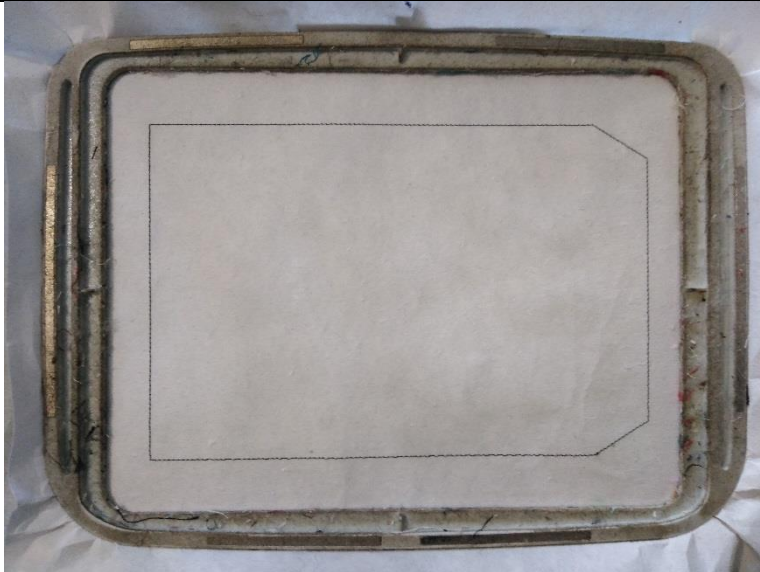


Pencil case - organizer

I recommend using a thick fabric that holds its shape well. Vinyl, eco-leather, felt.



File 1-the main part.

Hoop tearaway stabilizer.

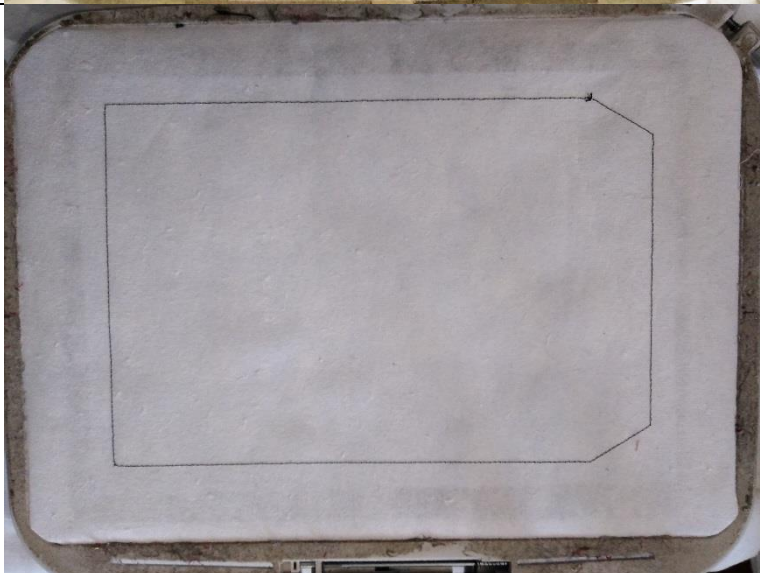
Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for design



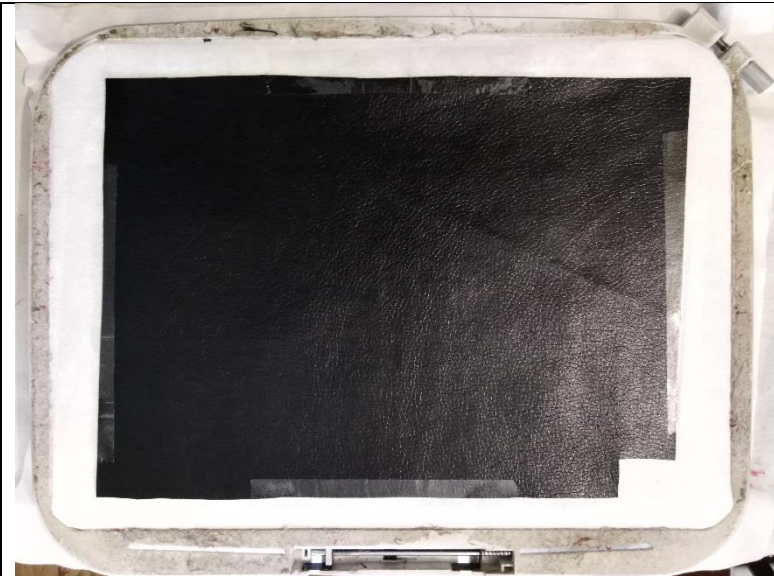
Put the main fabric face up.

Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.

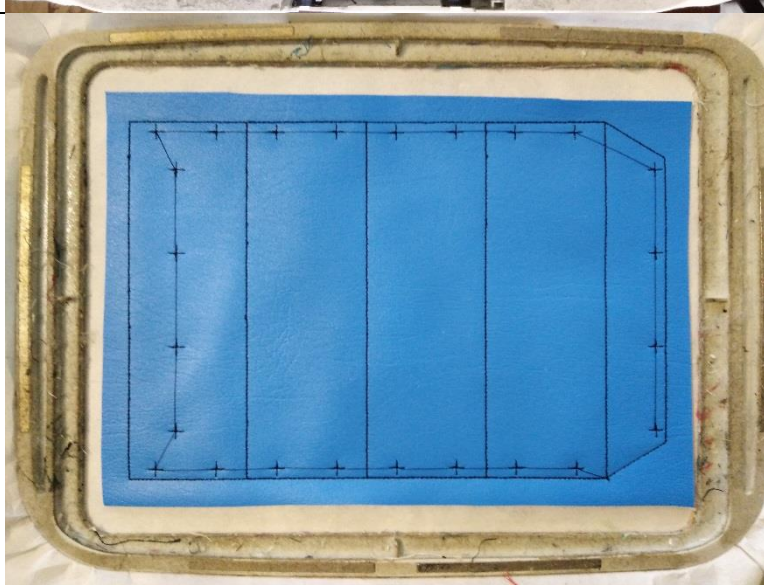
Fabric size = design size + 0.5-1 inch to width and height



Turn to the back side.

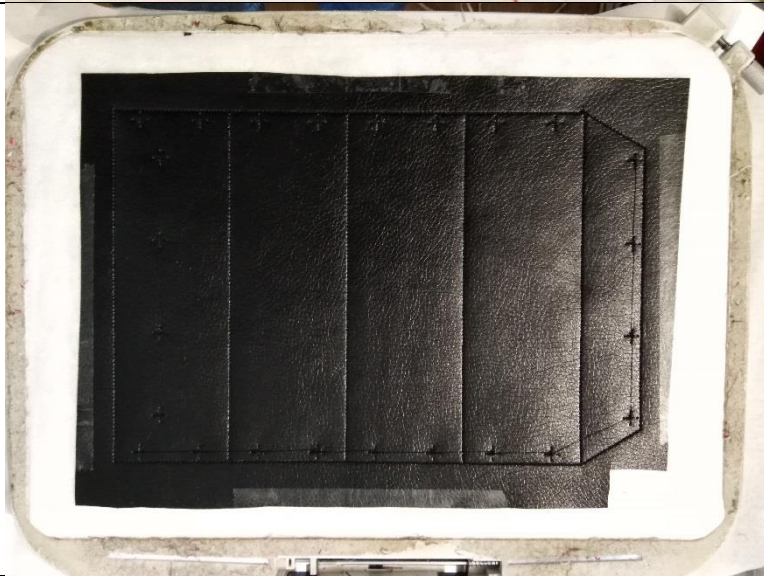


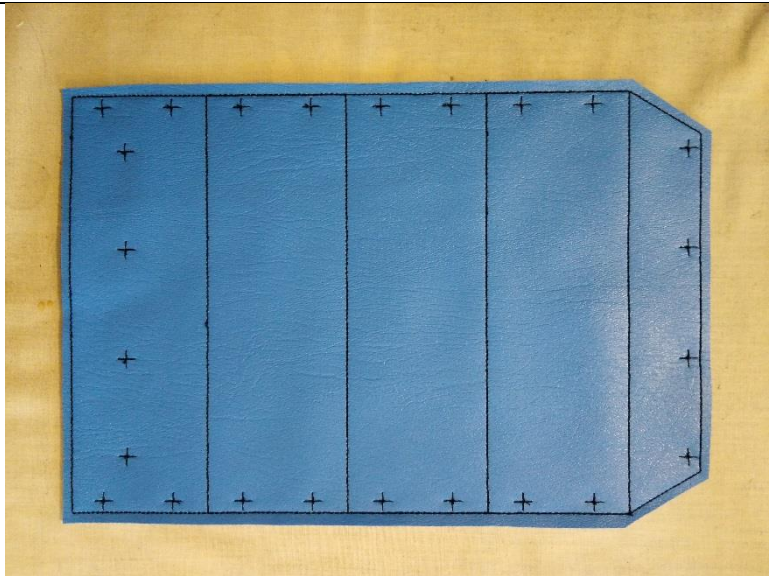

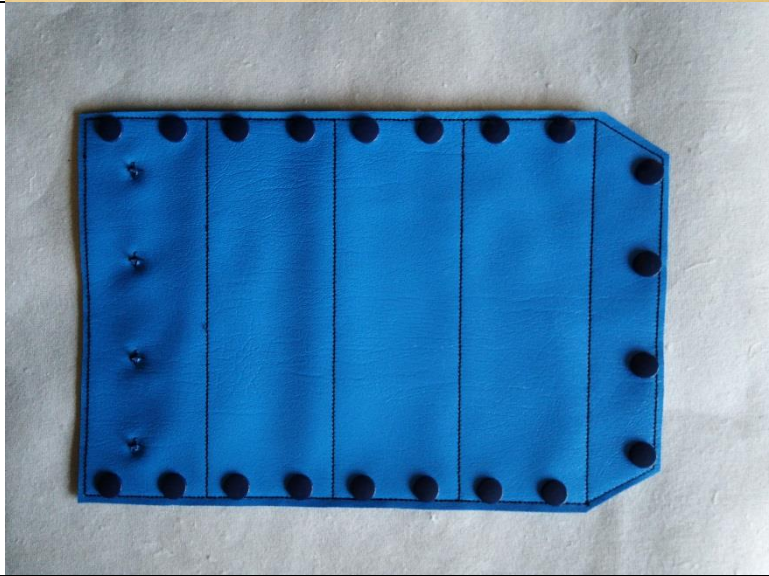
Stitch Color 2

Stitch Color 3 - the placement for the button.

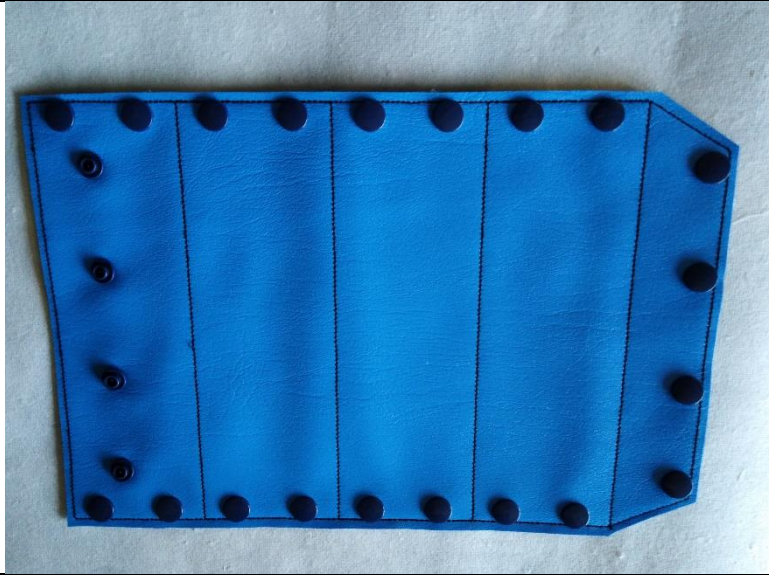


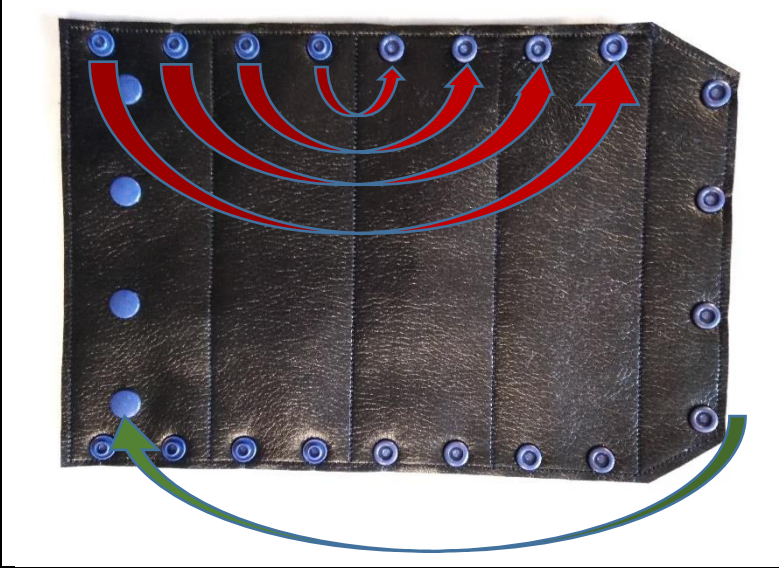
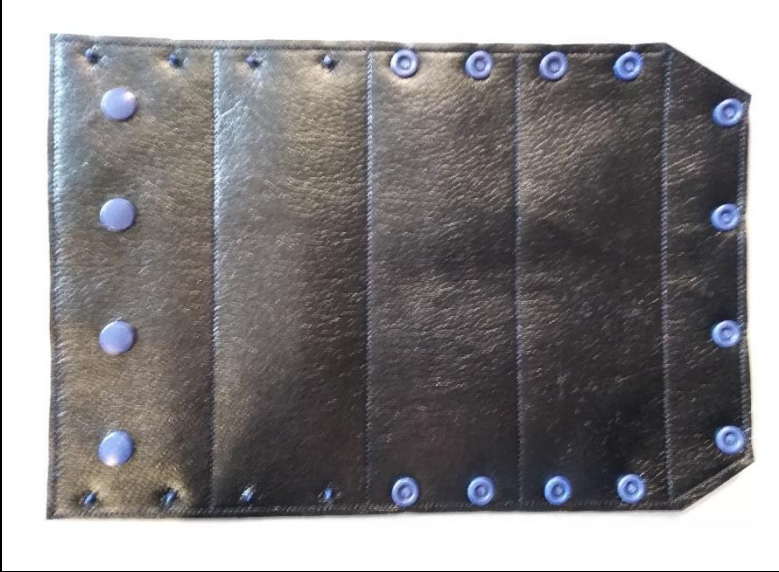


Trim the seams to about 2-3 mm.

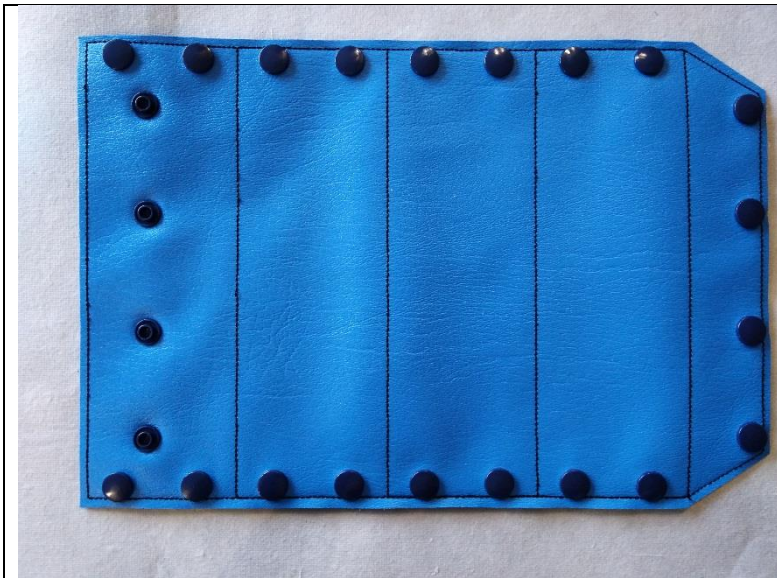

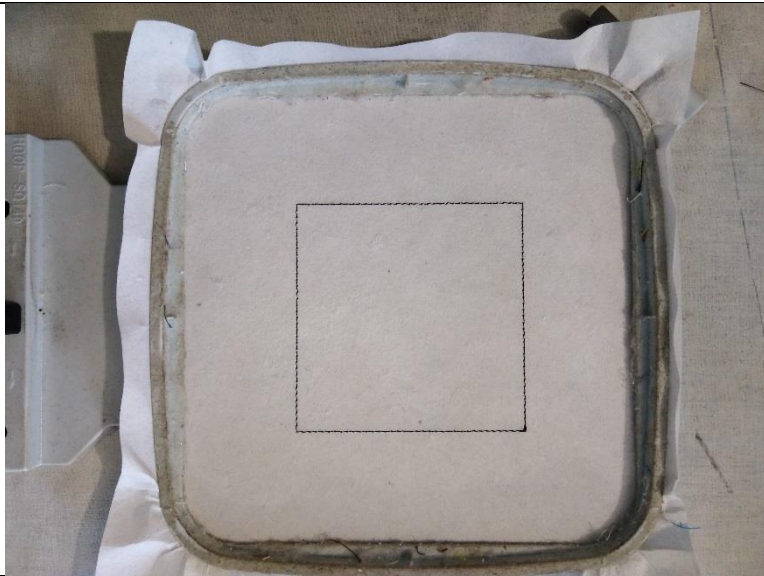

Hoop tearaway stabilizer.

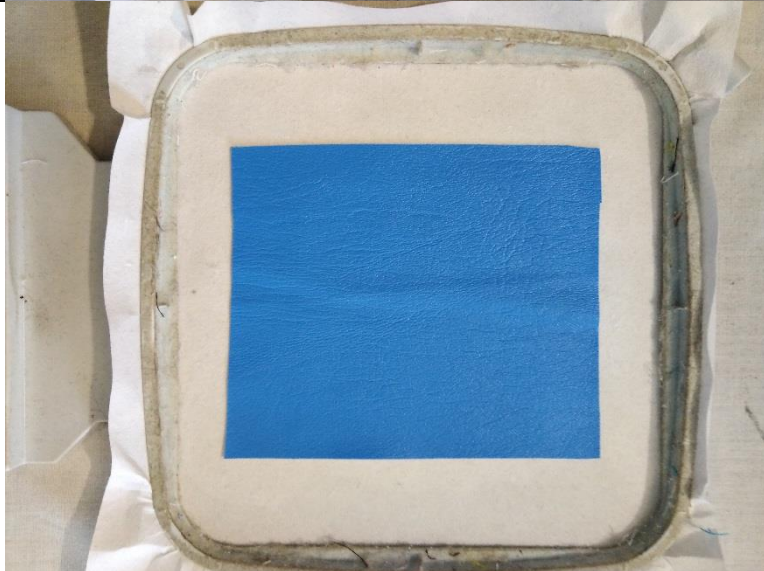
Stitch Color 1 - the placement line for design

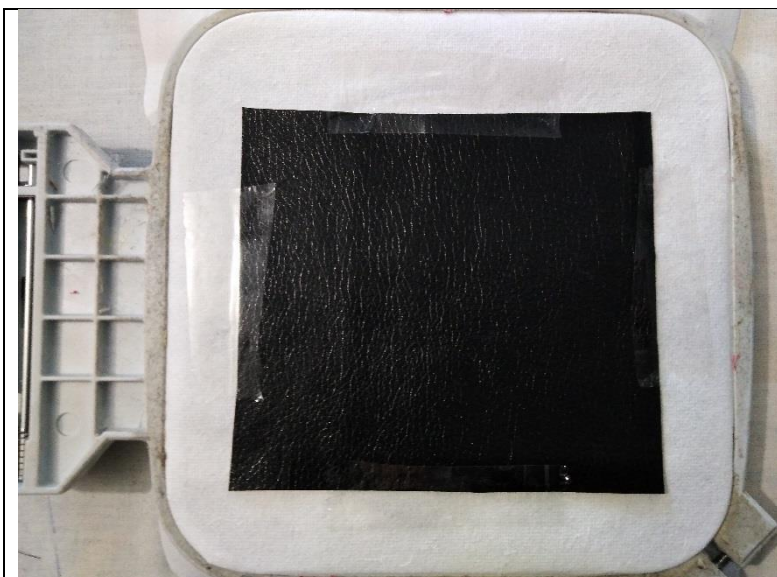


Put the main fabric face up.

Fix it with glue or adhesive tape.

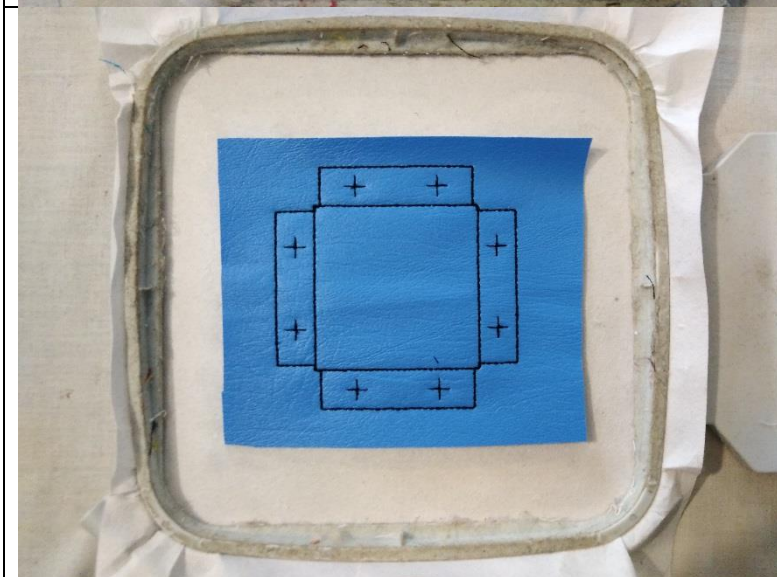
Fabric size = design size + 0.5-1 inch to width and height





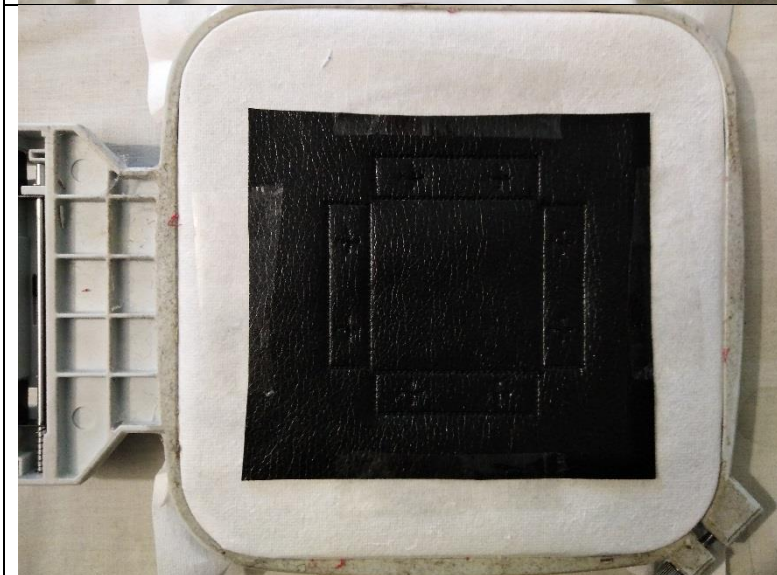

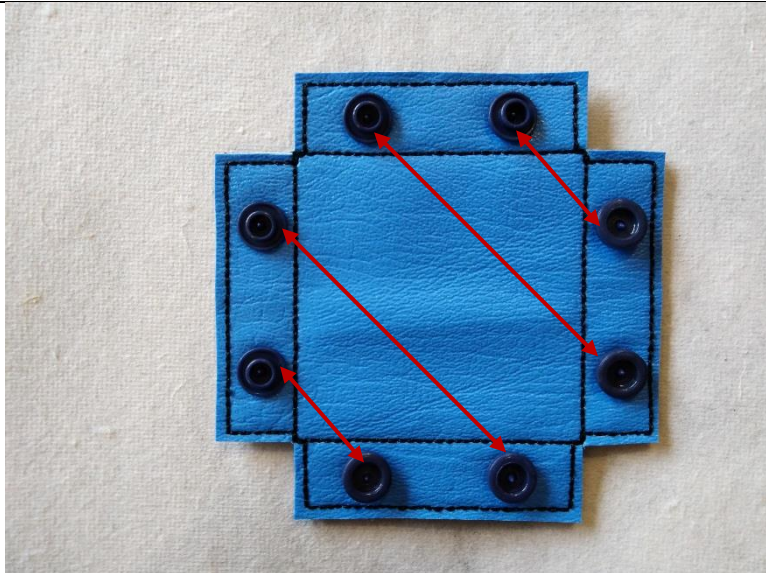
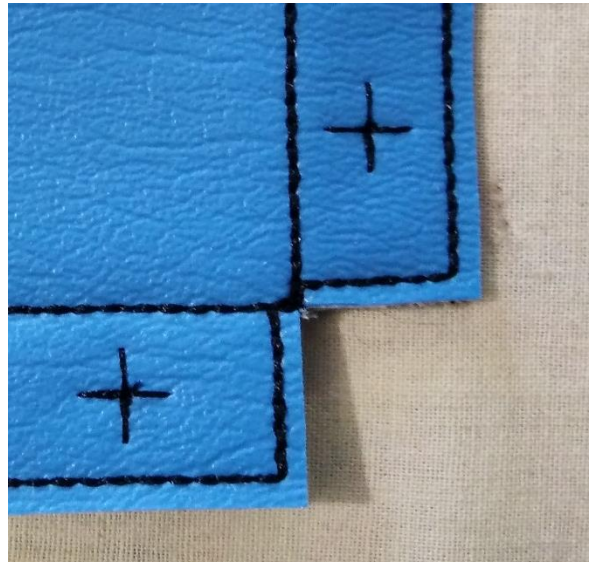
Stitch Color 2

Stitch Color 3 - the placement for the button.

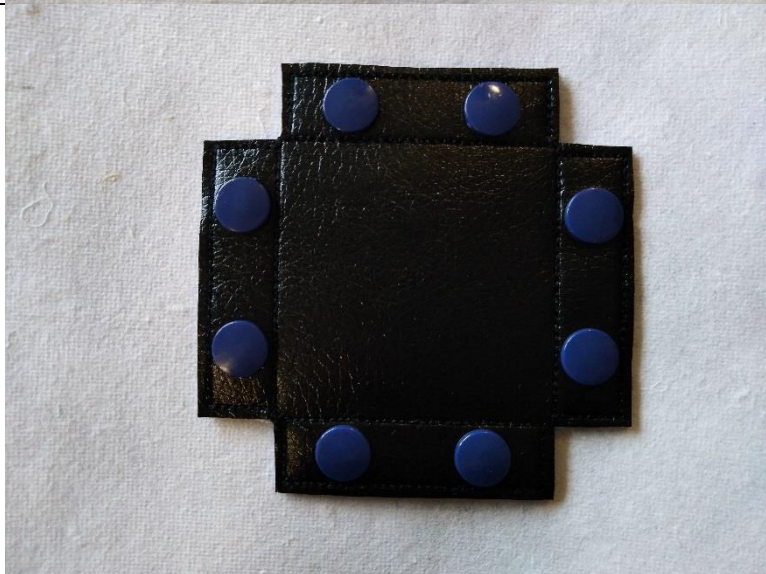


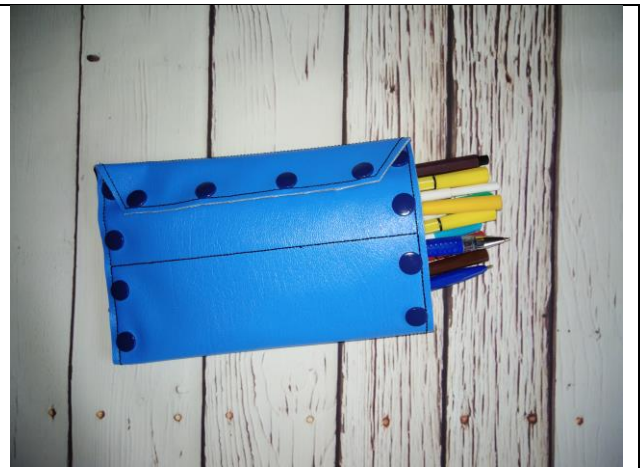


Trim the seams to about 2-3 mm.



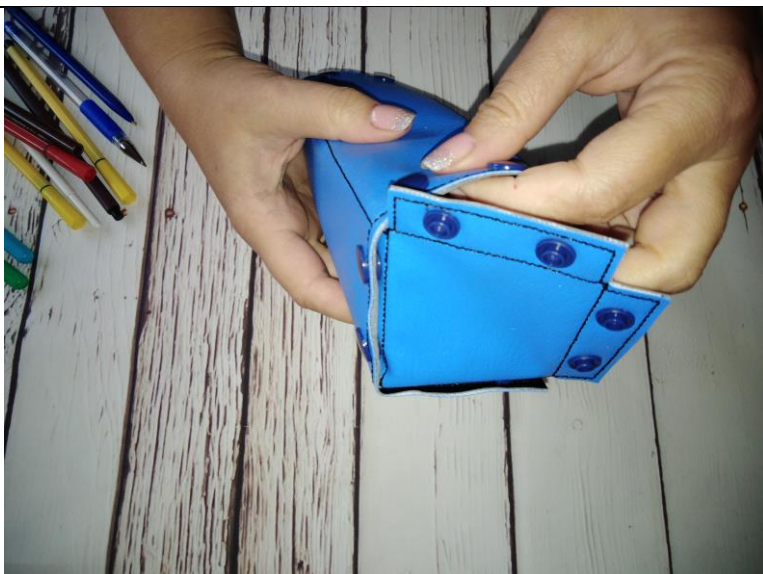
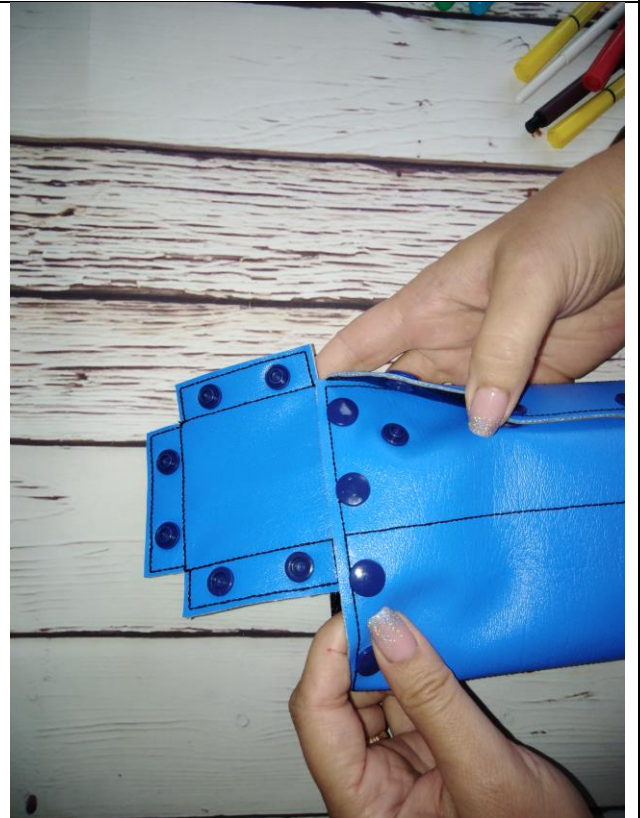

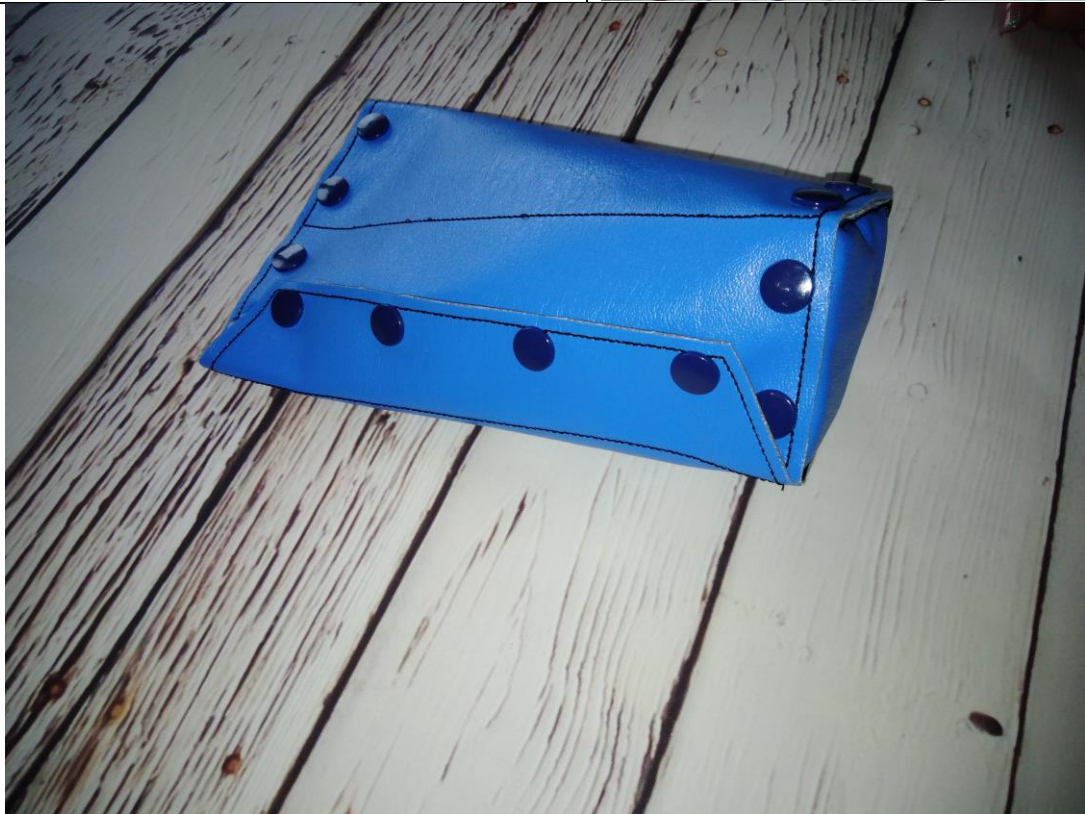




Fasten the buttons
