

Gnome Garland – In the Hoop



WHAT IS NEEDED:

Foam 1 cm
Padding 1 cm
Felt or fabric of your choice

STEP TO MAKE THE CIRCLE



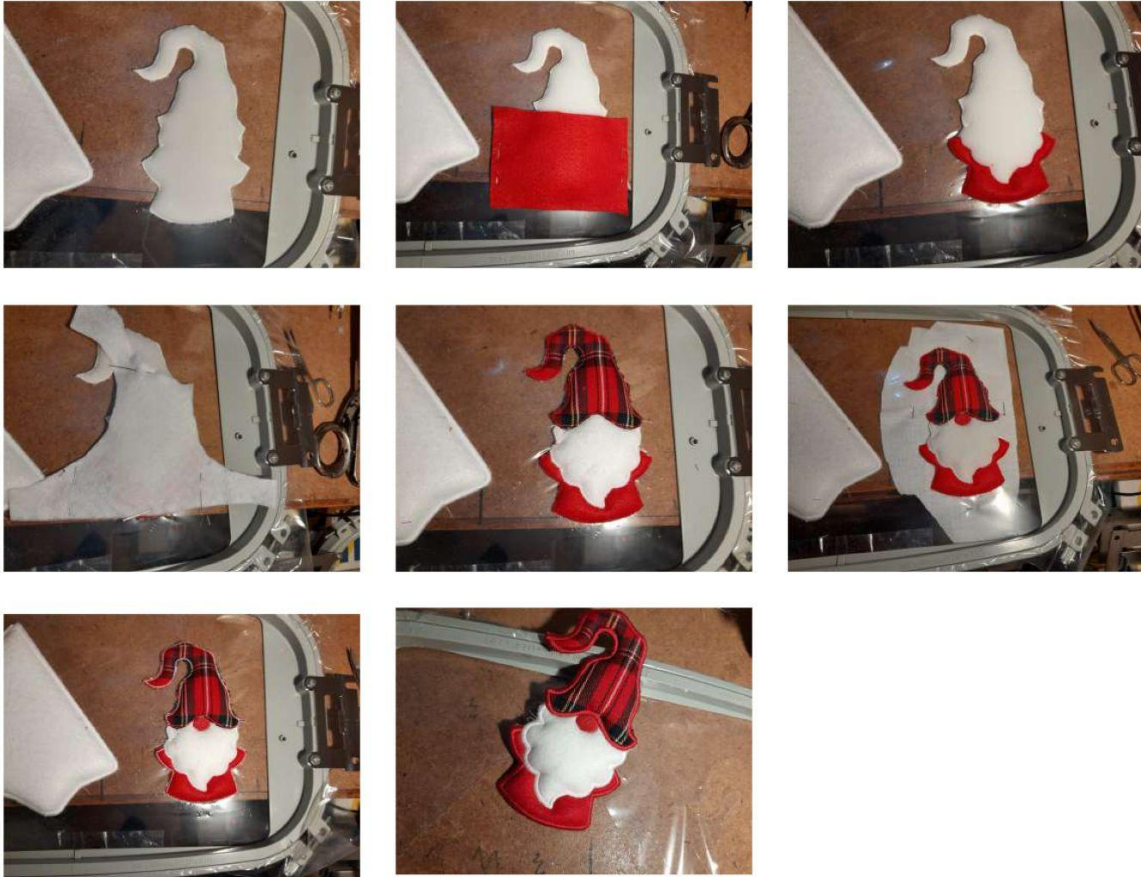
Put it in the frame tear-away stabilizer
Embroider the position track
Place the foam rectangle
Embroider the next track
Cut out the shape

Place the padding on top of the foam. Embroider the next seam
Cut out the shape
Place the outer fabric on the right side of the frame and the lining on the wrong side.
Secure everything with pins. Embroider the next seam

Cut out excess fabric both above and below the frame
Finish the shape with the last seam
Remove the stabilizer
Follow the same steps to make the other half of the circle



STEP TO MAKE GNOME



The photos are related to a different gnome from the one inserted in the files you downloaded, but the procedure is the same
Embroider the position trace, place the foam on top, embroider the next trace and cut out the excess, in this case we will not put the padding
Then we proceed with the applique before finishing with the last seam
you have to put the lining on the back of the frame.



Also for the banner and the balls the procedure is the same
 Embroider the position trace, place the foam on top, embroider the trace
 Next, cut out the shape, then place the outer fabric on top, do the embroidery,
 Turn the hoop over and fix the lining, embroider the penultimate trace, cut out
 everything the excess of fabric both above and below, finish with the last seam

To assemble the circle it is necessary to position the part below, above the other half taking as reference the part delimited by the horizontal seam, join all parts with fabric glue or hot glue.
