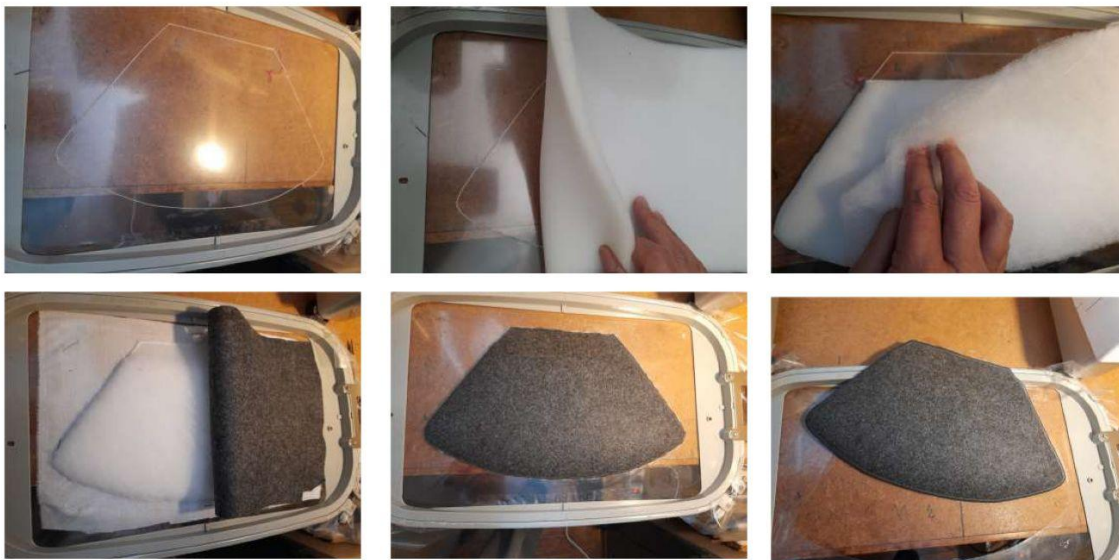

WHAT IS NEEDED:

Foam 1 cm
Padding 1 cm
Felt or fabric of your choice

STEP TO MAKE THE TREE



This tree is made up of three distinct parts for which the procedure is the same
Put the tear-off stabilizer in the frame (I use plastic bags)
Embroider the position trace - Place the foam rectangle on the trace
Embroider the next seam - Cut out the shape
Place the fixed padding on top of the foam fix with pins or adhesive tape
Embroider the next seam, cut out the excess padding
Place the fabric of the tree on top of the padding -Fix with pins
Turn the frame over and put the lining fabric on, fix with pins
Embroider the next trace - Cut out the excess fabric both above and below
Finish with the last seam

Perform the same operations to do the other two parts of the tree tree

STEP TO MAKE THE BANNER



Place the tear-off stabilizer in the hoop - Embroider the position trace -
Lay down the foam rectangle
Embroider the next seam - Cut out the shape
Place the padding and fabric on top of the foam, fix with adhesive tape or pins
Embroider the word - Turn the hoop over and secure the lining fabric
Cut out the excess fabric both above and below
Finish with the last seam

STEP TO MAKE HOUSE



The procedure for making the house is identical in the first steps as far as it concerns the two paddings, then the applique must be performed, first the part is done of the roof, then the body of the house, then the two embroideries are made

Before finishing, place the lining on the back of the hoop, cut it out the excess of fabric both above and below and ends with the last two stitching

Photos are missing but I hope the process is clear

STEP TO MAKE THE FLOWERS



For the flowers I did two different tests
The first with padding and the second with foam
Basically they could also be done without any kind of internal support,
but perhaps they would come too light
So at the discretion whether to use one or the other padding
I prefer the one made with foam in the leaves and normal padding in
the flower

Join all parts with fabric glue or hot glue.
I have inserted some handmade roses for which I don't have a tutorial,
but basically you can add more flowers or other decorations of your choice
