

ITH Bib

The best ITH Bib ever! ITH Bib is made with wadding and fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 40 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 00:40 hours

Materials:

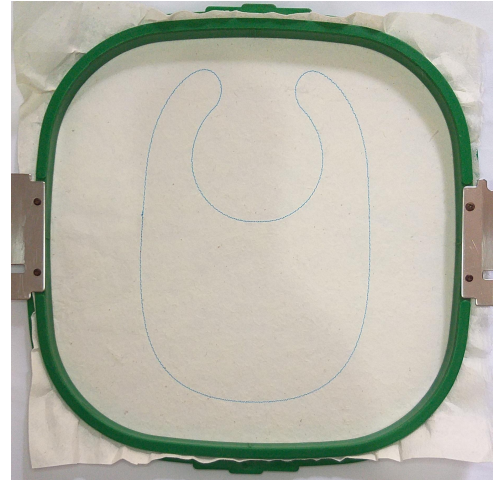
- 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

Designs used in this project:

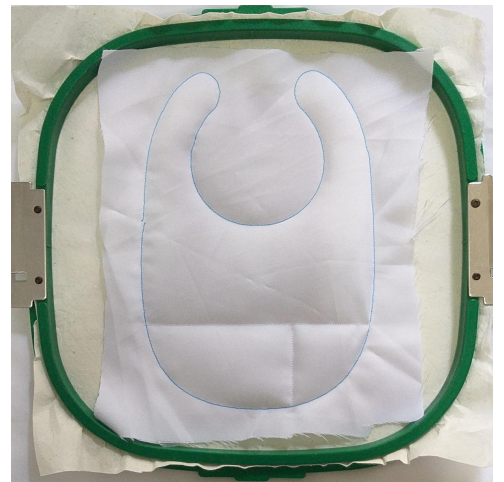


Step 1:

For this project tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run the color-stop 1 as a placement line.

**Step 2:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Spray Repositionable adhesive on it and cover the placement line with a layer of wadding and white fabric on top of it. Then repeat the color-stop 1 to fix the fabric and run color-stop 2 as a placement line.

**Step 3:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Spray Repositionable adhesive on a rectangle of printed fabric and cover the placement line with it and run color-stop 3 through color-stop 6.



Step 4:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop.
Place two strips of fabric on the upper ends of the Bib facing from outside to inside. Cover everything with a rectangle of white fabric fixed with repositionable adhesive spray and run color-stop 7.

**Step 5:**

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, leaving a homogeneous margin.

**Step 6:**

Flip it inside out through the hole left on the bottom.



Step 7:

Sew the hole by hand and you're done.
