WHAT IS NEEDED:

Foam 1 cm
Padding 1 cm
Felt or fabric of your choice



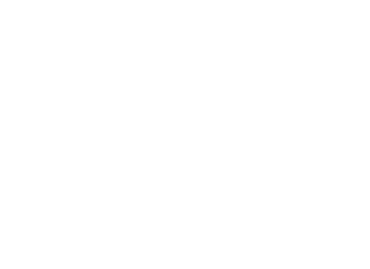
Put it in the frame tear-away stabilizer Embroider the position track
Place the foam rectangle Embroider the next track - Cut out the shape
Place the padding on top of the foam, secure with pins or tape Embroider the following seam - Cut out the excess padding



Put the lining on the back of the hoop and the outer fabric on top of the anchor -
Embroider the next track and then cut out the excess fabric both above and below,
finish with the cover stitch



Proceed in the same way to make the bear too



After having fixed and cut out the second padding, proceed with the body applications



Embroider the first part of the bear's face, and then make the applique



Proceed with all the following steps until you have completed all the embroidered parts of the bear, muzzle, t-shirt and paws
Turn the hoop over, secure the lining, embroider the next track, and cut out the excess fabric. Finish with the cover stitch



To make the hat there is the step to insert the foam and the procedure is the same as used in previously, however, to make the rudder you do not need padding
You just need to put the lining on the back before finishing with the last seam
