The best ITH Pet Garland ever! ITH Pet Garland is made with fabric, just take all the work out of the project. Make these in less than 80 minutes.

Skill Level: Beginner

Time Required: 01:20 hours

Materials:

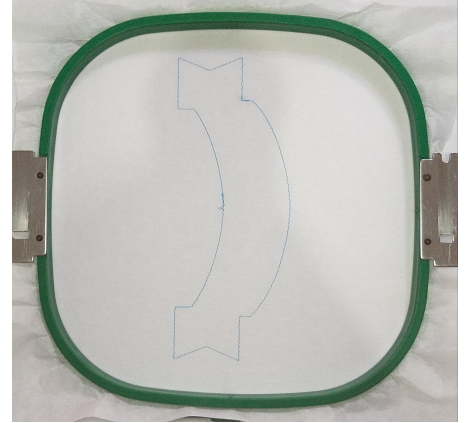
- 4" x 4 - 5" x 7" - 6" x 10" or an extra-large embroidery hoop.
- Fabric in your favorite colors.
- 2.5-ounce Cut-away Stabilizer.
- Repositionable adhesive spray
- Fabric scissors

Designs used in this project:



Step 1:

For the Banner part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

**Step 2:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Beige fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 7.

**Step 3:**

Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 8.

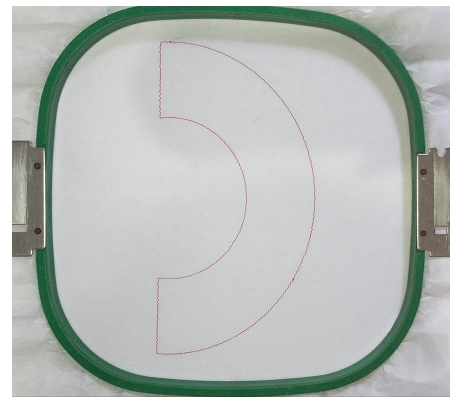


Step 4:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.

**Step 5:**

For the Top part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.

**Step 6:**

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Printed fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and run color-stop 2 through color-stop 4 to fix the fabric.



Step 7:

Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 5.



Step 8:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 9:

For the Bottom part, follow the same steps used in the Top part.



Step 10:

For the Cat part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 11:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Beige fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and repeat color-stop 1 to fix the fabric.



Step 12:

Run color-stop 2 through color-stop 8.



Step 13:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 14:

For the Dog part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 15:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Brown fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and repeat color-stop 1 to fix the fabric.



Step 16:

Run color-stop 2 through color-stop 5.



Step 17:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 18:

For the Cat paw part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 19:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Beige fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and un color-stop 2 through color-stop 4.



Step 20:

Remove the project from the hoop. Cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 21:

For the Dog paw part, follow the same steps used in the Cat paw part.



Step 22:

For the Heart part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 23:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and un color-stop 2 and color-stop 3.



Step 24:

Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 4.



Step 25:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors, and save it for later.



Step 26:

For the Hat part tautly hoop 2.5-ounce cutaway stabilizer in your embroidery hoop and run color-stop 1 as a placement line.



Step 27:

Remove the hoop from the machine, do not unhoop. Cover the placement line with Red fabric with the help of the repositionable adhesive spray, and un color-stop 2 and color-stop 3.



Step 28:

Cut off the excess fabric and run color-stop 4 through color-stop 7.



Step 29:

Remove the project from the hoop and cut out the outline of the design with sharp scissors.



Step 30:

We put all the pieces together.



Step 31:

With the help of a needle and thread or some type of textile glue, join the pieces as they are arranged in the image.

Use a ribbon as a complementary decoration.
