How to Create Gift Bags for the 5x7 Hoop

Requirements.

- 1. 2 pieces of fabric sizes 6x7. (the design will be stitched on the front piece)
- 2. Temporary adhesive spray or masking tape
- 3. 1 or 2 Colours embroidery thread.

Preparation.

- 1. Hoop stitch and tear.
- 2. Use temporary adhesive spray to attach the back piece to the stitch and tear, pretty side facing you.

Stitch the back portion.

- 1. Stitch the back of the bag using the same colour thread in the bobbin as the embroidery thread.
- 2. Unhoop.
- 3. Put aside.

Stitch the front portion.


- 1. I only used one colour for all steps.
- 2. Stitch the design.
- 3. Stitch the button holes for the ribbon.
- 4. Remove the hoop from the machine, BUT DO NOT UNHOOP.
- 5. Place the back piece on top of the piece just stitched. Place the button holes exactly on top of each other.
- 6. The tear away stabilizer of the back piece must be facing you. Tape in place.
- 7. Re-attach the hoop to the machine.
- 8. Stitch the next colour to attach the back portion to the front portion.
- 9. Remove the hoop from the machine, and unhoop.
- 10. Use zig-zag scissors to trim the design, trim 2 or 3cm past the button holes. Trim the top, sides and bottom. Trim 1cm from the stitches attaching the front and back to each other.
- 11. Turn the design inside out.
- 12. Cut open the button holes and thread ribbon through them.
