WHAT IS NEEDED:

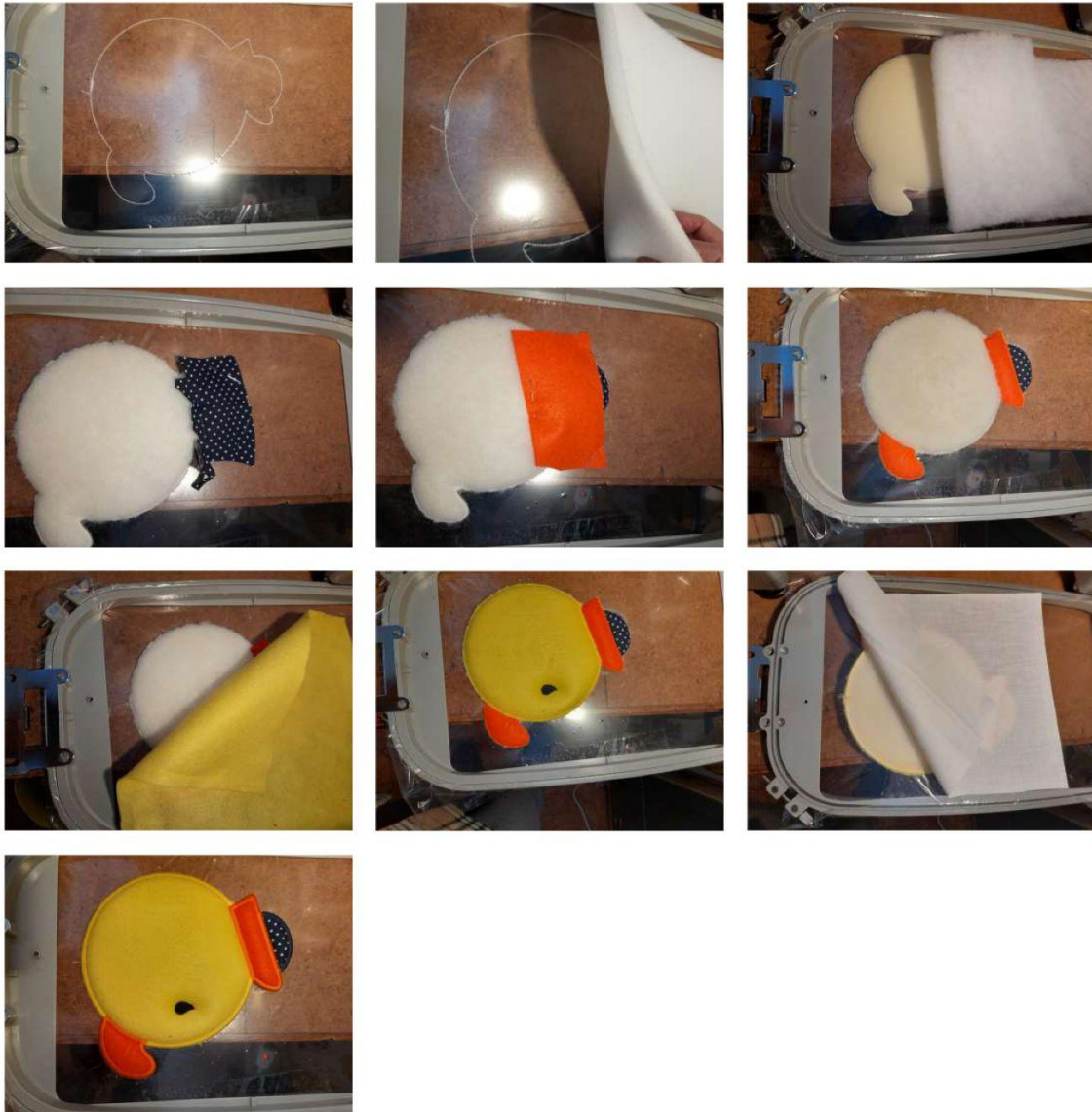
Padding 1 cm

Foam 1 cm

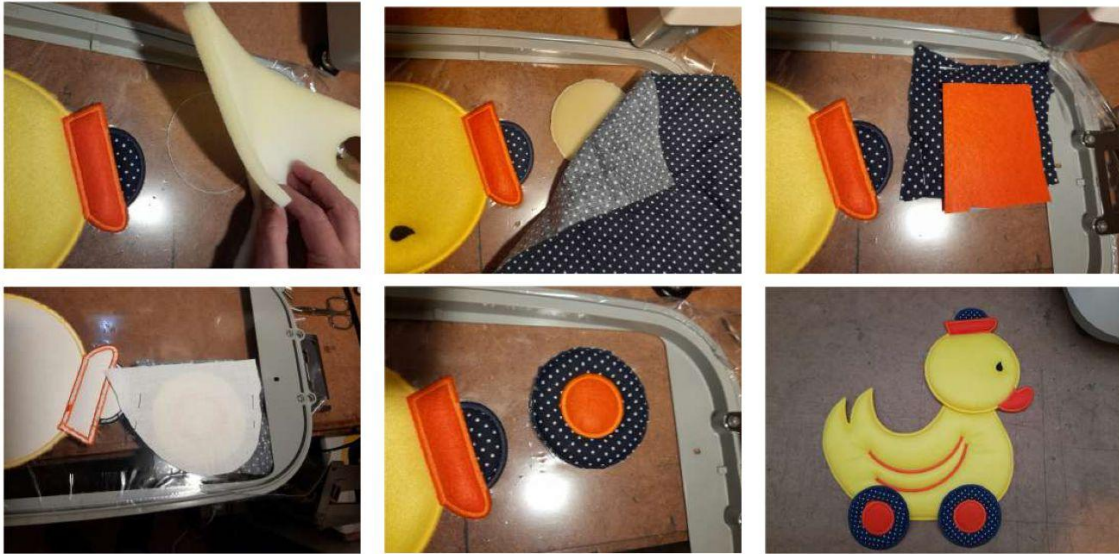
Felt or fabric of your choice



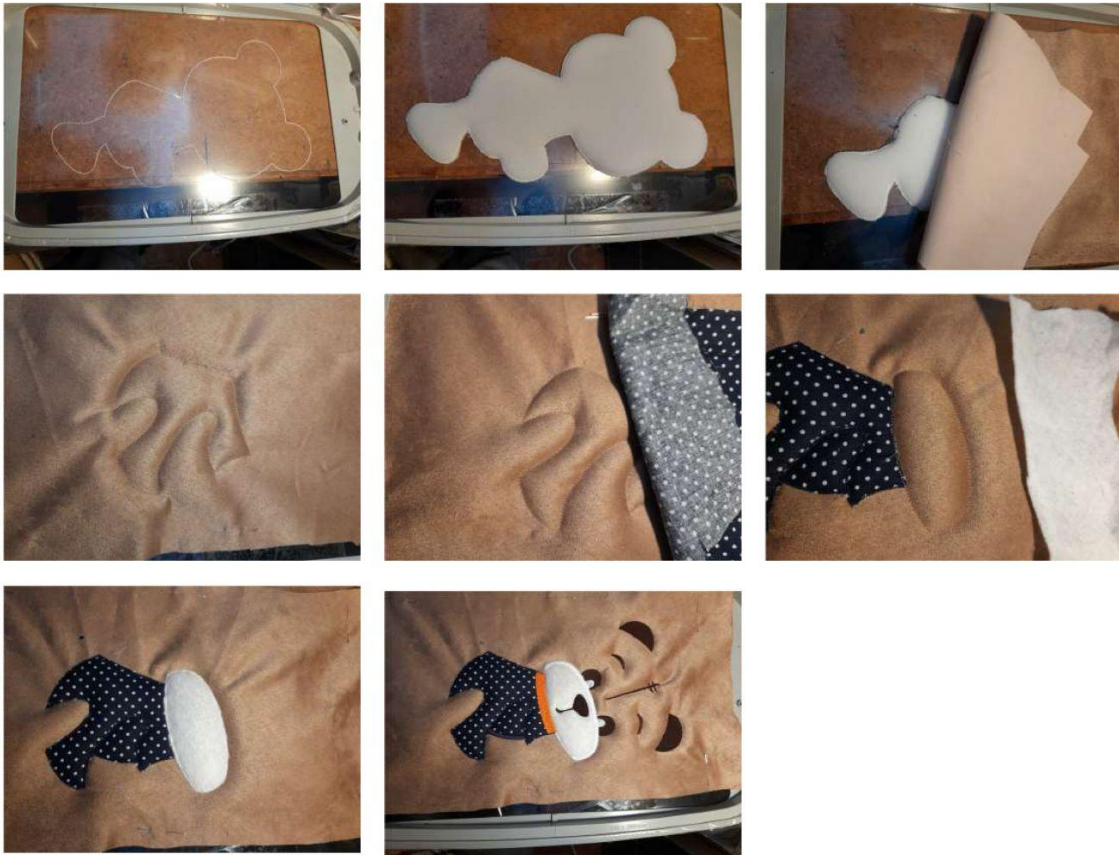
Tear-off stabilizer in the hoop - Embroider the position track
Place foam on top - I embroider the next track - I cut out the excess
Place on the batting - I embroider the next track - I cut out the excess
I do the central embroidery - I turn the hoop over and fix the lining
I embroider the next track -, I cut out the excess fabric both above and below
I finish with the last cover seam



To make the duck's head, I repeat the first three steps with the overlapping of the padding, then I perform the applique of the hat, the nose and the face
I turn the frame and fix the lining on the back, sew the next seam, cut out the excess fabric and I end up with coverage



To make the wheels follow the same procedure used for the duck's head, the only difference is that only the foam layer is needed





Even to make the teddy bear, the procedure is the same, just use the layer of foam, do the applique of the dress and the muzzle, remember to put the lining on the back
Join all parts with hot glue or fabric glue
