WHAT IS NEEDED:

Foam
Padding
Felt or fabric of your choice

STEP TO MAKE THE CIRCLE



Put it in the frame tear-away stabilizer
Embroider the position track
Place the foam rectangle
Embroider the next track
Cut out the shape



Rest on top of the foam the padding and the fabric of the upper part,
fixed with pins or adhesive tape
Flip the frame over and place the second rectangle of fabric
fix with pins or adhesive tape
Embroider the next seam



Cut out excess fabric both above and below the frame
Finish the shape with the last seam
Remove the stabilizer
Follow the same steps to make the other half of the circle



STEP TO MAKE THE BEAR



Put tear away stabilizer in the frame
Embroider the position track
Place the foam on top - Embroider the next track
Remove the excess foam



It puts on foam padding and fabric to make the cloud
Embroider the next track and cut out the excess fabric.
Do the same operation for the body of the bear
Place the fabric to make the bear's face
Embroider the next track and cut out the excess fabric
Continue with the embroidery of the eyes, nose, mouth and internal parts of the body



Turn the frame over and place the fabric covering the embroidery, fix with pins
Put the frame back in the embroiderer, sew the next track, cut off the excess fabric
both above and below, embroider the last cover seam

STEP TO MAKE AUREOLE - WINGS - CLOUDS AND STARS

The procedure for making a halo, wings, clouds and stars is the same as that used
to make the circle and the bear, follow the steps in the order of sewing and
remember to put the fabric under the frame before finishing with the cover





To assemble the circle it is necessary to position the part below, above the other half taking as reference the part delimited by the horizontal seam,join allparts with fabric glue or hot glue.
