zigzag stitch



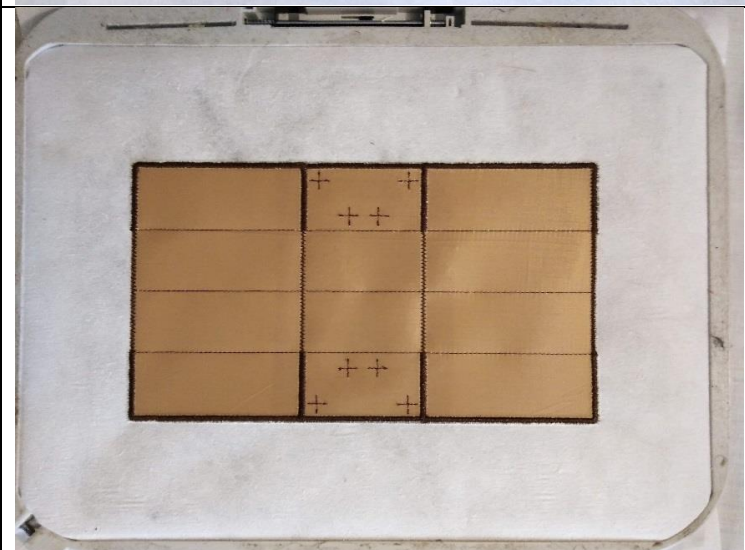
Stitch Color 5 - satin border



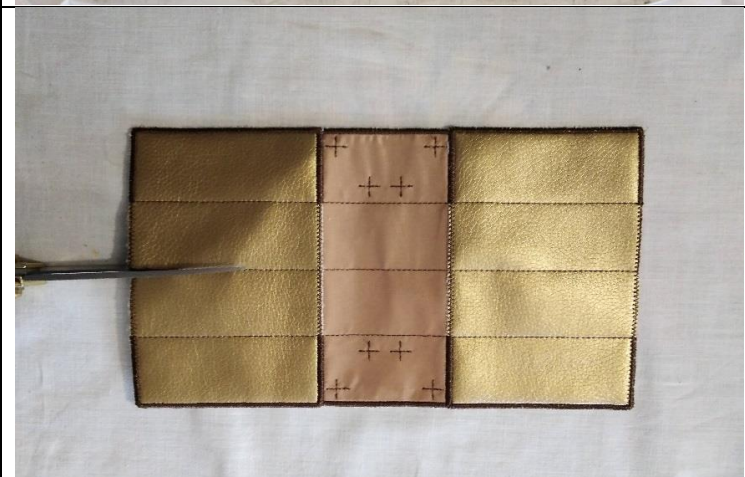

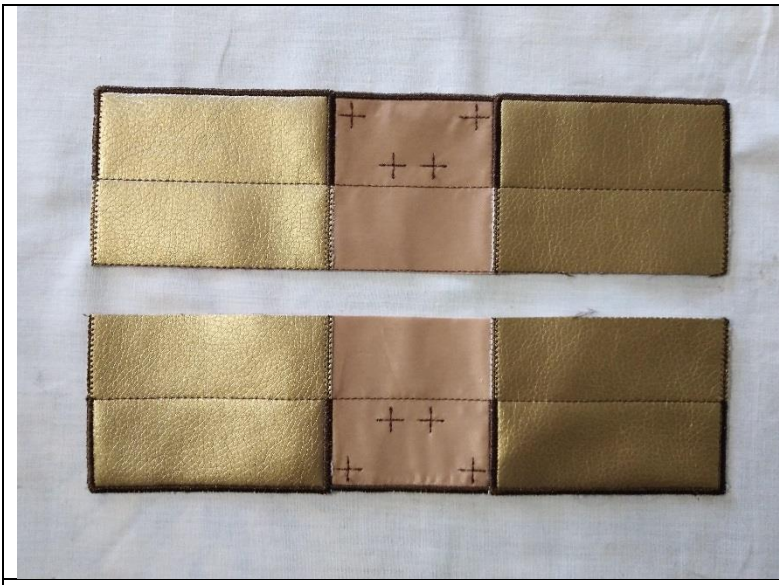
Stitch Color 6 - the placement line for Button

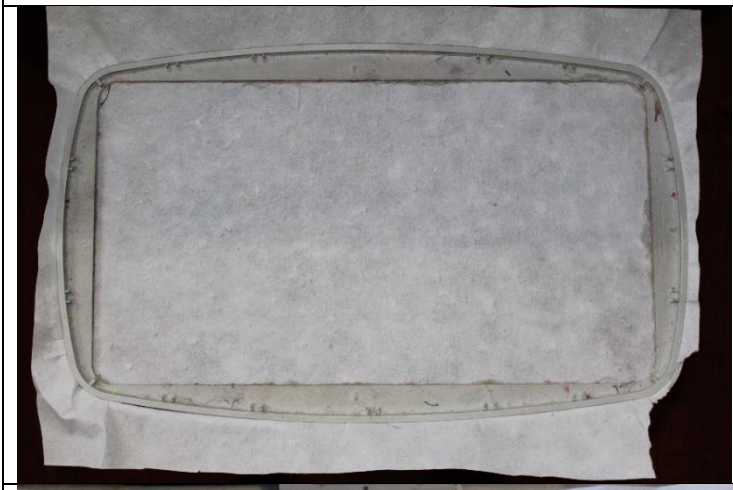
Cut along the center line to get 2 parts.



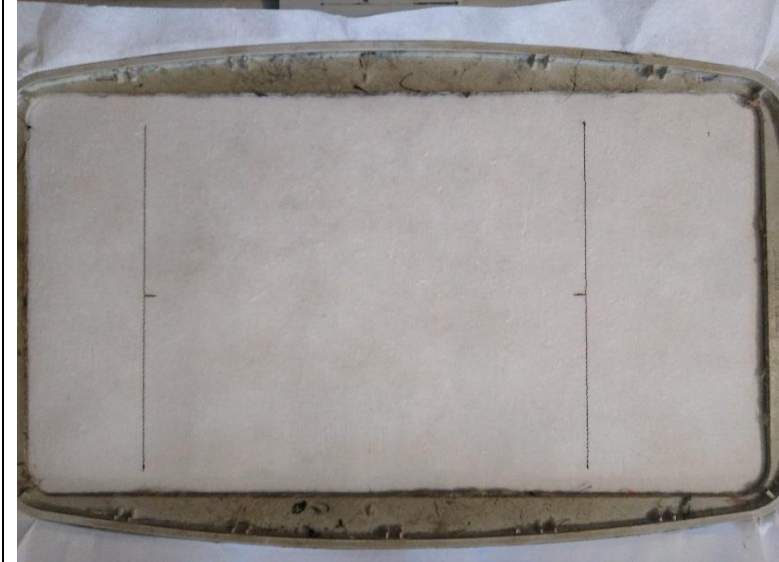
Remove the remaining stabilizer.  
The first two pieces are ready.

Select **file 2**

Hoop tearaway or water-soluble stabilizer.



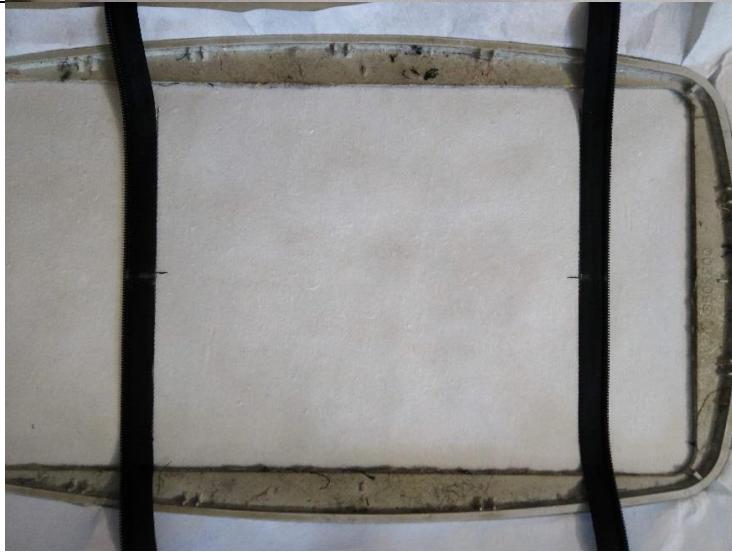
Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for design



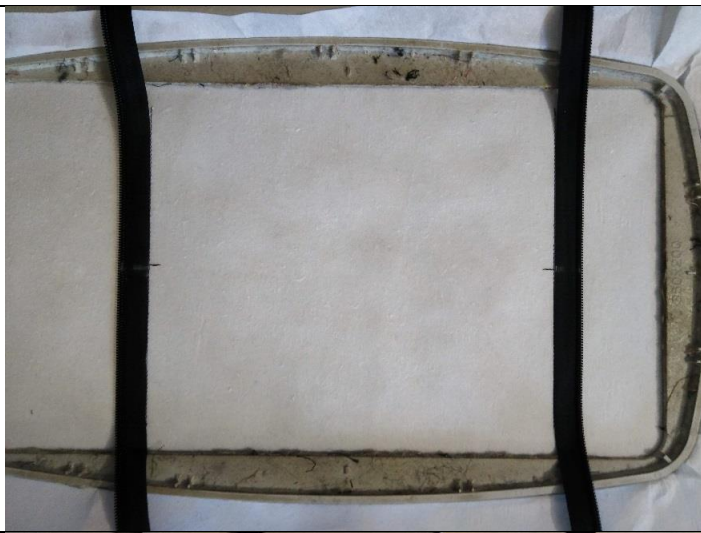
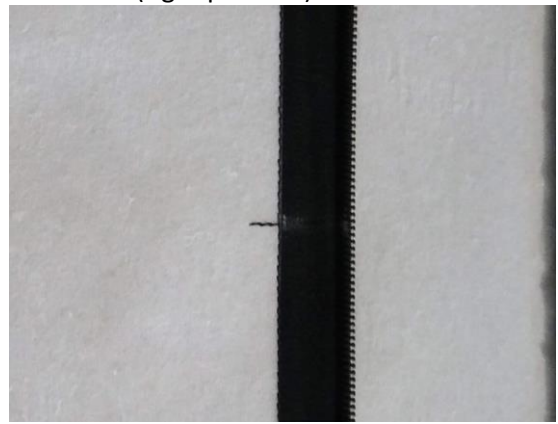
Fold the zipper in half to find the middle.



Make a mark.

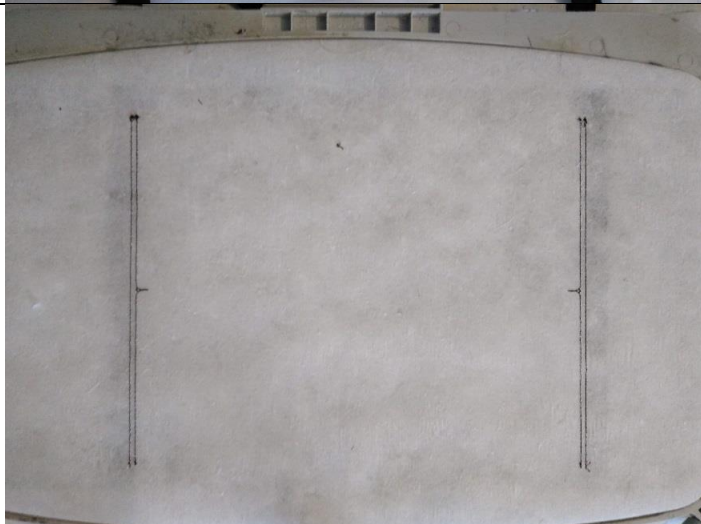


Open the zipper  
Attach the edge of the zipper tape to the stitch aligning the marks (right part out)



Stitch Color 2-3 fixing zippers to the stabilizer

To control the process a stop is programmed after the second color



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side.





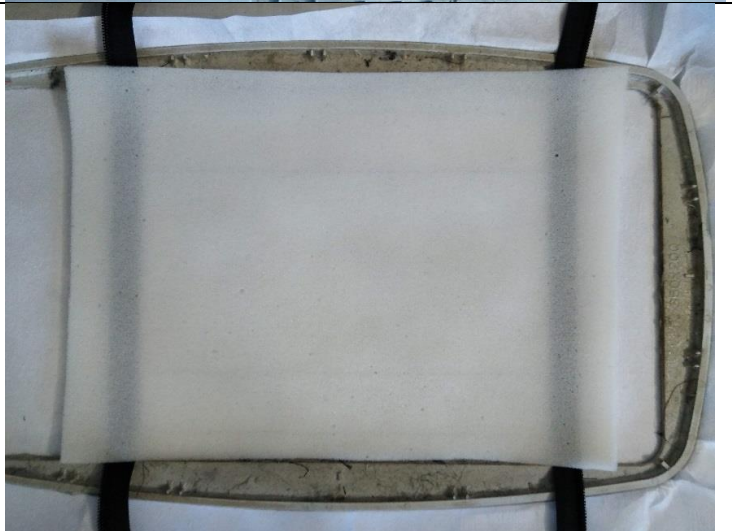
Place the lining **E** face up on the back of the hoop.  
Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.



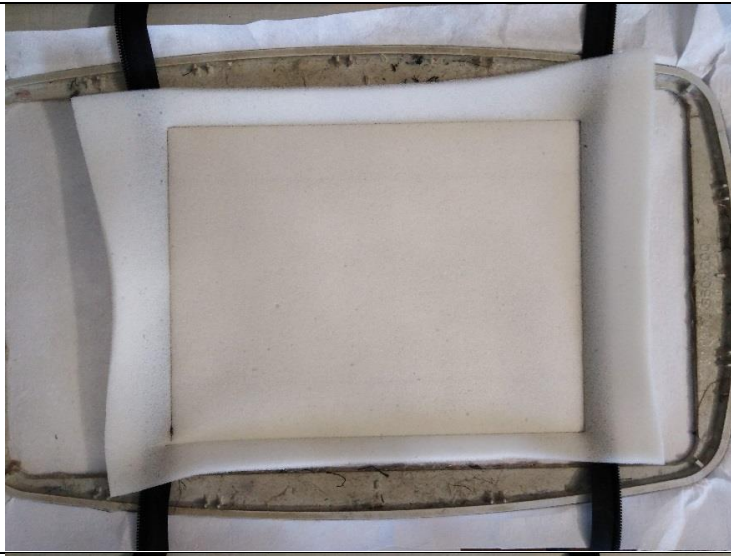
Stitch Color 4  
Fixing the lining and auxiliary stitches.  
These are auxiliary stitches that will serve you in the future.



(back of hoop view)



Put polyester batting **F**.  
You can use temporary fixation glue.



Stitch Color 5



Cut off the exceed the polyester batting around near stitch.



Put the main fabric **D** face up.

Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.

Stitch Color 6 - Fixation of fabric

At this stage you can embroider your patterns



Stitch Color 7 - the basic pattern



Remove the hoop from the machine and turn to the back side.



Put the side panel parts to the lines, so that the lines match with the stitches, embroidered early. As on photo.  
Secure the pieces with adhesive tape. Make sure that the adhesive tape does not fall under the stitch and under the fastening of the hoop.



Stitch Color 8

Check if the side parts are sewn correctly. Correct them if necessary.



Stitch Color 9 - zigzag for trimming



Cut off the exceed fabric close to the stitch on both sides of the hoop.

Stitch Color 10 - satin border.

Remove the stabilizer  
The main part are ready.



Fold the pencil case piece in half aligning the side edges and zippers. Make sure that the zipper parts are of the same size.



Insert the the sliders into both sides of the zipper.

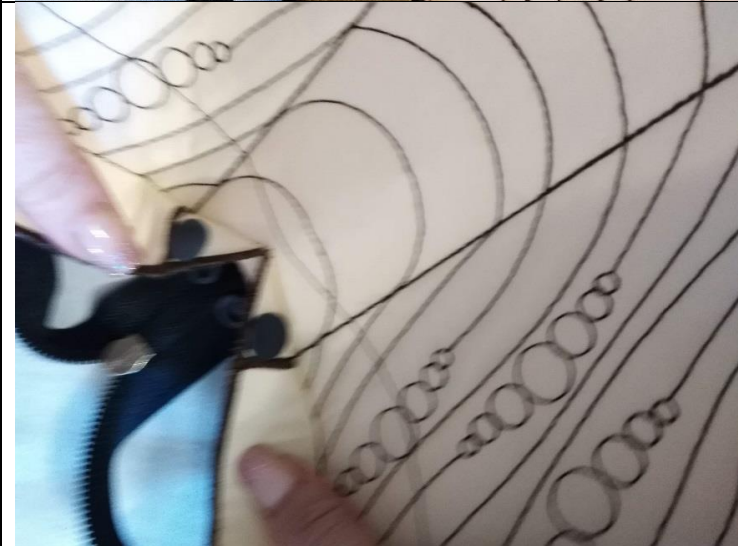




Install the buttons as in the photo.



Set the 1st part of the snap button, which is closer to the edge, fixing the main piece, the side part and the zipper tape.  
The second part of the snap button is installed only on the side piece.





Fold the pencil case piece in half, face inward, aligning the edges of the side pieces.

Sew them over the edge with overcast hand stitch.





For clarity I used the thread of contrast color.







Turn the pencil case out, fasten the buttons and straighten the corners.



Your pencil case is ready.
